**ROARING TOWARD LOUISVILLE** Two more horses moved from the land of pretenders to the land of contenders on the road to the May 4 Kentucky Derby yesterday, when **Roar** (Forty Niner) won the \$600,000 GII Jim Beam S. at Turfway Park, and **Romano Gucci** (Aaron's Concorde) remained undefeated after taking the GII Gotham S. at Aqueduct (see weekend results, p. 2). One-for-four as a two-year-old, Roar has come back with a vengeance at three, earning his third straight win with his Jim Beam effort. "It's a thrill to be back in the Derby hunt," said winning owner Seth Hancock, who owns and bred the colt in partnership with Adele Dilschneider. "A farm like ours is always geared to the Derby, and he's got to be one of the ones you'd give a chance to." Said trainer Shug McGaughey: "I would say he'll most likely go straight to the Derby, but if he pops out of it real good and we think we need to run again, we've always got the Lexington (April 21 at Keeneland) as a possibility." McGaughey found the key to the colt's turnaround when jockey Mike Smith told him he could hear the colt breathing loudly after he finished 4th in the Sept. 23 Kentucky Cup. After ending his year with an 8th-place finish in the Breeders' Futurity, McGaughey found the cure with a procedure called a myectomy. "He was displacing his soft palate, and it would cut his air off," said McGaughey. The procedure, done in his stall, took 15 minutes to correct the displaced soft palate. "The biggest thing I'm pleased with, condition-wise and looks-wise, is that he's going forward and he has been all winter." Trainer D. Wayne Lukas, who sent out the 4-5 favorite, **Victory Speech** (Deputy Minister) and the 4-1 third choice, **Dr. Caton** (Seattle Slew), saw his colts run 3rd and 7th, respectively. Gary Stevens, who rode the favorite, said he never seemed at ease on the surface yesterday. "He wasn't real comfortable with the racetrack all the way around," said Stevens. "As soon as I started pushing on him, he lost all his confidence and he just fell apart. After the race he wasn't tired at all." Lukas said his inclination would be to send Victory Speech straight to the Derby and that Dr. Caton may head to the Derby Trial and then the Preakness. Runner-up Ensign Ray will make his next start in the April 13 Bluegrass S. Turfway attracted its second-largest crowd in history, 19,552, and saw them wager \$2,874,210 on track for the third-largest on-track betting day in the track's history.

Roar broke well and sat just off the pace while three wide on the first turn. Inching up to the leader, Ensign Ray, down the backstretch, he took over entering the stretch and got clear late in an impressive performance. Victory Speech, up close early, was sent through on the rail entering the far turn and, despite vigorous asking by his rider, dropped back from the top two entering the stretch. DR. CATON (Seattle Slew) ducked out at the start, bumping APAK (Opening Verse) and tired at the end of the backstretch. Said rider Jerry Bailey: "He was just spinning his wheels from the time the gate opened. The harder he tried, the deeper he sank." CONNECTING TERMS (Private Terms) was scratched from the Jim Beam yesterday morning by trainer Elliott Walden due to his outside post position, and will instad point to either the Arkansas Derby or the Lexington S.

Romano Gucci was undefeated in his three previous starts including the GIII Best Turn in his last start Mar. 2. In his first start over six furlongs, the bay gelding recovered from an awkward beginning to set the pace, opening daylight in the stretch and then held on determinedly to remain undefeated. "Romano Gucci is a bit eccentric," said winning jockey Julie Krone. "Sometimes horses with more talent are like that. In the starting gate he hears and sees things. I made the decision (to go to the lead) and my horse was fast enough. He did it calmly and rated well. He just galloped to the spot. He skipped over the track, cut the corner and kicked in for me." Trainer Dick Dutrow said the Wood Memorial (Apr. 13) would be next for Romano Gucci.

Del Mar Dennis ran sixth as the favorite in the GIII New Orleans H. Mar. 10 in his last outing. Again the favorite, the gelding raced to the early lead, hooked up with Just Java on the second turn and narrowly held off that rival at the wire for his third straight San Bernardino H. win. Winning jockey Kent Desormeaux said, "About the eighth pole, he was ready to give way. I gave him some encouragement, and boy, he just found another gear. He really stuck his neck out. You could feel him getting tired and want to give way. But he is just about as game as they come."

**SMITHFIELD OUT OF SANTA ANITA DERBY**

Smithfield (Halo), who was pointing for the \$1 million Santa Anita Derby this Saturday, suffered a fractured sesamoid bone in his left front foot during a workout Friday morning and will be out of action indefinitely. Trainer Charlie Whittingham, who owns the three-year-old colt in partnership with Jack Mandato and Arthur B. Hancock, said Smithfield is likely to be sidelined six months to a year. "He was going easy, the track had just been harrowed and everything seemed to be fine," said Whittingham. "He must have just taken a bad step. It's unfortunate, but it happens." Second to **Odyle** (Alleged) in the GII San Felipe March 17, Smithfield worked five furlongs in 1:00 1/5 before returning to Whittingham's barn, where the injury was discovered. Whittingham said he had not ruled out starting **Corker** (Festin), a half-brother to 1994 Kentucky Derby runner-up **Strodes Creek** (Halo), in Smithfield's place Saturday. The colt, who has won one of five starts, was most recently third as the 4-5 choice in an March 23 allowance at Santa Anita.

**ROUGH QUEST TAKES GRAND NATIONAL**

**Rough Quest** (Ire) (Crash Course {GB}), second in the Cheltenham Gold Cup in his most recent start, won yesterday's Grand National at Aintree Racecourse in England by 1 1/4 lengths, but the 10-year-old gelding had to survive a stewards' inquiry after hampering the runner-up, **Encore Un Peu** (Fr) (Nikos {GB}), when reaching the front on the run from the final fence. After lengthy deliberations, however, officials allowed the result to stand. "They came a bit close together on the run-in," said trainer Terry Casey of the top two finishers. "But they were two tired horses. The horse was in fantastic form at home." Said jockey Mick Fitzgerald, "I've never been so frightened in my life as during the stewards' enquiry. It's one thing to win the race but then you think you might get it taken from you." **Superior Finish** (GB) (Oats {Ire}) was 16 lengths back in third.

While jockey agent Vince DeGregory was quoted as saying the rider intended to shift her tack to the West Coast after this year's Breeders' Cup, Krone said no final decision has been made. "I'm flattered that Vince DeGregory is excited at the possibility of my going to California," said Krone, "however my main concern is my business at hand right now. Yes, I loved California, but I have not seriously thought about moving my tack. That's not to say I may not at some future date, but I have no definite plans right now."
