### CAL-BRED MAKES GOOD IN SANTA ANITA DERBY

He was named the champion California-bred two-year-old male of 1995 but the crowd put little emphasis on the accomplishment and let Cavonnier (Batonnier) go off at 10-1 in yesterday's GI \$1,000,000 Santa Anita Derby. Undaunted by the odds, the gelding overcame traffic trouble to split a seam at the top of the stretch and carry jockey Chris McCarron to a 1 3/4-length victory over the late-closing Alyrob (Alysheba). "I was confident that he had a shot to win, but I knew he would have to improve and he did," said McCarron. "He improved lengths today." His trainer, Bob Baffert, will book a flight to Kentucky. "If it looks like he's training strong, we've got to take a shot at the Derby," he said. "I've never made it this far, but I've had Derby Fever before. There's so much luck involved. It's a long way off, and we've got to keep him healthy--that's the main part. Right now, I just want to sit here and enjoy this moment." Alyrob, returning from throat surgery, was off a step slowly, found himself in a jam on the far turn and came out into Matty G (Capote) looking for running room; he found it and finished well to get second, but was disqualified and placed last for his actions. "I was ecstatic with the way he ran and I thought the stewards made the right call," said trainer Wally Dollase, who added that he would like to take the colt to Churchill if he can earn a spot in the gate on Derby Day. "Moneywise, he may not qualify, but he deserves to be in that race," said Dollase. Trainer D. Wayne Lukas had a disappointing day as even-money Honour And Glory (Relaunch) pressed the pace but could do not better than third, 6 1/2 lengths behind the runner-up; he was moved up to second by the stewards. Prince Of Thieves (Hansel) finished a tiring sixth; moved up to fifth, he was found to have bled. "It wasn't a lot, but it was enough to compromise the way he finished," said Lukas of Prince Of Thieves. "We'll treat him with Lasix for the Derby." Honour and Glory also heads to Kentucky.

**GREER GARSON DEAD AT 92** Academy Award-winning actress Greer Garson, co-owner of 1971 Horse of the Year Ack Ack (Battle Joined), died Saturday of heart failure at the Dallas Presbyterian Hospital. Garson owned Ack Ack in partnership with her late husband, oilman E. E. Buddy Fogelson; they raced under the stable name Forked Lightning Ranch.

Coming off a solid third-place finish after setting the pace in the GII San Felipe, Cavonnier this time let 96-1 SUPER MINING (Mining) and even-money Honour And Glory cut out the early fractions. Tucked in behind horses to the top of the stretch, the dark bay responded when swung out for racing room and had no trouble getting past the tiring favorite to earn himself a trip to see the Twin Spires of Churchill. "When I was asked, 'What if you win the Santa Anita Derby--what are you going to do?' I said, 'I'll probably run naked through the backside.' It's going to be an ugly sight, that's all I can say," laughed trainer Bob Baffert. Alyrob, who suffered through a troubled trip in his first start in two months, came on once in the clear but found himself under the scrutiny of the stewards for drifting out into MATTY G (Capote) in upper stretch. Trainer D. Wayne Lukas felt Honour And Glory lost his chance in the speed duel. "He ran big under a lot of pressure," he said. "Super Mining just stayed there and stayed there. Gary (Stevens) said he was kissing and chirping, bootin' and scootin' every step...he could just never get in front of him--that was that. He ran well to be third."

His streak does not yet rival that of stablemate Cigar,  
but Geri ran his skein to six straight in taking his first  
Grade I appearance. The lightly raced chestnut colt  
came back from a seven-month vacation in January and  
put together three victories at Gulfstream, then shipped  
to Arkansas for a sterner test here. Never doubted by  
the crowd as the 6-5 favorite, Allen Paulson's homebred  
settled in sixth for a half, moved up to challenge for the  
lead under his own courage on the far turn, then put  
away fellow Bill Mott trainee Wekiva Springs to pocket  
his biggest paycheck to date, more than triple his previ-  
ous career earnings. Asked if the winner would meet  
Cigar in the future, Mott said, "I hope so--at least once,  
in the Breeders' Cup Classic." Geri could head to New  
York for the Met Mile May 27, while Wekiva Springs  
may go to Maryland for the Pimlico Special May 11.

**OCTAGONAL TAKES AJC DERBY** Winning his  
fourth G1 event in a row, Woodlands Stud's **Octagonal**  
(NZ) (Zabeel {NZ}), bred at Cambridge Stud and trained  
by John Hawkes, won the \$772,678 AJC Derby over  
12 furlongs at Randwick in Australia yesterday. Last  
year's champion Australian two-year-old was timed in  
2:28.41, more than two seconds faster than the old  
race record set by Dulcify in 1979. Ridden by Darren  
Beadman, the 9-10 favorite had to battle hard to over-  
haul **Saintly (Aus)** (Sky Chase {NZ}) by a head, with  
**Filante (NZ)** (Star Way {GB}) third. Said trainer Hawkes:  
"What can I say about him? He's a champion and that's  
it. He doesn't win by much, but then he didn't have to.  
The horse has an unbelievable will to win. They've  
either got it or they haven't and that's what separates  
him from the rest." Beadman, who has ridden Octagonal  
to all four G1 victories, added: "I can't believe it. He's a  
sensational horse. At the 100-metre mark I wasn't sure,  
but at the 50 metres I knew we had it. He just doesn't

Bay Derby last time he ran, was this time the third  
choice in a field of nine but proved much the best. "We  
were planning on being third or fourth early, but he  
broke so good...I just went ahead," said jockey Ramon  
Perez. "I felt confident all the way around that we were  
going to win." Jack Smith, co-owner of El Amante, said  
the colt could make his next start in the Illinois Derby  
May 11. Runner-up **Bold Lachee**, who was supple-  
mented to the Flamingo, will ship north to Pimlico for  
the GIII Federico Tesio April 20. "We're looking at sup-  
plementing him to the Preakness," said co-owner James  
Marini. **Will's Way**, bet down to even-money in his third  
start and his stakes debut, made a move at the leader at  
the top of the lane but faded to third in the drive. "He  
just needs more seasoning," said jockey Craig Perret.
