JUMRON LIKELY TO BE RETIRED Charles W. Dunn's **Jumron (GB)** (Sharpo {GB}), winner of last year's GIII El Camino Real Derby and \$150,000 Golden State Derby, reinjured a tendon in a recent workout and will probably be retired, trainer Walter Greenman said Sunday. "When we really tested him, it was just too much," said Greenman, referring to a March 12 workout in which the four-year-old was timed in :46 1/5 for four furlongs. Greenman had hoped to launch Jumron's comeback in the \$60,000 Tokyo City Cup March 15 on Santa Anita's turf course. Jumron originally suffered the tendon injury last spring. The bay colt won five of nine career starts for earnings of \$404,380. His only off-the-board performance was a fourth-place finish in what may prove to be his final career start, the 1995 Kentucky Derby. According to Greenman, Jumron might be tried at stud in Dunn's home state of Washington.

ALLIED FORCES TO KENTUCKY DERBY It's a long way from Dubai to Louisville, but trainer Kiaran McLaughlin hopes to make the journey this spring with the first ever horse based in the Middle East to run in the Kentucky Derby. McLaughlin, a former assistant trainer to D. Wayne Lukas, said yesterday he plans to start a colt named **Allied Forces** (Miswaki) in the May 4 Run for the Roses. The horse is currently in training in Dubai, and has not raced since finishing second to English champion Alhaarth in the July 26 G3 Lanson Champagne Vintage S. at Goodwood. McLaughlin said he will not run Allied Forces before the Derby, but thinks the colt may be good enough to overcome the obvious obstacles. "He's a very nice horse," McLaughlin said. "I know it will be difficult to get him ready off such a long layoff, but with being here (in Dubai) with 75 horses it would be very hard for me to run him in a race like the Blue Grass. I'm hoping his best race will be his first one. He's had (unofficial) races here already, working seven furlongs in company with some nice horses." Bred in Florida, Allied Forces has won two of four lifetime starts, including a listed stakes at Newmarket last summer. He was sold after winning his career debut to current owner Ahmed Al Tayer for a sum believed to be in excess of 500,000 pounds (\$770,772).

Windsharp and Wandesta, the only fillies or mares in the GII San Luis Obispo H. at Santa Anita Feb. 19, finished one-two in that race over their male counterparts. They moved up to Grade I competition here and achieved the same results, both rallying from well back to finish within a neck of each other at the wire. Windsharp was given a clear outside trip by jockey Eddie Delahoussaye, while Wandesta encountered some traffic while trying to get through on the rail; the trip may have made the difference. "Corey (Nakatani) on the other mare (Wandesta) moved to the inside at the three-eighths pole," said Delahoussaye. "I went to the outside. My mare doesn't quicken that fast. So I figured I'd just stay out of trouble. Wandesta got through on the rail, and it looked like she was going to run by me. But this mare dug right back in and finished her off." Winning trainer Wally Dollase said, "The long range goal (for Windsharp) would be to win the mile-and-a-half Breeders' Cup Turf," but added that the mare's next start will probably be the GII Santa Barbara H. for fillies and mares at 1 1/4-miles on the turf April 20.

American-based entrants **Cigar** (Palace Music) and **Soul of the Matter** (Private Terms) worked under the floodlights in front of about 500 onlookers at Nad Al Sheba Sunday night. Reigning Horse of the Year Cigar went a half-mile in :49 1/5, while Soul of the Matter breezed the same distance in :52 2/5. Cigar's regular jockey Jerry Bailey said, "I don't think there will be much more pace than him. I think I'll be second or third early." The six-year-old's trainer Bill Mott added, "You've got to take the local horses seriously. The main reason is that we're on their sand now. Part of the challenge is to come halfway around the world, run on a different racetrack and meet new competitors. That's what it's all about. If everything was our own way, it wouldn't be a challenge."

Japanese challenger **Lively Mount (Jpn)** (Green Mount) was clocked in 1:04.75 for five furlongs Sunday. The five-year-old is the second richest horse in the field behind Cigar. He has won 10 of 21 starts for earnings of \$4,252,104.

Clive Brittain-trainee **Needle Gun (Ire)** (Sure Blade), the longest shot in the field at 100-1, breezed three furlongs in :40.90 yesterday and is scheduled to work again today with World Cup jockey Brett Doyle aboard.

Simon Crisford, Godolphin stable manager, considers Cigar the horse to beat. "I called Tom Albertrani (former assistant to Bill Mott, now assistant to Saeed bin Suroor) and asked him how to beat Cigar, since he's the only person who may know," Crisford said. "He said that if you really want to beat Cigar, all you have to do is close your eyes and keep dreaming."

A # will distinguish first-time stakes-winners, a @ will indicate first-time graded stakes-winners, a + will denote winners who are first-time starters and an (S) will be used for state-bred races.

Local News, England:

Danehill Dancer (Ire) (Danehill), officially the third-best European juvenile last season and a leading candidate for the British 2000 Guineas, is set to begin his 1996 campaign in the G3 Greenham S. at Newbury April 20. Neville Callaghan, the colt's Newmarket-based trainer, said: "I am happy with him so far and, if he continues to please me, he will most probably start off in the Greenham. I think we'll keep him to a mile this year. I cannot imagine he will be tried over further." Danehill Dancer is already a dual G1 winner. He collected the Heinz 57 Phoenix S. over six furlongs at Leopardstown and the National S. over seven furlongs at the Curragh before signing off his two-year-old career with a second to European champion juvenile and 2000 Guineas favorite Alhaarth in Newmarket's Dewhurst S. Oct. 13.

Two of the 10 live races on Saturday's program at Hialeah had to be canceled after horsemen scratched a total of 29 horses from the card in protest of the track's drastic purse cuts. The field for the second race was reduced to two and the field for the eighth reduced to three by late scratches and both races were called off. The purse for the featured GIII Widener H. was cut from \$200,000 to \$100,000, but all eight of the original entries competed. Hialeah responded to the horsemen's actions by immediately returning purses to their condition-book levels.
