**MATCH RACE SET FOR SANTA ANITA** Jockeys Gary Stevens and Julie Krone will face off in a match race at Santa Anita March 23. The two will ride a pair of the circuit's sharpest claimers, **Busy Banana (GB)** (Insan) and **Richard Of England** (Tri Jet), in a \$40,000 starter allowance test going a mile and a sixteenth; mounts will be decided by the luck of the draw when entries for the race are taken March 21. The two horses last met in a starter allowance at a mile and a quarter February 9, with Busy Banana taking a wire-to-wire victory by 2 3/4 lengths; Richard Of England, who had won three in a row going into that race, finished fourth. Busy Banana came back to run his 1996 record to three-for-three with a starter allowance win at the match race distance March 2.


**EPSOM OAKS ENTRIES RELEASED** Saeed bin Suroor, trainer of last year's Epsom Oaks winner **Moonshell (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells), has four of the 75 entries in this season's classic event set for June 7. Suroor's leading hopes at this stage are **Bint Shadayid** (Nashwan), runner-up to **Bosra Sham** (Woodman) in Ascot's Group One Fillies Mile on her second outing as a juvenile, and **Pricket** (Diesis {GB}), a once-raced winning full-sister to the 1988 Oaks heroine Diminuendo. Henry Cecil, handler of Bosra Sham, has seven other possible fillies for the Oaks, including Group One Prix Marcel Boussac fourth **Solar Crystal (Ire)** (Alzao). But even Cecil was outnumbered when the initial entries were published Thursday; trainer John Gosden has nine to choose from. The most promising pair are the two once-raced maidens **Annaba (Ire)** (In The Wings {GB}) plus **Kerry Ring (GB)** (Sadler's Wells), whose dam Kerrera was second in the 1000 Guineas of 1989.

**JOE BRAVO NOTCHES #2,000** Jockey Joe Bravo picked up career win number 2,000 at Aqueduct yesterday, riding **Lakeside Lady** (Meadowlake) to victory in the first race. Bravo, 25, has been the leading rider at Monmouth Park and The Meadowlands since 1991; he moved his tack to New York for the first time this winter, but will return to New Jersey for the opening of the Monmouth meet this May. Commenting on the career milestone, Bravo said, "I was praying I could win the first (Thursday) and get number 2,000 off my back. I didn't want to get stuck at 1,999. I'm thankful to everyone who ever gave me a chance." Bravo is currently 10th in the standings at Aqueduct.

Trainer Jim Ryerson said yesterday that he is content to have his Breeders' Cup Juvenile champ **Unbridled's Song** (Unbridled) break from the rail in tomorrow's Grade I event. "My hope is that the longer run into the turn will be a benefit to us," he said. "I don't think the post position is as important, but it will allow us to have a smoother run into the turn than we did last time." Trainer Mike Puype saddles morning-line favorite **Cobra King** (Farma Way), who will break from the two-hole Saturday. "That is going to be Chris McCarron's worry more than mine," he said. "Cobra King likes to run on the inside anyway. I would have rather had the four or the five, but I'm sure it will be fine. I have too much confidence in Chris to think that we won't get a good trip. It might turn out that we save a lot of ground on each turn and it makes a difference."

**DEPUTY MINISTER COLT TOPS FAIR**

**GROUNDS SALE** A bay colt by Deputy Minister out of Natania (Naskra), a multiple-stakes winner of \$441,418, brought a bid of \$75,000 to top the Fair Grounds Sales Company Two-Year-Olds In-Training Sale, held Tuesday at the Fair Grounds. The colt, a half-brother to MGSP Compadre (El Gran Senor), was consigned by Lagniappe, agent for Foxfield, and purchased by Paul Magee. A total of 32 juveniles brought \$407,200, an average of \$12,725; 52 two-year-olds were listed as not sold or brought no bids. An additional eight horses-in-training grossed \$25,800, an average of \$3,225. In last year's mixed two-year-olds-in-training and horses-of-racing-age sale, 17 two-year-olds sold for \$191,600, an average of \$11,271, and eight horses-of-racing-age sold for \$15,400, an average of \$1,925.

The GIII Alabama Derby, awarded graded status for the first time for 1996, will be held at Louisiana Downs this year thanks to an agreement reached between the Bossier City racetrack, the Birmingham Racing Commission and the Alabama Thoroughbred Association. The race, which will be sponsored by Isle of Capri, supporter of the GI Super Derby, was moved due to the fact that Birmingham will not conduct a live race meet this year; it will replace the Prelude S., traditional prep for the Super Derby, and is scheduled to be run August 31.

Frank Stronach's **Buck Strider** (Easy Goer), who had been pointing to Sunday's GIII Louisiana Derby after finishing fourth in the Risen Star S. last out, suffered a fractured left hind leg during a workout Wednesday morning. The three-year-old underwent surgery at Louisiana State University in Baton Rouge late Wednesday. "It was not life-threatening," said Fair Grounds Stakes Coordinator David Heitzmann of the injury. "We understand they put two pins (in the leg)." Also injured during a morning trial Wednesday, MGSP **Seeker's Reward** (Gone West) suffered a condylar fracture of the left front cannon bone; he will also miss the Louisiana Derby, and his racing future is uncertain.

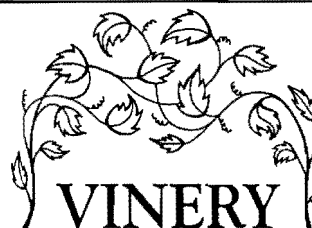
