SERENA'S SONG NAMED KENTUCKY-BRED HORSE OF THE YEAR

After representing her home state with an Eclipse Award and six Grade I wins last year, **Serena's Song** (Rahy) has been honored by the Kentucky Thoroughbred Owners and Breeders as the 1995 Kentucky-bred Horse of the Year. The now four-year-old was also named top three-year-old filly; the list of Kentucky-bred champions also includes: **Maria's Mon** (Wavering Monarch), two-year-old colt; **Golden Attraction** (Mr. Prospector), two-year-old filly; **Thunder Gulch** (Gulch), three-year-old colt; **Tinnners Way** (Secretariat), handicap horse; **Inside Information** (Private Account), handicap mare; **Lassigny** (Gone West), male turf horse; **Possibly Perfect** (Northern Baby), female turf horse; **Desert Stormer** (Storm Cat), sprinter; **Lammtarra** (*Nijinsky II), Kentucky-bred racing abroad; **Cat Appeal** (Storm Cat), earner of the year; **Storm Cat** (Storm Bird), sire of the year; **Overbrook Farm**, owner and breeder of the year; and **D. Wayne Lukas**, trainer of the year. Mrs. Virginia Kraft Payson's **Northern Sunset (Ire)** (Northfields) was named Broodmare of the Year. The 19-year-old is the dam of 10 foals to race, nine of them winners, with five graded-stakes runners and three millionaires; her leading performer to date is St. Jovite, a champion at two and three and European Horse of the Year in 1992. She was represented last year by L'Carriere, winner of the Saratoga Cup and runner-up in the GI Breeders' Cup Classic.

News cont.**RECORD HANDLE AT GULFSTREAM MEET**

Gulfstream Park completed its 64-day meeting Saturday, March 16, with an 9.5 percent increase in the daily average total commingled handle, establishing a Florida record of \$8,967,595. The on-track average showed a 1.9 percent gain; inter-track wagering was up 11.3 percent, and inter-state betting increased by 11.9 percent. Total handle for the meet was \$573,926,082, up 11.3 percent from 1995. Total on-track attendance was also up slightly, from 662,499 a year ago to 663,935 this year, but the daily average showed a small decline, dropping 1.3 percent to 10,374. Reviewing the meet, Gulfstream President and CEO Douglas Donn said, "The public response to Gulfstream's initiatives resulted in another successful season. Gulfstream's national stature continues to grow with our vast simulcasting network being responsible for an overall increase in wagering to establish a record. Our management and staff diligently will analyze surveys taken during the season in an effort to make Gulfstream even more customer-oriented in 1997." Jockey Jerry Bailey came from behind on closing day to edge Shane Sellers for the riding title. Bidding to lead the standings for the second straight year, Bailey booted home five winners Saturday to move his total for the meet to 97; Sellers was second with 96. Bill Mott led all trainers with 37 victories to take that title for the fourth year in a row. Allen Paulson topped the owner standings with 17 wins and \$695,108 in earnings.

SONIC LADY DEAD Sonic Lady (Nureyev), champion European filly of 1986, has died at Sheikh Mohammed's Dalham Hall Stud in Newmarket. She was 13. The former Michael Stoute-trainee won her only juvenile start. At three she captured the G1 Irish 1000 Guineas, G2 Coronation S., G1 Sussex S. and G1 Prix du Moulin de Longchamp. She retired after finishing third in the 1987 Breeders' Cup Mile with seven wins and four third-place finishes in 12 career starts for earnings of \$708,895. A Kentucky-bred who brought \$500,000 at the 1984 Fasig-Tipton Kentucky July Yearling Sale, Sonic Lady had also enjoyed a successful career as a broodmare. Her first two foals, Hazaam (Blushing Groom {Fr}) and Sharman (Blushing Groom {Fr}), have won Group 3 stakes in Europe; her last foal, a Machiavellian filly, was born February 8.

WORLD CUP COMPETITORS BREEZE Pentire (GB) (Be My Guest) performed his first piece of fast work under floodlights Monday as he gets ready for the \$4 million Dubai World Cup March 27. Partnered by regular jockey Michael Hills, the four-year-old began his breeze from the seven-furlong start; in company with stablemate **Young Buster (Ire)** (Teenoso), he was clocked going the final three furlongs in :38. "They both worked nicely and I am very pleased with them," said trainer Geoffrey Wragg. "I plan to give them a blow on Monday and then they will be spot on for race day." **Danewin (Aus)** (Danehill) also stretched his legs over the Nad Al Sheba sand Monday; the Australian hopeful breezed over 10 furlongs and also went the last three-eighths in :38. "The work was pleasing but not sensational at this stage, however he did have a good blow," said trainer Bob Thomsen. "He pulled up better than last time and we have still got a bit of work to do with him. I plan to do four more gallops between now and the day of the race."

WALLACE DOLLASE NAMED UTTA TRAINER OF THE MONTH Wallace Dollase, who has saddled the winners of seven stakes at the current Santa Anita meet, was named Trainer of the Month for February by the United Thoroughbred Trainers of America. Dollase, also named the February *Cobra Golf/Thoroughbred Daily News* Subscriber of the Month, captured four stakes last month, including the GI Strub with **Helmsman** (El Gran Senor), GII La Canada with **Jewel Princess** (Key to the Mint), and GII San Luis Obispo with **Windsharp** (Lear Fan). The award, co-sponsored by Vinery Farm of Midway, Kentucky, will be featured on a segment of ESPN's *Racehorse Digest*.

MARYLAND JOCKEY CLUB STRONG IN 1995

The Maryland Jockey Club and its two Thoroughbred tracks, Laurel Park and Pimlico Race Course, released financial statements yesterday which revealed that both tracks showed a profit in 1995. After incurring a loss of \$609,894 in 1994, Laurel reported net income of \$1,630,823 in 1995; Pimlico reported net income of \$2,525,216 last year, up from \$1,630,823 in 1994. Joseph De Francis, president and CEO of the MJC, credited last year's success to three factors. "First, the weather in 1995 was extremely favorable, with a very mild winter. Second, we improved the performance of our full-card simulcasting and off-track betting operations. Finally, we operated the overall business more efficiently, with improved financial controls instituted and overseen by our Chief Financial Officer, Jim Peterson, and our Controller, Doug Illig," he said. Looking forward to 1996, however, De Francis was cautious, saying, "The gains from full-card simulcasting and off-track betting appear to have peaked. Wagering, revenues and profits all declined slightly in the fourth quarter of 1995 as compared with the fourth quarter of 1994." Voicing concern about the impact of the Delaware slot machines which have been operating since the first of the year, he added, "We project that net income for the first two months of 1996 has declined by almost \$2 million over the comparable period in 1995, from a profit of \$696,457 in 1995 to a projected loss of \$1.3 million in 1996."

PASSERO TO ASK FOR HEARING Trainer Frank Passero, who has been charged with cruelty to animals for the alleged use of a substance known as "Fiery Jack" on the genitals of his horses, plans to ask for a hearing on the matter. Passero has hired two lawyers and said yesterday, "We're going full force at it." He added, "There's just no way" the substance, which contains a derivative of cayenne pepper, was used by any person on his horses' genitals and that the groom who made that statement has limited education and was "bulldozed" by investigators into signing a statement.
