UNBRIDLED'S SONG UNBEATABLE IN FLORIDA DERBY

In what was by far his most impressive performance to date, steel grey **Unbridled's Song** (Unbridled) stole the show at Gulfstream Park yesterday, rolling past pacesetter **Appealing Skier** (Baldski) on the far turn and gliding away from the field to take the GI Florida Derby by an authoritative 5 3/4 lengths. "This was a dynamite race," said winning jockey Mike Smith. "He battled for the early lead and then he just ran away from them. He is getting better each time." Enthused trainer Jim Ryerson, "We're going to the Triple Crown. We're just getting warmed up. He ran awesome today...he showed us improvement, and if he improves some more then you are talking about a very good horse, a special horse." The colt will make his next start in the Wood Memorial at Aqueduct April 13; then it's on to Kentucky, where he will try to overcome the Breeders' Cup jinx to become the first winner of the Juvenile to capture the Kentucky Derby. Disappointing both his connections and the handicappers who made him the 9-5 favorite, **Cobra King** (Farma Way) had little to say about the outcome of the Florida Derby; never in the hunt, he finished eighth in the nine-horse field. "I don't know why he ran so poorly," said trainer Mike Puype. "He trained beautifully for the race and came to the paddock great. He was in unfamiliar territory; he had dirt hitting him in the face and he was in close quarters. He may have lost interest. I don't know why he didn't pick it up." Added his rider, Chris McCarron, "I'm in shock. He was flat; he never tried to run. He was beautiful warming up, just perfect. I have no idea what happened." The colt will have the chance to redeem himself in the Toyota Blue Grass S. April 13.

CIGAR SHARP, READY TO SHIP

Cigar (Palace Music) worked seven furlongs in a brisk 1:23 3/5 under jockey Jerry Bailey yesterday and, pronounced fit by trainer Bill Mott, was scheduled to begin the trek to Dubai at 8:00 p.m. last night. "I thought he was going easily," Mott said of the breeze. "It was quicker than what I expected, but I think we've got a fast racetrack and it was a freshly harrowed racetrack. He should be screwed down pretty tight. He had a great work--I thought it was just great. Everything looks fine now." Cigar will be accompanied on the flight by stable pony **Snowball** and three members of the Mott crew.

Unbridled's Song just missed in his first two starts of the year, running second in the GII Hutcheson and GII Fountain Of Youth, but proved third time's the charm for this three-year-old with an impressive performance here. Rated just off the flank of **APPEALING SKIER** (Baldski) for six furlongs, the Breeders' Cup Juvenile champ took the lead on his own courage and raced to the wire unchallenged to earn his second Grade I score. "He had a rough trip into the first turn last time (in the Fountain Of Youth), and they ran him down," said trainer Jim Ryerson. "Today he had a clear run and he settled and he picked it up. He got the shot to relax. It was tough to get beat the other two times, but today you forget about it." Jockey Mike Smith was pleased with his mount's new attitude. "They have worked and worked with him and he was much better behaved this time," he said. "I know it might have looked like he was rank early, but he was just frisky. He was really good." Editor's Note and Skip Away came on late to pick up the pieces for second and third.

FRANK PASSERO UNDER INVESTIGATION

Trainer Frank Passero, who won a record 14 straight races during the Gulfstream Park meet which ended Saturday, was served with papers yesterday by Florida state racing authorities who are charging that grooms employed by Passero applied a substance containing cayenne pepper to the genitals, rectum and between the legs of several of his horses before they raced. One of the grooms, Abraham Siddo, told authorities that he applied the substance per Passero's orders. Passero admitted he has used the substance, but said that he did so in a legal manner and never asked anyone to apply it to the genitals or rectum. "Everything I have done to win with the horses was done within the legal rules of horse racing," Passero said. "That I used it on horses' genitals was an outrageous lie. We use it on the thighs, hocks and stifles. I've been using the stuff for 10 years." Passero has 21 days to answer the complaint, at which time he can request a hearing. If he is found guilty, it is expected the penalty will be severe. In the complaint filed by the Florida Division of Parimutuel Wagering, it was charged that "the placement of the product on the genitalia, anus and inner thighs constitutes an unconscionable and despicable act of animal cruelty." It also charged that application of the substance, known as "Fiery Jack," was "a ruthless act orchestrated solely to gain a racing advantage by using its irritating characteristics as external stimulus." Passero, 62, a native of Canada, was the second-leading trainer at Gulfstream with 33 wins.

