PIMLICO OPENS TODAY Pimlico Race Course opens for its 1996 Spring Meeting this afternoon, offering free grandstand admission and free programs to its opening-day patrons and showcasing three-year-olds in the featured \$30,000 Harriman S. at five furlongs. The Baltimore oval will be dark Mondays and most Wednesdays, as well as Easter Sunday, April 7; Tuesday, May 14; Sunday, May 19; and Tuesday, May 28; the track will be open for a live card Wednesday, May 15. Post time will be 1:00 p.m. Eastern everyday except Preakness Day, May 18, when the first race will go off at 11:00 a.m. Highlighting the 50-day meet are the GI Pimlico Special May 11, the GII Black-Eyed Susan S. May 17 and the GI Preakness and GII Early Times Dixie May 18. The meeting runs through June 9.

NOT SURPRISING BAFFLES HIS TRAINER

Trainer Judson Van Worp is still puzzled by the two lackluster performances that his 1995 Sprint Champion **Not Surprising** (Medieval Man) has put in this year. The six-year-old was fifth in the Deputy Minister H. in his '96 debut, and sixth last time out in the Dade County S. at Hialeah March 24. "We got him back (to Tampa Bay Downs) after the Dade County, and he scoped clean," said Van Worp. "We went over him from top to bottom and couldn't find a thing wrong with him. The only thing I can think of is that he just resented being up on the pace and down along that deep rail." The Eclipse Award winner will ship back to Hialeah Thursday and try to break out of his slump in Saturday's \$50,000 Hialeah Sprint Championship, a seven-furlong event which he captured last year.

Saturday, Santa Anita Park

SANTA ANITA DERBY-GI, \$1,000,000, 3yo, 9f

Trainer D. Wayne Lukas sent both of his Santa Anita Derby hopefuls for their final tune-ups yesterday. **Honour And Glory** (Relaunch) went five furlongs in 1:01 3/5 while stablemate **Prince Of Thieves** (Hansel) went the same distance in 1:00 4/5; jockey Gary Stevens was aboard for both works. "They were nice, solid maintenance-type works," said Lukas. "I told Gary the only mistake he could make was to go too fast. Afterward he said, 'I'm not sure which one I like more'." Stevens will ride San Rafael S. winner Honour and Glory Saturday; Shane Sellers will be up on Prince Of Thieves. Cal-bred **Cavonnier** (Batonnier) worked a bullet six furlongs in 1:11 3/5 Monday; Chris McCarron has the mount. The rest of the expected field, with jockeys, will be: **Corker** (Festin {Arg}), Desormeaux; **Alyrob** (Alysheba), Nakatani; **Matty G** (Capote), Solis; **Super Mining** (Mining), Antley; **E C's Dream** (Incinderator), Pincay Jr.; and possibly **Strangelove** (World Appeal), no rider. The Santa Anita Derby will be televised as the featured segment on ABC's *Wide World Of Sports*; post time is scheduled for 2:10 p.m. PST.

Saturday, Hialeah Park

FLAMINGO S.-GIII, \$200,000, 3yo, 9f

A field of nine looks likely for the Flamingo, headed by Fountain Of Youth winner **Built For Pleasure** (Homebuilder). The colt, 143-1 in the Fountain Of Youth, disappointed at 15-1 when seventh in the GI Florida Derby last time out. Also expected to start are supplemental nominee **Bold Lachee** (Apalachee), **Cat On Tour** (Tour d'Or), **Laughing Dan** (Premiership), **Play It Again Stan** (Big Stanley), **Premier Majesty** (Waquoit), **Representative** (North Prospect), **Tour's Big Red** (Tour d'Or) and **Will's Way** (Easy Goer). Laughing Dan took an allowance race at Hialeah Sunday, but trainer Luis Olivares said the Cobbleview Stable runner would "probably" run back on five days rest. Undefeated Will's Way, an impressive allowance winner at Gulfstream in his last, is scheduled to work today; two-for-two, the colt did not make his debut until February and steps up to stakes company for the first time Saturday. "I might not normally jump up to spot like the Flamingo, but he is special, the timing is right and we're here," said trainer H. James Bond.

LAST WEEK'S TRIPLE CROWN CONTENDERS

Trainer Shug McGaughey has corrected a breathing problem which hindered **Roar's** (Forty Niner) performances at a route of ground last year and the colt responded in Saturday's nine-furlong GII Jim Beam S. at Turfway to post his first two-turn victory in decisive fashion. "I had plenty of horse left," said his jockey, Mike Smith. "He won nice and comfortable. I'm sure he'll get stronger off this race." The colt came out of the race in good order and will continue his Derby preparations at Keeneland; McGaughey indicated he could head straight to the "Run for the Roses" or come back in the Lexington S. April 21. **Ensign Ray** (Blue Ensign), second in the Beam at odds of 38-1, will also head to Keeneland and may surface next in the Toyota Blue Grass April 13. The Team Lukas runners, **Victory Speech** (Deputy Minister), a disappointing third as the 4-5 favorite, and **Dr. Caton** (Seattle Slew), seventh, returned to their home base at Churchill Downs Saturday evening, and their trainer said neither colt handled the surface well at Turfway. Victory Speech still has a ticket to the Derby and could start without another prep; as for stablemate Dr. Caton, D. Wayne Lukas said, "We're not going to push him." **Best Secret** (Fiery Best) was nominated to the Triple Crown for \$6,000 after his fourth-place finish in the Jim Beam. The colt vans back to Florida Wednesday, and will likely be flown back for the Derby in mid-April. **Pugnacious** (Sunny's Halo), six-length winner of the Rushaway S. on the Beam undercard, will go next in the Arkansas Derby April 13.

In New York Saturday, **Romano Gucci** (Aaron's Concorde) ran his record to four-for-four with a half-length win in the GII Gotham at a mile. The gelding was also nominated to the Triple Crown after the victory, and will go next in the Wood Memorial April 13. "I don't think anyone dreamed we had a Triple Crown horse," said trainer Dick Dutrow. **Feather Box** (Cherokee Colony), third in the Gotham, was also a late Triple Crown nominee and will also point for the Wood.

A total of six horses opted for the \$6,000 late nomination fee for the Triple Crown, which closed Saturday (the fee earns a nomination to each of the three Triple Crown races; it is not \$6,000 each for the Kentucky Derby, Preakness and Belmont Stakes, as may have been indicated in the *TDN* Stakes Closings Box). In addition to Romano Gucci, Feather Box and Best Secret, **Harrowman** (Dawn Quixote), **Jewelled Road** (Cahill Road) and **Zarb's Magic** (Zarbyev) also nominated Saturday.

Thundering Storm (Storm Brewing), winner of the Tampa Bay Derby, will make his next start in the GIII Federico Tesio at Pimlico April 20. "If he runs impressively there, maybe we could consider the Preakness," said trainer Don Rice.
