MERLENE TAKES GOLDEN SLIPPER Danehill (Danzig) sired his third Golden Slipper winner in a row and trainer Lee Freedman saddled his fourth in a row when the two-year-old filly **Merlene (Aus)** (Danehill), the 15-4 second favorite, won the Australian race, worth \$1,545,356, by 1 1/2-lengths Saturday. The colt **Paint (Aus)** (Raami {GB}), sent off the 13-4 favorite, was second, with **Flavour (Aus)** (Rubiton {Aus}) a length back in third. Bought for only \$77,268 by owners Kerry Packer and Lloyd Williams, Merlene earned \$944,599 for her victory. She has now won four of five career starts for earnings of \$1,050,997. However, the filly's victory came at a high price for winning jockey Greg Hall, who received the maximum fine of \$38,634 and a two-month suspension for allowing Merlene to shift out on the turn for home, causing serious interference to five other runners. The stewards stated that Hall committed a "blatant" act and that they would have liked to have fined him his whole win percentage of \$47,230. "If we had the discretion to fine you your percentage, we would have done so," they told him. On the same card at Rosehill racetrack in Sydney, Australia Saturday, the three-year-old colt **Octagonal (NZ)** (Zabeel {NZ}) won the \$772,678 Mercedes Classic over 1 1/2-miles. Octagonal, last year's Champion Two-Year-Old in Australia, is owned by Jack and Bob Ingham's Woodlands Stud and is trained by John Hawkes. He will go on to the 1 1/2-mile Australian Derby next weekend. *(Full Australian stakes results will be in tomorrow's TDN)*

LEXINGTON STAKES NEXT FOR COBRA KING **Cobra King** (Farma Way), eighth as the 9-5 favorite in the March 16 Florida Derby, galloped Sunday at Churchill Downs and will be pointed to the GII \$150,000 Lexington S. at Keeneland April 21, according to trainer Mike Puype. "We missed a couple days of training, but he's back galloping," Puype said. "He's had a combination of minor and aggravating problems, but nothing serious." The three-year-old colt had been pointing to the GII \$500,000 Toyota Blue Grass S. April 13, but pulled up sore following a workout over a deep, rain-soaked Churchill surface early last week. Puype opted for the 1 1/16-mile Lexington rather than the 1 1/8-mile Blue Grass because it gives the MGSW a little more time and looks to be a softer spot. "I think that's what he needs right now if we still have hope of making the (Kentucky) Derby," Puype added. Also confirmed yesterday for the Lexington S. was GIII San Vicente S. winner **Afleetaffair** (Afleet).

Tychonic (GB) was 4-5 to score his fifth straight stakes victory and his second in graded company and he did not let his backers down. The bay followed longshot SCORE QUICK (Northern Score) through a half in a moderate :47 2/5, pulled past that rival as they raced around the far turn, then turned back the challenge of Debutant Trick and drew clear under a Gary Stevens hand ride. "I just get him out of the gate and let him pretty much dictate to me what he wants to do," said Stevens. "He's got a lot of confidence and he just kind of gives you one of those armchair rides. You don't have a lot of worries with him." Trainer Bobby Frankel said of the former high-priced claimer, who raced for as low as \$80,000 last August, "He was a \$50,000 horse when I got him--(Juddmonte) wasn't even going to send him to me. He was in a sale but I looked at him and said, 'Man, that's a good-looking horse...send him to me' and they did. It just took a long time for him to come around." The budding turf star could make his next start in the GIII San Simeon H. April 22.

Saturday, Oaklawn Park:

OAKLAWN H.-GI, \$750,000, 4yo/up, 1 1/8m

Trainer Bill Mott may send two postward in the Oaklawn H. "Don't be surprised if **Geri** (Theatrical {Ire}) runs in the Handicap along with **Wekiva Springs** (Run-away Groom)," said Ralph Nicks, assistant to Mott. Four-year-old Geri has won his last five starts, including the Gill Creme Fraiche H. at Gulfstream March 16. Wekiva Springs took the GI \$500,000 Gulfstream Park H. in his most recent outing March 2. Scheduled to arrive in Hot Springs Wednesday on the same flight as Geri and Wekiva Springs is **Halo's Image** (Halo). The five-year-old has started only twice this year, defeating Wekiva Springs by a nose in the Gill Broward H. Jan. 13 then finishing second by 5 1/4-lengths to Geri in the Creme Fraiche. A charter flight of four horses, including Santa Anita H. winner and runner-up **Mr Purple** (Deputy Minister) and **Luthier Fever** (Mt. Livermore), was expected to arrive at Hot Springs Municipal Airport Sunday morning at 10 a.m. Mr Purple will be ridden Saturday by his Big 'Cap jockey Eddie Delahoussaye. The consistent **Vindictive Silence** (Orbit Dancer), winner of six of his last eight starts, including stakes at Remington Park, Trinity Meadows and Sam Houston, has been confirmed for the race by trainer and co-owner Jim Baldwin. Another possible starter is the six-year-old mare **Halo America** (Waquoit), who, with a victory, would become the first filly or mare to win the race, which was introduced in 1946. "I'm not saying we are going to run Halo America, just don't be surprised if she shows up in the entries," trainer Bobby Barnett said. "She is nominated to both the Oaklawn H. and the Apple Blossom (April 12). Anyway, Mr. Franks (owner John Franks) and I are discussing the race."

