TURFWAY NAMED WAGERING CENTER FOR DUBAI WORLD CUP Turfway Park will serve as the North American center for wagering on the \$4 million Dubai World Cup, set for Wednesday, March 27. Arlington International Racecourse, which is coordinating the North American simulcast of the event, selected Turfway as the wagering center for all bets placed in the U. S., Canada and Mexico. Turfway will accept wagers from racetracks and other outlets across the country, and will maintain them in a common betting pool with bets placed at the track's Race Book. Because of the time difference, the Dubai World Cup will go off at 10 a.m. EST, with televised commentary and post-race interviews from 9:30-10:30 a.m. The post position draw is set for Sunday, March 24; program pages will be available later that day. Turfway and the national outlets will accept advance wagering on the race Sunday and Monday, March 24-25. The track is closed March 26.

FOUNTAIN OF YOUTH WINNER WORKS Built for Pleasure (Homebuilder), 143-1 winner of the GII Fountain of Youth last time out, breezed six furlongs in 1:16 at Calder yesterday morning. "That is about what I wanted," said owner/trainer Thomas Heard. "The track is deep over there. He galloped out strong--he is dead fit." The three-year-old will try to prove that his first stakes victory was no fluke in the GI Florida Derby this Saturday, March 16. "I gave him a chance in the Fountain of Youth. I thought he should have been third or fourth choice, but he was overlooked," said Heard. "They were all making excuses...my horse was nine-wide turning for home. He looped the whole field and ran by them, and he ran the whole way on one lead. He is a real contender. He has grown and matured and now he knows what it's all about."

SUFFOLK CANCELS SATURDAY Buffeted by a windchill factor that brought temperatures below zero yesterday, Suffolk Downs in East Boston, Massachusetts canceled its live card for the second straight day. Simulcasting continued as scheduled, and racing is expected to resume this afternoon. Saturday's feature, the \$25,000a Mystery Jet S., has been rescheduled for April 28. **Correction:** It was incorrectly reported in yesterday's TDN that Thistledown Racetrack in Cleveland canceled racing Friday, March 8. In fact, the track held its full card of seven races; it was Ohio's Beulah Park which canceled Friday.

Celtic Arms (Fr) became the late Rodney Rash's last stakes winner when he took the GII Gulfstream Park Breeders' Cup H. Feb. 17. With this effort, the horse becomes the first winner for Ben Cecil, Rash's assistant, who took over the trainer's 33 horses after he died suddenly March 1. "I'm thrilled to have my first win, of course, but it is not quite as I would have had it," Cecil admitted after the race. "We've had long faces for a few days, but everyone has gone on with their job. It has been a very tough week." Owner Gary Tanaka added, "Rodney always had great confidence in this horse, but we couldn't get him to produce. He was ecstatic when he won last time." Celtic Arms had gained a reputation for inconsistency, but Tanaka thinks the bay has turned things around. "I think it is a combination of Florida and the pace here, which has been slow," he said. "It has been much like France where they dawdle the first part and sprint home." Options for the French Derby winner's next start include the Hialeah Turf Cup (Apr. 20), the San Luis Rey (Mar. 24), or the Golden Gate H. (Jun. 16). Favored Broadway Flyer grabbed the lead with a quarter-mile to go but weakened late and had to settle for second.
