### BREEDERS' CUP CLASSIC PURSE

**RAISED TO \$4 MILLION** Officials of Breeders' Cup Limited announced yesterday that the purse for the GI Breeders' Cup Classic will be increased \$1 million, making the race worth \$4 million. "We have been evaluating the desirability of a purse increase for several years," said D.G. Van Clief Jr., executive director of Breeders' Cup Ltd. "The addition of \$1 million to the Breeders' Cup Classic will serve to reaffirm its importance as the event's finale and demonstrate vitality in our overall program. In the future, we will continue to evaluate the possibility of further increases to the Championship purses." The winner's share of the Classic will be \$2,080,000; the rest of the purse will be divided as follows: second--\$800,000, third--\$480,000, fourth--\$224,000, and fifth--\$80,000. The mile-and-a-quarter Breeders' Cup Classic, sponsored by Mobil Corporation, will have its 13th renewal at Woodbine Racetrack in Toronto Saturday, October 26, 1996.

### BARRETT'S RECORDS HUGE INCREASES IN GROSS, AVERAGE

The 1996 Barretts March Sale of Selected Two-Year-Olds in Training concluded Wednesday night. There were 61 two-year-olds sold during Wednesday's second session for a gross of \$12,751,000 and an average of \$209,033, up 59.4 percent from last year's second session average of \$131,109. There were 18 horses reported as not sold. The highest price Wednesday was \$900,000 paid by B. Wayne Hughes for **Native Storm**, a bay colt by Storm Bird--Aquakiss (Fr) (Kings Lake). "I'm crazy," Hughes said. "It was too much money, but we wanted him. We thought he'd go for about \$500,000. We loved everything about him. He's a good-looking horse. He breezed well (an eighth in :10.99 Monday), and we're happy to have him. He'll go to (trainer) George Vogel." Overall, 160 two-year-olds were sold during the two-day auction for a gross of \$33,016,000--up 46.4 percent from 1995, when 161 horses brought \$22,548,000. The average price of \$206,350 was up 47.3 percent from last year's \$140,050. There were 73 horses reported as not sold. The sale's top purchaser was Hiroshi Fujita, who bought 10 juveniles for \$4,910,000, an average of \$491,000. Jerry Bailey Sales Agency, agent for Bailey-Ellenbergl, was the top consignor, selling nine head for \$3,415,000, an average of \$379,444.

**NORTHERN SPUR OUT OF PAN AMERICAN**

Champion **Northern Spur (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) came down with a case of colic shortly after arriving at Gulfstream Park Tuesday night, and after missing two days of training, will be forced to miss Saturday's GII Crown Royal Pan American.

**AQUEDUCT, SUFFOLK AND TURFWAY PARK CANCEL RACING**

Racing at New York's Aqueduct Racetrack was called off after the second race Thursday because the jockeys felt the track surface was unsafe. Rain checks for parking, admission and programs were issued to the fans on hand; the track is expected to be back in action this afternoon. Suffolk Downs in East Boston, Massachusetts has cancelled Friday's live racing card due to the snowstorm that hit the region Wednesday night. It is the 20th time this winter that Suffolk has been forced to call off live racing due to the weather. Simulcasting at Suffolk will continue as scheduled, and live racing is scheduled to resume Saturday. At Turfway Park in Florence, Kentucky, live racing was cancelled for the 12th time this year Thursday night, with poor road conditions and extreme wind chill factors cited as the reasons. The Race Book at Turfway Park remained open for full-card simulcasting, with live racing scheduled to resume Friday evening.

**BREEDERS' CUP TICKET ORDER FORMS TO BE MAILED THIS MONTH**

The first mailing of Ticket Order Forms for the 13th running of the Breeders' Cup Championship will take place by the end of March, it was announced yesterday at Woodbine Racetrack. The 1996 Breeders' Cup will be held Saturday, October 26 at Woodbine in Ontario, Canada. All of the available 6,500 reserved seats will be allocated by special lottery. In order to be eligible for the "seat derby," Ticket Order Forms must be received at Woodbine no later than May 31. The lottery will take place June 1. Requests for the Breeders' Cup Ticket Order Form can be faxed to Wendy Loiselle, Woodbine Racetrack, Breeders' Cup Reserved Seats, at (416) 213-2101.

**JOCKEY CLUB CLOSES 1993 FOAL CROP**

The Jockey Club has closed out the North American registered foal crop of 1993 at 37,095. This represents an increase of 1.4 percent on the original estimate of 36,600. The number could increase slightly, as there are a few registration cases still pending. The 1993 crop was down three percent compared to the 1992 crop of 38,257; this marked the seventh consecutive decline, beginning with the registered crop of 1987. The trend could be reversing, however, as the estimated 1994 foal crop dropped to an eight-year low of 34,700, but the 1995 estimate is for 35,200 registered foals, and the 1996 estimate is at 35,700.

### Local News, Oklahoma:

Oklahoma racetracks came one step closer Wednesday to realizing full-card, out-of-state simulcasting when state senators passed Senate Bill 1260. The bill would permit Remington Park, Blue Ribbon Downs and Fair Meadows to offer up to six full-card simulcasts per day. Under the proposal, state racetracks could conduct simulcasting during live racing days as well as dark days. Remington Park's number of simulcast-only days could equal at most one-half of the number of live racing days. The bill will now move to the Oklahoma House of Representatives. Oklahoma is one of three states which currently prohibit full-card interstate simulcasting.

### Local News, Santa Anita, Continued.

Trainer Wally Dollase said **Windsharp** (Lear Fan), who beat the boys in the GII San Luis Obispo H. Feb. 19, has recovered from a temperature and is back in training.

**Ready to Order** (Order) recently suffered a bruised foot, which explains why the three-year-old colt was scratched from last Saturday's GII San Rafael S. According to trainer Jude Feld, the injury is not serious and the GIII San Vicente S. third-place finisher is scheduled to resume galloping today.

The Santa Anita Companies yesterday reported improved operating performance for the year-ended December 31, 1995. Excluding non-recurring items, the combined income for 1995 was \$7,047,000, or \$.63 per share, compared to \$5,522,000, or \$.50 per share, in 1994. The higher earnings for the year, before non-recurring items, are primarily due to improved results in Santa Anita's Thoroughbred racing operations. After taking into consideration several non-recurring charges and credits which principally result from the strategic redirection of Santa Anita Realty, The Santa Anita Companies reported a combined net loss for the year ended December 31, 1995 of \$27,505,000, or \$2.45 per share, compared to combined net income of \$2,314,000, or \$.21 per share, in 1994.

### Local News, California:

A California Thoroughbred owner has pledged a gift of \$12 million to the UCLA Children's Hospital. Rubin Brown, an 83-year-old electrical supply entrepreneur, asked only that the millions be used "to help the kids," said Kim Richardson, his spokesperson. Brown's gift is the largest ever received by the Children's Hospital, located at the UCLA Medical Center in Westwood, and ranks among the 10 largest received in the history of the Medical Center. Brown has raced and bred horses for the past 50 years. He currently has six horses in training in Southern California with Craig Lewis. Among Brown's best horses are MSW **Our Sweet Sham** (Nosttrum) and stakes-placed **Sticky Wile** (Clever Trick), who in 1989 set a track record that still stands at Santa Anita for a mile in 1:32 3/5. According to Lewis, Brown also has approximately 12 broodmares.
