STEVENS PREVAILS IN SANTA ANITA MATCH

Jockey Gary Stevens, riding speedster **Busy Banana** (GB) (Insan), was sent off at 2-5 to beat Julie Krone and **Richard Of England** (Tri Jet) in yesterday's \$40,000 match race at Santa Anita and did just that, taking the lead at the start of the 1 1/16th-mile event and holding it all the way to the wire to win by 2 3/4 lengths. "I pretty much sent him every jump of the way," said Stevens. "We really didn't get much of a chance for a breather. It's a lot like working horses in the morning. If you can get your horse's head stuck out in front, a lot of times the second-best horse will win. Anyway, it was a blast. The crowd got into it--it was a lot of fun."

L'CARRIERE SHARP IN DUBAI PREP Training under the floodlights for the first time, **L'Carriere** (Carr de Naskra) worked six furlongs with blinkers on at Nad Al Sheba yesterday, going the distance over the rain-soaked sand in 1:14 while racing near the middle of the track. "I'm very pleased with that work," said trainer H. James Bond. "That was a heck of a time on this track. The inside of the track is very mushy following (Friday's) rain, which is why we worked on the outside." **Danewin** (Aus) (Danehill) is scheduled to work out of the starting gate under the lights this evening. **Needle Gun** (Ire) (Sure Blade) will have a new jockey for the Dubai World Cup; Brett Doyle, currently the leading rider in the United Arab Emirates, has picked up the mount. **Cigar** (Palace Music) is set to breeze today. "The horse is well but obviously with the rain (Friday) I was only able to canter him steadily," said trainer Bill Mott. "He is a very relaxed horse who has taken the traveling in his stride."

HIALEAH PURSE DECREASE REVOKED John Van Lindt, executive vice president and general manager of Hialeah Park, announced yesterday that purses would return to original condition book levels beginning with today's card. Purses had been lowered in response to an injunction which prevented out-of-state simulcasting of the Hialeah signal. That matter is still before the courts. **News cont. p3**

Pharma was a troubled fifth in her last start, the GII Buena Vista March 2. Untroubled here, the mare took the lead after drifting out in the initial strides of the race; challenged by **BIS CAT** (NZ) (Defecting Dancer) through moderate fractions of :25 and :49 1/5, she drew off from that rival on the second turn and then held off **Angel In My Heart** at the wire. "She's a very strong mare," winning jockey Chris McCarron said after the race. "I had a lot of bad luck in her last race. The way **Matiara** won last time, I didn't know if I could beat her today. But one thing was relatively certain, and that was my trip. I was the only speed in there. It was a question of how much they would allow me to slow it down. The one thing we learned about her last effort--she has been relaxing much better in her last two or three races. Ron (Ellis) has done a great job of getting her to save that energy for the last two furlongs, and she was tough today." Winning trainer Ron Ellis had some doubts about his charge being successful in the Santa Ana. "I knew she was really coming into this race top-notch. We were a little worried that we couldn't beat a **Matiara**, but she was just training so good, Marty (Wygod) said to give it a shot. It didn't look like there was a lot of speed in this race, not like she has. I had a lot of confidence in her today. I usually shy away from a spot when I'm the third-choice, but I just felt really good about it today." Ellis said **Pharma** would probably not start again before the Hollywood Park meet. The 3-5 **Matiara**, compromised by the slow pace, finished third.

PARISELLA SETS TURFWAY STANDARD Trainer John Parisella, who tied the Turfway Park record for most wins in a single meet Thursday when he saddled his 31st winner of the current season, broke that mark Friday night when he sent out Shawklit Lover to take the fifth race and Instant Panic to take the eighth, bringing his total to 33 victories. "When I tied the record Thursday night it was such a good feeling, but I really wanted to just get it off my back," said Parisella. "I just kind of feel relieved now." The native New Yorker first brought a string to Turfway during the 1995 fall meet, and finished second in the trainer standings to D. Wayne Lukas. "I was a tremendous underdog when I came here," he remarked. "That's what makes this so special. The people in this area have spoiled me so much and really made me appreciate racing again; I'll be back at Turfway next fall for sure."

"ON CALL" EXPANDING FOR 1996 "On Call," the American Association of Equine Practitioners' media assistance program, will add the Olympic Games as well as an expanded schedule of races and arena events to its 1996 agenda. The program, which began in 1991, will provide nearly 20 veterinarians to more than 60 events during the upcoming year. The media-trained vets will furnish medical information and commentary to both print and broadcast media during both live network races and taped arena events; they will also respond to crisis situations and answers questions concerning veterinary medicine.

A # will distinguish first-time stakes-winners, a @ will indicate first-time graded stakes-winners, a + will denote winners who are first-time starters, an (S) will be used for state-bred races and an (R) will be used for other restricted races.
