**DELAWARE PARK OPENS TODAY** Thoroughbred racing returns to the oldest track in the Delaware Valley today as Delaware Park opens for its 59th season of racing, the first since slot machines were installed at the track last December 29. The 130-day meet will feature live racing Tuesdays, Wednesdays, Saturdays and Sundays, with first post at 12:45 p.m. and free admission and parking daily. Thursdays will be added to the live calendar in August, and there will also be racing at the track Memorial Day, July 4 and Labor Day. Daily average overnight purses for the first condition book are set at \$132,000, up from \$92,000 at the end of the 1995 live season. The 1996 stakes schedule, worth over \$1 million, will be highlighted by the \$200,000 Delaware H., to be run Sunday, July 14. The Delaware meet closes November 10.

**WINDSHARP PROBABLE FOR SAN JUAN CAPISTRANO** Looking to beat the boys for the third straight time, **Windsharp** (Lear Fan) is pointing for the GI San Juan Capistrano H. at Santa Anita April 21. "We're leaning towards running her in the San Juan," said trainer Wally Dollase, "but we haven't ruled out the Santa Barbara (April 20). We won't make a decision until early next week." The five-year-old Windsharp captured the GII San Luis Obispo and the GI San Luis Rey in her last two starts; **Wandesta** (GB) (Nashwan), the only other distaffer in those events, finished second both times but will make her next start in the GI Santa Barbara, a race she won last year.

**ITALIAN CHAMP READY FOR RETURN** **Glory Of Dancer** (GB) (Shareef Dancer), last year's Highweight Colt at Two in Italy and one of eight colts supplemented to the 1996 Epsom Derby at a cost of \$12,180 this week, is to make his first British appearance in the G3 Thresher Classic Trial at Sandown Park April 27. **Glory Of Dancer** captured the G1 Gran Criterium at Milan when trained in Italy last season; he joined the stable of Newmarket-based Paul Kelleway about 10 weeks ago.

Turning the tables on last year's champion three-year-old filly **Serena's Song**, **Twice The Vice** avenged a loss in the GI Santa Maria H. February 17. Trying the slop for the first time, the winner of the GI Santa Margarita H. in her last picked up her second consecutive Grade I victory, closing from just off the pace of the speedy **Halo America** to take command in the stretch and draw clear under jockey Chris McCarron. "I had no clue whether this filly would like the mud or not," said McCarron. "Her trainer doesn't even work his horses if the track comes up sloppy. As we headed into the first turn she got splashed and threw her head a little, but then she set her head down and...I knew she was going to give me her best. The rest of the trip all I did was act like I was earning my money." Trainer Ronald Ellis said, "This concludes the first half of her campaign. My plans are to take her home, let her catch her breath, and then we will plan the rest of the year, winding up--we hope--in the Breeders' Cup." The runner-up, who was also second in this event last year, turned back a challenge from odds-on **Serena's Song** at the quarter-pole but could not answer when headed by the winner. **Serena's Song** suffered back-to-back losses for the first time since September 3, 1994. "She didn't have as much energy today," said her jockey, Gary Stevens. "I don't know if it was the trip getting here, but she wasn't as active in the post parade as normal. I was always in a position to get by the leader (but) she just didn't give me any late move."

Unbridled's Song (Unbridled) galloped a steady 1 3/8 miles at Aqueduct Friday. The gallop represented a change in plans for the Florida Derby winner, who had been slated to blow out through the lane. "We change plans quite often, given enough time to think about it," smiled trainer Jim Ryerson. "Actually, his schedule was all thrown off with the day we missed because of the snow. I didn't want to blow him out after a day off, which ruled Thursday out, and then we normally don't breeze him that close to a race. He'd never blown out the day before a race, and after some thought we decided against it." Others who missed workouts: GII Gotham S. winner Romano Gucci (Aaron's Concorde) and Cherry Hill Mile winner In Contention (Devil's Bag). *The Wood Memorial will be televised live on ABC-TV; post time is scheduled for 5:05 p.m. EDT.*

#### THORO-GRAPH ANALYSIS by Jerry Brown

Clearly the horse to beat in the Arkansas Derby is Team Lukas' Grindstone (Unbridled), the morning-line favorite. In his second start this year he won the Louisiana Derby with a lifetime best figure of 5 1/2. Three-year-olds tend to pair up top efforts in the spring, and with a month's rest, this one should do just that.

The live longshot in the race is Beefchopper (Farma Way), who had a nice pattern as a two-year-old, getting down to a couple of 8s late in the year. He didn't make his '96 debut until March, when he won a two-turn stake with a 6. Lifetime efforts following a layoff are tricky to evaluate, since they sometimes cause a bounce, but at a price we'll take our chances. Although they both got the worst of the draw, the play is a box of Grindstone and Beefchopper. *The Thoro-Graph handicapper's line offers analyses and suggested plays for six major tracks daily.
