**ANNUS MIRABILIS DEFEATED** Annus Mirabilis (Fr) (Warning {GB}), being prepared for a crack at the Dubai World Cup March 27, made a disappointing first appearance at Nad Al Sheba race course Sunday. The Godolphin colt was unsuited to very wet conditions and struggled home a well-beaten fourth behind Istinsaar (Crafty Prospector) in the Keeneland Mile over a track made very slow by a pre-race rainstorm. British champion jockey Frankie Dettori, who described the going as "muddy," also felt Annus Mirabilis would make a better showing at a longer distance. Dettori came back later in the card to pilot **Tamayaz** (Gone West) to a five-length victory over **Cezanne** (GB) (Ajdal) in the third round of the Maktoum al Maktoum Challenge.

### SPRING THAW MELTS TURFWAY CARD

Turfway Park was forced to cancel live racing just prior to the first race Sunday afternoon due to a rapidly thawing track surface. It was the 14th cancellation since the beginning of the track's Winter/Spring Meet January 1. "Our track superintendent expressed concern that the track was thawing too quickly," said Turfway General manager Greg Schmitz. "With all the rain and snow we had before the recent cold snap, and with sun and temperatures forecast to reach 40 degrees (Sunday), the track needs time to thaw out. We don't want to put horses and riders on the track when there is a question about the conditions." Turfway's Race Book remained open for simulcasting; live action resumes Wednesday.

### TOP BARRETT'S TWO-YEAR-OLDS HEADING TO EUROPE

B. Wayne Hughes, who purchased the top-selling colt and third-from-the-top filly at last week's Barretts March Sale of Selected Two-Year-Olds in Training, will ship the pair to Europe, according to his trainer, George Vogel. But plans call for the colt **Native Storm** (Storm Bird), a \$900,000 acquisition, and the unnamed filly by Storm Bird--Piling Up (Secretariat), bought for \$525,000, to train but not race abroad, returning to California for three-year-old campaigns.

Antespend, winner of the GI Las Virgenes in her last outing Feb. 18, gave a repeat performance of that wire-to-wire win here for her sixth straight. The bay daughter of Derby champion Spend A Buck led from the start and was once again chased around the Santa Anita oval by Cara Rafaela. Cara Rafaela changed course several times to avoid Antespend, causing an inquiry into the running of the race, but the steward's deemed the winner's infractions insufficient to change the order of finish. Gary Stevens, riding Cara Rafaela, disagreed strongly with their decision. "It was a horrible call. I guess they were allowing you to go wherever you want on the racecourse and to do all the herding you want to do. I just had a discussion with (steward) George Slender about that, and it's evident to me that you've just got a green light to drift and go wherever you want to go...just pretty much slow the pace down all you want by wandering all over the racetrack. I think this ruling by the stewards was pathetic, an absolute joke." Winning trainer Ron McAnally said, "I was concerned (about the inquiry), especially when it took so long. I saw Gary and (Wayne) Lukas go immediately to the steward's stand. I thought there would be an inquiry because twice it didn't look like (Stevens) knew if he wanted to go to the inside or outside. But he did not take up and that was the one thing we had in our favor. Gary started through on the rail and Chris (Antley) said he let him go, which is where he wanted to be. Our filly started to drift out in the stretch and (Cara Rafaela) started to come out with us and then decided to go back in. To me, it was a close call." McAnally indicated Antespend could start next in Oaklawn's GI Fantasy S. Apr. 5.

Twice The Vice had scored back-to-back victories in stakes at Hollywood and Santa Anita before facing Serena's Song in the GI Santa Maria H. last out. A very respectable second in that race, the consistent miss came back as the 6-5 favorite and earned a hard-fought decision over Sleep Easy, closing to take the lead at the top of the stretch, then giving it her all to hold the runner-up safe. Jewel Princess, looking for her third straight, was bumped and went four-wide on the final turn, then was fanned even wider at the top of the stretch, but finished well to be third. The winner will once again take on Serena's Song in her next start, the GI Apple Blossom at Oaklawn April 12.

Memories (Ire), off for three months after finishing off the board in her last four starts of 1995, came back in fine fettle, taking a Gulfstream allowance test by six lengths February 28. The five-year-old, who had finished a decent fourth in the GI Flower Bowl H. over a soft turf at Belmont last fall, demonstrated a liking for a deep course once again, dueling with **ELECTRIC SOCIETY (IRE)** (Law Society) to the top of the stretch, then shaking loose from that one only to be challenged late by Caromana, who just missed in a photo. "My plan before the race was to settle in about third or fourth, but she was going so easy I just let her go," said winning jockey Jose Santos. "We were passed for a step on the far turn, but from then on she really dug in--she just didn't want any horse to pass her." The favorite, California shipper **PRIVITY** (Private Account) was with the leaders early but dropped back to finish seventh.

**News cont.****FLORIDA HORSEMEN TAKE HIALEAH TO**

**COURT** The Florida Horsemen's Benevolent and Protective Association gave Hialeah owner John Brunetti until Saturday, March 9, to sign a contract calling for an average daily purse distribution of \$104,000 at Hialeah's upcoming meet. Brunetti didn't sign, and the horsemen say they will take him to Federal Court to try and stop the track from simulcasting their signal out. "We will be in court (today) seeking an injunction to stop him from broadcasting his signal out," said Scott Savin, president of the FHBPA. "We all ready have 40 of the 75 outlets that took Hialeah last year agreeing not to take it this year without a horsemen's contract. We figure the 35 remaining tracks make up only about 33 percent of the money he took in last year. I don't think he'll be very successful getting places to take Hialeah." The FHBPA went to Federal Court last year and filed suit against the 75 outlets taking Hialeah after the track failed to fulfill the purse guarantee of the 1995 contract. The horsemen based their suit on the Interstate Horse Racing Act of 1978.