WIDENER CONTENDERS COMPENSATED According to a report in today's *Daily Racing Form*, officials at Hialeah have announced they will restore the purse of the March 23 Gill Widener H. to its original value of \$200,000, and will distribute the additional funds to the top five finishers in the race. The nine-furlong event had its purse cut in half, to \$100,000, after Hialeah was temporarily forced to stop sending its simulcasting signal due to a court order. The injunction was lifted Tuesday. The first five under the wire in the Widener, in order, were **Mecke** (Maudlin), **Personal Merit** (Turkoman), **Jelly Roll Jive** (Prosper Fager), **Paragram** (Miswaki) and **Shan's Ready** (Shananie). The *DRF* also

reported that the purse for the Patricia S., won by **Lulu's Ransom** (Red Ransom) March 23, will also be raised from \$35,000 to its original value of \$50,000. Trainer Manny Tortora saddled both Mecke and Lulu's Ransom to their respective victories.

LAUREL WRAP-UP Laurel Park wrapped up its 56-day winter/spring meeting Sunday with a 5.1 percent downswing in total betting when compared with the similar session in 1995. Bad weather was blamed for most of the decline during the meeting, which began Jan. 1. Cancellations due mostly to snowstorms caused the 1996 meet to operate seven fewer days than in 1995. As a result, the total Maryland mutuel handle was \$120,536,428, compared to \$126,975,051 last year. Joe De Francis, CEO at Laurel and Pimlico, said yesterday that the final figures were "not as bad as we had feared, but they were not exceptional. Given the weather and what is happening in Delaware, the Laurel meeting was hurt." De Francis was referring to the introduction of slot machines, which have now been legalized for operation at racetracks in Delaware. Maryland racing now switches to Pimlico Racecourse, which opens Tuesday.

REGAL DISCOVERY BACK HOME Last year's Queens Plate winner **Regal Discovery** (Regal Classic) was expected to clear quarantine yesterday afternoon. The four-year-old was flown to New Jersey from Dubai following his disappointing finish in last Wednesday's \$500,000 Dubai Duty Free S. Trainer Roger Attfield said the Canadian-bred will now be shipped to Lexington for the Keeneland spring meet. Regal Discovery finished ninth to **Key Of Luck** (Chief's Crown) in the 1 1/4-mile race at Nad al Sheba Racecourse. "We knew it was going to be a very difficult race going in," Attfield said. "It was a very tough field, but I thought he'd run a lot better than he did. Jerry Bailey (his jockey) told me that the horse just didn't handle the deep going at all." Despite the outcome of the race, Attfield said the trip was well worth the effort. "It was a tremendous experience in Dubai, and we were treated so very well. The track is just beautiful and I'd have to say the beaches were as good, if not better, than anything you'd find in the Caribbean. Our whole stay was just sheer luxury."

Signal Tap, unraced since finishing a dismal 11th over a boggy turf in the GI Breeders' Cup Turf last October, had finished on the board in every other grass start, including a solid third in last year's GI Man o' War. Finding himself on firm footing once again for his return, the bay proved the Breeders' Cup performance a fluke as he rallied from far back to outfinish Copy Editor for his first stakes triumph.

"He's been super ever since we got him on the turf last year," said Randy Schulhofer, assistant to his dad, trainer Scotty Schulhofer. "Dad has been pointing him for this race all along. It was great to get it in before the rain--we would have been very concerned if the course had come up soft." The five-year-old will start next in the Hialeah Turf Cup April 20.

Kristy Krunch ended his juvenile season with a win in the mile-and-a-sixteenth Kingarvie S. over this track but had not fared well in his first two starts at three, finishing off the board in a pair of Maryland sprint stakes. Ignored at the windows upon his return home, the bay was last for a quarter but accelerated to sweep past the field on the far turn and lead them all home for a handy victory over the crowd's odds-on choice. It was the first stakes win for apprentice jockey Neil Poznansky; long-term plans for the colt include a Queen's Plate bid. GOMTUU (Hail the Ruckus), last year's Canadian champion and second choice at even money, showed speed early but faded to fifth and pulled up lame. His jockey, Jim McAleney, said it felt like the champ injured his left front leg a few jumps past the wire; Gomtuu was vanned off and no report on his condition was immediately available.

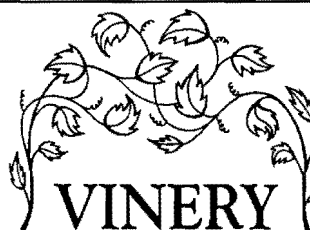

Corker (Festin {Arg}), a half-brother to Strodes Creek, will replace the injured Smithfield for trainer Charlie Whittingham in Saturday's \$1 million Santa Anita Derby. Another addition to the field is GIII Louisiana Derby fourth-place finisher **EC's Dream** (Incinderator). Both three-year-olds worked five furlongs Sunday at Santa Anita. Corker was timed in 1:02 2/5, and EC's Dream went in 1:03 3/5.

Serena's Song (Rahy) and **Twice the Vice** (Vice Regent), one-two in the GI Santa Maria H. Feb. 17, both worked Sunday at Santa Anita in preparation for the GI \$500,000 Apple Blossom H. April 12 at Oaklawn Park. **Serena's Song** drilled seven furlongs in 1:25 2/5, and **Twice the Vice** breezed a mile in 1:41 4/5.

Two-time Pacific Classic winner **Tinners Way** (Secretariat), off since his seventh-place finish in the Oct. 28 Breeders' Cup Classic, returned to the work tab yesterday with a three-furlong breeze in :38 2/5 for trainer Bobby Frankel at Hollywood Park.
