NO QUICK ANSWER IN SHERGAR MYSTERY

John Flynn, head of the Weatherby's Bloodtyping Laboratories in County Kildare, the group charged with determining if a recently exhumed corpse of a horse in Ireland is that of **Shergar (Ire)** (Great Nephew {GB}), told the *Racing Post* Thursday that the process would not be a quick one. "The potential is there for a 100 percent, unequivocal identification that the carcass is that of Shergar, but there is a very long and difficult time ahead," Flynn told the paper. "A DNA profile has to be built from the carcass and that has then to be matched up with the DNA profiles from other material, sources of hair which have come to light, and the horse's offspring. It would be marvelous if the whole thing could be resolved, but at this stage I would rather be pessimistic than optimistic." England's champion colt in 1981, Shergar was kidnapped in 1983 from an Irish stud farm.

ALHAARTH CLOSE TO RETURN **Alhaarth (Ire)**

(Unfuwain), the top two-year-old in Europe last season, is likely to make his three-year-old debut in the G3 Greenham S. at Newbury April 20. Undefeated in five starts as a juvenile, the colt has not raced since taking the G1 Dewhurst S. going seven furlongs at Newmarket last October 13. "If the ground is good, he is almost certain to run in the Greenham," said trainer Dick Hern. "If the weather turns bad, however, it may have to be the G3 Craven S. (April 18) at Newmarket instead. I'd rather it be Newbury if at all possible because it's level weights." Alhaarth is currently the ante-post favorite for both the 2000 Guineas at Newmarket May 4 and the Vodafone Derby at Epsom June 8.

THORO-GRAPH ANALYSIS by Jerry Brown

The Oaklawn H. features a strong group of older horses, many of whom have run very big Thoro-Graph figures over the last few months. **Halo's Image** (Halo) ran the best race of his life two starts back, bounced last time, and figures to take quite a while to come around again. **Mr Purple** (Deputy Minister) ran his lifetime best last time, and will probably suffer the same fate. The Mott trainees, **Geri** (Theatrical {Ire}) and **Wekiva Springs** (Runaway Groom), are a little slower, although far more solid. But neither is worth taking at a short price in a wide-open event.

The interesting horse is **Judge T C** (Judge Smells), who ran an enormous figure (1) in December, then tailed off--although able to get a win and a couple of seconds while doing so. Now he looks ready again to fire a good one and, at a price, we'll take a shot. The Thoro-Graph play is Judge T C to win, protecting with exactas underneath both Mott horses. *The Thoro-Graph handicapper's line offers analyses and suggested plays for six major tracks daily. "DERBY OF THE DECADE" IN AUSTRALIA

Today's 135th AJC Derby at Randwick in Sydney, Australia, has been billed as the "Derby Of The Decade" with the nation's three leading contenders for the title of Champion Three-Year-Old, **Octagonal (NZ)** (Zabeele {NZ}), **Nothin' Leica Dane** (Danehill) and **Saintly (Aus)** (Sky Chase {NZ}), taking each other on in the \$772,678 mile-and-a-half contest. "This will be a race you'll want to tell your grandchildren about," promised Nothin' Leica Dane's trainer, Gai Waterhouse. "It's got all the ingredients of a truly wonderful race that only comes along once in a lifetime." The only time these three horses have met was in the mile-and-a-quarter G1 Rosehill Guineas March 23, when Octagonal won narrowly from Saintly and Nothin' Leica Dane. Octagonal is even-money favorite at present, having also won last weekend's G1 Mercedes Classic in Sydney. His shrewd trainer John Hawkes said: "It's going to be another great race, but Octagonal will win. Nothin' Leica Dane and Saintly are both good horses, but Octagonal is better. It's as simple as that. The only thing that can beat him is bad luck."

BILL MOTT: "COBRA GOLF/TDN SUBSCRIBER OF THE MONTH"

Bill Mott, who achieved the training feat of the century in winning the inaugural \$4 million Dubai World Cup with **Cigar** (Palace Music) just weeks after a foot abscess caused the horse to miss 11 days of training, has been named the *Cobra Golf/Thoroughbred Daily News Subscriber of the Month* for March. Mott will receive a set of King Cobra Golf Clubs, the country's leading oversize irons and woods, in recognition of the honor. Mott, who led the national trainer standings through March with earnings of \$4,356,069, also won the GI Gulfstream Park H. with **Wekiva Springs** (Runaway Groom), the GIII Fort Lauderdale H. with **Winged Victory** (Nijinsky II), and the GIII Creme Fraiche H. with **Geri** (Theatrical {Ire}). His total earnings for the month of March alone reached nearly \$3 million. "We're pleased and proud to present this award to Bill," said Cobra Golf Chairman Gary Biszantz. "With Cigar's historic win in Dubai, he and owner Allen Paulson not only made the sport of horse racing proud, but they made the entire country proud."

GOMTUU RETIRED According to a report in today's *Daily Racing Form*, last year's Canadian champion two-year-old **Gomtuu** (Hail The Ruckus) has been retired after suffering a fracture in his left knee Sunday. The colt pulled up lame after finishing fifth in the final start of his career, the Friar Rock S. at Woodbine; he underwent surgery Monday at Canada's University of Guelph.
