**DUBAI WORLD CUP NOTES** Cigar (Palace Music) missed a workout scheduled for Monday at Gulfstream due to a sloppy track, but trainer Bill Mott said he would try to get the work in today and, if there are no more obstacles, the six-year-old could still make the Dubai World Cup March 27. "I didn't like the racetrack (Monday)," said Mott. "There were pools of water sitting out there. We'll work when the track is in better shape. I can't be pressed into something because I have a deadline. If it doesn't rain anymore, I'm sure the track will tighten up and they will get it rolled and I will feel better about working him over it (today)." As for how the delay will affect the champ's Dubai status, Mott said, "We are on a tight schedule. A lot will depend on the racetrack. I'm not looking for a real hard work (today). If all goes well, we'll plan a little longer and more serious work on Saturday." Cigar is booked on a flight to Dubai Saturday evening. **Jeune (GB)** (Kalaglow {Ire}) will not take part in the \$4 million World Cup after finishing last in Monday's G1 Australian Cup at Flemington. The seven-year-old showed little in the race as **Saintly (Aus)** (Sky Chase {NZ}) scored a 2 1/2-length victory. "It was hopeless right from the start," said his trainer, Peter Hayes. Angus Gold, racing manager to the gelding's owner, Hamdan al Maktoum, added, "We have regrettably informed the Dubai World Cup Committee that he will not take part, as he is clearly not at his peak." **L'Carriere** (Carr de Naskra) left from Florida Sunday and, after stops in Atlanta and Amsterdam, was expected to arrive in Dubai late Monday evening. He will have two works over the track at Nad Al Sheba before the World Cup. Australian champion **Danewin (Aus)** (Danehill) had his first trip around the Dubai oval Sunday morning, galloping under the floodlights at 5:20 a.m. "He felt really good and was comfortable on the sand," said his rider, Myles Plumb. "He is really well in himself and was not affected in any way by the floodlights." **Tamayaz** (Gone West) may have put himself in the World Cup picture with his five-length romp in Sunday's third leg of the Maktoum al Maktoum Challenge; the four-year-old could replace **Moonshell (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells), who disappointed when a well-beaten third in her first run over the course, in the line-up for the mile-and-a-quarter event.

"He has settled down some since (the Fountain of Youth)," said George Weaver, assistant to trainer D. Wayne Lukas, adding, "The more times he runs, the better he gets--especially about his behavior. He is a sound horse than can handle the campaign." Gary Stevens will fly in from California for the ride. Prepping for the Florida Derby Sunday, **Appealing Skier** (Baldski) went five furlongs in 1:00 3/5 at Gulfstream. The colt, winner of the GII Hutcheson S. in his first start of the year, came back to finish fourth in the GII Fountain of Youth February 24.