NEW YORK OUTLETS, CASINOS TO TAKE HIALEAH SIGNAL

The controversy surrounding today's opening of the 1996 Hialeah Park meet took a new turn yesterday when the track announced it has reached simulcasting agreements with the New York City Off-Track Betting Corporation, New York Racing Association, Atlantic City and Nevada casinos, and other parimutuel sites throughout the U.S., Canada, Mexico and the Caribbean. The parimutuel outlets will take the signal from Hialeah despite the objections of the Florida Horsemen's Benevolent and Protective Association, which went to court last week seeking an injunction against Hialeah simulcasting after the track refused to sign a contract with the group. Hialeah claims to have simulcasting approval from the Florida Owners' and Horsemen's Association, which it says represents the majority of the Hialeah horsemen; Florida courts have yet to rule on the matter. The 1996 Hialeah meeting runs through May 22, with live racing Fridays through Wednesdays.

INQUIRY INTO CHELTENHAM DEATH TALLY

Britain's Jockey Club is to launch an inquiry into a total of 10 fatalities to horses during last week's Cheltenham Festival. Veterinary reports are to be studied and safety standards assessed following a death toll which many consider to be unacceptable. Edward Gillespie, manager director at Cheltenham, stated, "We're saddened by the fact that any horse dies at the races. The fatalities have marred a very successful Festival. We will now carry out a thorough review, looking at all the evidence, to see whether any pattern emerges which can be avoided in the future. Above all, we want to identify anything we can put right."

Juliannus, third in the Feb. 17 Essex H. after a layoff, rated just behind the pacesetter, gained a narrow lead around the second turn and won easily. Winning jockey Robby Albarado said, "My horse responded well at the top of the stretch. I was able to pick up the 'Judge' at the eighth pole and didn't have to ask my horse for too much more through the drive. It was his second race over the track and he seemed much sharper this time." Judge T C, the 4-5 favorite, finished well but had to settle for second. "My horse...is still not the way he is when he is at his best," said his jockey, Joe Johnson. "I would say you saw about 75 percent today. I lost a little time at the quarter-pole when I had to wait for an opening, but once we straightened out he had every chance. He didn't have his best late kick." Essex H. winner CLASSIC FIT (Bucksplasher) was scratched after coming down with a fever Saturday morning.

THORO-GRAPH ANALYSIS by Jerry Brown

The two San Felipe favorites fit the profile of the last 14 Derby winners--slow or unraced over the summer as juveniles, but running at least one big figure before the end of that campaign. Either would become a serious Derby contender with a win here. **Odyle** (Alleged) didn't race until September, but since then has run well in every start except for the time he shipped cross-country to run in the mud. In his last start he was extremely wide, and earned a lifetime best of 8. With four weeks rest, he is sure to at least pair up that effort, and could run a new top. **Prince of Thieves** (Hansel) exploded with a 6 3/4 last out and now comes back well-rested, making him unlikely to bounce and a candidate to go forward. Aside from fitting the profile, Prince of Thieves has everything you want in a Derby prospect--good pedigree, a good figure around two turns, and D. Wayne Lukas. From a betting perspective, there is not much value here. If you must play, try a box of Odyle and Prince Of Thieves, doubling up with Prince of Thieves on top. *The Thoro-Graph handicapper's line offers analyses and suggested plays for six major tracks daily.
