**MOTT: CIGAR'S OPTIONS OPEN** Possible options for Cigar's (Palace Music) next start now include the June 1 Massachusetts H. at Suffolk Downs and the May 27 Metropolitan H. at Belmont Park, trainer Bill Mott said yesterday. "(The Mass'Cap) is a possibility," said Mott from his barn at Churchill Downs. "I think everything is an option. It depends on how quickly he comes around. We'd even have to consider the Met Mile." Mott said Cigar was recovering from his trip to Dubai and his hard-fought win in the March 27 World Cup. "He's at Belmont, doing fine," said Mott. "He's galloping and putting his weight back on." While winning a handicap prior to the June 30 Hollywood Gold Cup could add to Cigar's impost in that race, Mott said, "If he's really doing extremely well and he's ready, I'd probably rather run him than wait 30 days and not pick up a pound."

LEXINGTON S.-GII, \$175,000a, 3yo, 8.5f

Jim Beam winner **Roar** (Forty Niner) heads a probable field of nine in the final major prep for the Kentucky Derby. "I think he needs another race around two turns," said his trainer, Shug McGaughey. "We'd like to see another good effort out of him." **Prince Of Thieves** (Hansel) worked five-eighths in :59 4/5 at Churchill Monday. Also expected for the race are **Afleetaffair** (Afleet), **Budroyale** (Cee's Tizzy), **City By Night** (Slew City Slew), **Foolish Pole** (Polish Numbers), **Javeriano** (Sewickley), **Saratoga Dandy** (Saratoga Six) and **Victor Cooley** (Cool Victor); **Tibet** (Homebuilder) and **Wire Me Collect** (Clever Trick) are also possible.

**HOH MAGIC RETIRED** Hoh Magic (GB) (Cadeaux Genereux {GB}), heroine of Deauville's 1994 G1 Prix Morny and fourth last year in the Newmarket 1000 Guineas, has been retired and is to be covered by the 1996 Epsom Derby hero **Lammtarra** (Nijinsky II). Hoh Magic failed to win as a three-year-old but, along with her brave Classic placing, she registered several quality performances, including a third in the G1 July Cup won by Europe's champion sprinter **Lake Coniston (Ire)** (Bluebird). However, she disappointed connections on her reappearance at Warwick last week and will not race again. Michael Bell, her Newmarket-based trainer, said: "The plan is for her to be covered by Lammtarra and then be sent on to the December Sales. She'd been giving us every indication that she was on song at home. But she was very disappointing at Warwick and I suspect she'd had enough."

**PURE GRAIN GOES WEST** Pure Grain (GB) (Polish Precedent), forced into premature retirement by a fractured cannon bone sustained when finishing 10th in last November's Japan Cup, is to be covered by **Gone West** (Mr. Prospector). The winner of the Irish and Yorkshire Oaks and a brave fifth to Lammtarra in Longchamp's Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe before her life-threatening injury, will fly from Britain to Kentucky within the next few days. Robert Barnett, the owner/breeder of Pure Grain, said: "We have chosen to send her to Gone West because, apart from the fact that he has had plenty of stakes winners in America, we think he is suitable on pedigree grounds. Pure Grain is in pretty good shape now and, while nothing is without risk, we are as certain as you can be that she is ready to travel. It is obviously getting rather late in proceedings for this covering season. So, if we can arrange flights, she is likely to fly out this week and be covered shortly afterwards."
