GRAYS LEAD THE WAY TO THE

DERBY It wasn't the clouds over Kentucky and New York that made Saturday a gray day for racing. It was steel-hued **Unbridled's Song** (Unbridled) underlining his star status for the May 4 Kentucky Derby with an effortless performance in the GII Wood Memorial at Aqueduct, and the speedy grey **Skip Away** (Skip Trial) skipping over a Keeneland track labeled wet-fast to capture the GII Toyota Blue Grass by six widening lengths that colored the afternoon. Unbridled's Song has undoubtedly nailed down the dubious role of Derby favorite after toying with his rivals in the Wood. Sent off at 1-5, the long-striding colt haunted front-runner **Romano Gucci** (Aaron's Concorde) through moderate fractions, then put that one away as they headed around the far turn and was only asked to run in the final yards when jockey Mike Smith heard the hoofsteps of 12-1 **In Contention** (Devil's Bag). "He did seem to want company today," said Smith. "But when (In Contention) started to get to him a little, I shook him up and he went right back into the bridle." Added trainer Jim Ryerson, "He got to loafing and they started running at him. But he got the job done. There are more important things ahead. He wasn't 100 percent and he didn't run like it, but he can go forward off of this race." Unbridled's Song has several obstacles to overcome before he can find his way to the winner's circle on Derby Day. It has been 15 years since a Wood winner captured the "Run for the Roses" (Pleasant Colony-1981), 17 years since a favorite has prevailed (Spectacular Bid-1979), and no winner of the Breeders' Cup Juvenile has ever accomplished the double. But four of the last six Kentucky Derby winners have come out of the Blue Grass, and trainer Sonny Hine is hopeful that Skip Away, who broke the stakes record running the nine furlongs in 1:47 1/5 for his first stakes victory, will make it five-for-seven. "I told everyone around me I wouldn't be surprised if he won by eight," said a jubilant Hine. "This is an exceptional horse. He has done more than any horse I have ever had." On the board in seven of nine starts, the colt was put on Lasix after being eased in his '96 debut and came back to take a Gulfstream allowance by 12 lengths. He then finished third to Unbridled's Song after what Hine described as a "bad trip" in the Florida Derby, but enjoyed clear sailing at Keeneland, taking the lead after a half and opening it up down the lane. Looking forward to the Derby, jockey Shane Sellers said, "This horse will get the mile and a quarter."

Sent off the crowd's third choice at 9-2, Skip Away broke sharply and hauled jockey Shane Sellers to the lead, relinquished it briefly to fellow gray **ENSIGN RAY** (Blue Ensign), then took over once again and strode away from the field for a facile victory. "Believe me, I didn't go out there with the intention of going to the lead," said Sellers. "He dragged me by (Ensign Ray), and when he did, he relaxed. I didn't figure anybody could beat him from the three-eighths pole home." Trainer Nick Zito said that the Kentucky Derby is next for runner-up Louis Quatorze, and that stablemate **DILIGENCE** (Miswaki), fifth as the second choice, is also possible. His jockey, Eddie Delahoussaye, blamed the wet track for the colt's lackluster effort. "He just wasn't handling the track at all," said Delahoussaye. "He was floundering all the way." The 9-5 favorite Editor's Note disappointed the Team Lukas camp once again. Last for a half, the Overbrook colorbearer made up some ground late but finished a non-threatening third. But trainer D. Wayne Lukas said, "I was real pleased. This race has never been conducive to a bona fide closer. It just doesn't set up. It's an entirely different scenario than you get at Churchill. What we need to do is get a good, solid tightener out of this without knocking him out, and we'll be fine."

He wasn't quite as dominant as when winning the GI Florida Derby four weeks ago, but heavily favored Unbridled's Song still made it look easy, racing just off of pacesetter Romano Gucci to the second turn before asserting himself as the division leader under a confident jockey Mike Smith, who is equally as enthusiastic about his chances at Churchill Downs. "We're headed for Kentucky; we'll do it all over again," said Smith moments after the race. In Contention did make up some ground on the winner in the drive and while he never looked a threat, trainer Cynthia Reese said a trip to the Derby is still a possibility. "He's a nice horse, a real nice horse," said Reese. "He always tries hard and you have to give him a lot of credit. Now we'll have to consider going to the Derby."

Trainer Dick Dutrow will not send Romano Gucci to Churchill, but could join the Triple Crown trail further down the road. "He may be able to get a distance of ground in the future," he remarked. "Maybe at Pimlico."

Zarb's Magic, second after setting all the fractions in the GIII Louisiana Derby in his last start after taking a pair of Fair Grounds stakes in convincing fashion, was nevertheless given little chance outside his home state. Overlooked at the windows, the Louisiana-bred gelding this time took back off the pace of JEWELLED ROAD (Cahill Road) after hitting the gate at the start but kicked it into gear at the top of the stretch and outdueled 8-5 Grindstone down the lane for the victory. Said jockey Jerry Bailey, aboard Grindstone, "I think the winner got a better trip than I did and it made the difference. I was real happy with his effort and at this point would think this will be my mount in the Kentucky Derby if I am asked to ride him back." The first two finishers are expected to be pointed for the Derby.

Lee Freedman became the first trainer in Australia to send out 10 or more Group One winners in five consecutive seasons when his **Count Chivas (NZ)** (Lord Ballina {Aus}) won the \$540,875 Sydney Cup over two miles and his 1995 Golden Slipper winner **Flying Spur (Aus)** (Danehill) landed the \$231,803 All-Aged S. over a mile yesterday. Freedman has now won five Group One races in six days, following the victories of the filly **Merlene (Aus)** (Danehill) in both the Golden Slipper and the Sires Produce S. and **Gold Ace (Aus)** (Dieu d'Or {Aus}) in the Galaxy earlier in the week. Flying Spur will now be trained for the \$772,678 Stradbroke H. at Eagle Farm in Brisbane in June, while Count Chivas will be rested. "This horse has been going to stud three times," said Freedman about Arrowfield Stud's Flying Spur. "But he just keeps getting better. He's more mature now than he was before and winning a weight-for-age race will add to his stud value. He's an outstanding colt."

Sadly the All-Aged S. was marred when the million-dollar (Australian) earner **March Hare (Aus)** (Marscay {Aus}) broke a leg and is now battling for his life, with connections not at all hopeful. Ironically, this was to be his last race in Australia before being shipped to Japan for a racing and stud career.
