**FLORIDA DERBY WRAP-UP** Florida Derby winner Unbridled's Song (Unbridled) is doing well after Saturday's impressive performance and will ship to New York in 10 or 12 days to get ready for the Wood Memorial April 13. "He came out of the race great," said trainer Jim Ryerson. "Tex Sutton will fly him to New York." **Cobra King** (Farma Way), a disappointing eighth as the favorite, also seemed to exit the race none the worse for the wear. "He ate with appetite (Sunday) morning and was active," said his trainer, Mike Puype. "The race took nothing out of him." Puype added that the colt will leave for Keeneland at the end of the week, and will run once more before the Kentucky Derby. Florida Derby runner-up **Editor's Note** (Forty Niner) will also travel to Keeneland to contest the April 13 Toyota Blue Grass, while fourth-place finisher **Louis Quatorze** (Sovereign Dancer) could surface in either the Wood or the Blue Grass. **Appealing Skier** (Baldski), who tired to finish sixth after setting the pace, will be reserved for shorter races, and could try turf in his next start. Three records were broken and one was tied on Florida Derby Day. Simulcast to a record number of outlets, the Derby broke the Gulfstream Park record for most money wagered on a single race when \$4,185,392 went through the windows; the former one-race record of \$3,926,589 was set in 1994. Total handle for the day was a record \$21,102,814, eclipsing the mark of \$17,604,729 set last year. Jockey Mike Smith tied the standard for most consecutive Florida Derby wins, picking up his third straight with Unbridled's Song; he won with Holy Bull in 1994 and Thunder Gulch in 1995, and matched Bill Hartack, winner of the race from 1957-59; and Bill Shoemaker, successful from 1962-1964.

**DUBAI UPDATE** Cigar (Palace Music) flew out of Florida as scheduled Saturday night and, after a stop in Shannon, Ireland, was expected to arrive in Dubai at 2:00 p.m. EST Sunday. **Soul of the Matter** (Private Terms) worked seven furlongs in 1:28 at Hollywood yesterday; he and stablemate **Dare and Go** (Alydar) are booked on a flight to Dubai Tuesday. **Danewin** (Aus) (Danehill) and **Pentire** (GB) (Be My Guest) are scheduled to work this morning. Said trainer Geoffrey Wragg of his candidate, Pentire, "I am very pleased with him...he has really settled in. He is currently four kilograms above his racing weight, but hopefully this will come off him when he performs a serious piece of work (Monday)." *The expected field for the \$4 million Dubai World Cup, with the current odds from the bookmakers at Ladbrokes, is on p2.*

Odyle, an eight-length maiden winner last out after taking on graded stakes company in three of his first five starts, returned to the stakes wars with that win under his belt and proved successful once again. Last after a half, the colt joined the Triple Crown fray with a rallying tally under jockey Corey Nakatani. "He's still a little green, but he's getting better and this was a big stepping stone today," said Nakatani. "I've always known that he has class and ability. He just has to put it together." Trainer Paco Gonzalez, celebrating his 51st birthday yesterday, said the colt will now head for the Santa Anita Derby April 6. The 2-5 favorite, **PRINCE OF THIEVES** (Hansel), broke a step slowly and was pinched back while in tight quarters at the start, made a bid on the far turn but had nothing left for the drive and finished fourth. "He broke slow and just got wiped out," said jockey Gary Stevens. "It took him right out of the race. Everything that could go wrong went wrong." Looking on the bright side, trainer D. Wayne Lukas added, "In March and April, you've got the chance to regroup and do it again. On May 4, you don't get another chance. It's my job to get us headed in the right direction. I haven't lost any confidence."

The Thoroughbred Corporation's **Cezind** (Ferdinand), fifth in the Santa Anita H. in his last, will ship to Dubai to run in the \$350,000 King's Cup at the Equestrian Club of Riyadh March 31; Alex Solis has the mount. Also representing that owner in the race will be **Powerful Punch** (Danzig Connection), third in the Gulfstream Park H. in his most recent effort; he could have Corey Nakatani in the irons.

Champion **Northern Spur (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) drilled a mile in 1:40 1/5, handily, over a fast main track Sunday and is on target for the GI San Luis Rey S. March 24. Also breezing for weekend stakes starts, GI Santa Ana hopefuls **Angel In My Heart (Fr)** (Rainbow Quest) and **Real Connection** (Vigors) both went seven furlongs, with the former going in 1:27 1/5 at Hollywood, and the latter in 1:29 at Santa Anita. Additional Sunday works: **Lit de Justice** (El Gran Senor) went five furlongs in 1:02 for the Potrero Grande April 6; Santa Anita H. winner **Mr Purple** (Deputy Minister) went the same distance in 1:01 4/5; **Halo Sunshine** (Halo), scratched from yesterday's GII San Felipe S., worked six furlongs in 1:12 2/5; he will be pointed to the \$200,000 Golden State Derby at Bay Meadows Saturday.

**Abaginone** (Devil's Bag), a five-year-old with seven starts to his credit, earned his first stakes triumph at Bay Meadows Saturday, taking the Daly City H. by six lengths off an eight-month layoff; he could take on graded foes next in the GIII Potrero Grande Breeders' Cup H. April 6. "We're playing it one race at a time and keeping our fingers crossed," said trainer Sandy Shulman. As for Abaginone's lengthy absences, he said, "It's been strictly a shin problem. He had a fractured shin when we bought him (for \$55,000 at the Barretts Sale at two). He fractured it working in the preview."

**Jewel Princess** (Key to the Mint), who took back-to-back GII stakes before finishing third in the GI Santa Margarita last out, is enjoying a short two-week "mental vacation" on the farm, according to trainer Wally Dollase, and could make her next appearance in the Louisville Breeders' Cup H. at Churchill Downs May 3.

**Urgent Request (Ire)** (Rainbow Quest), 11th defending his title in the GI Santa Anita H. last time, will return to the turf for his next start, taking on last year's Eclipse Award winner in the San Luis Rey. Trainer Ben Cecil expects to see the grey on the front end. "If he isn't on the lead, he throws in the towel," said Cecil.

**Ready To Order** (Order), who missed yesterday's San Felipe due to a bruised foot, could be back in time for the GI Santa Anita Derby April 6. "If we can get him to the race perfectly, we'll run him," said trainer Jude Feld.
