DANEHILL DANCES TO NEWBURY VICTORY

Making his three-year-old bow, **Danehill Dancer (Ire)** (Danehill) put in a late run that brought him near the top of the list of candidates for the May 4 G1 2000 Guineas, posting a one-and-a-half length victory over front-running **Kahir Almaydan (Ire)** (Distinctly North) in yesterday's G3 Tripleprint Greenham S. over seven furlongs at Newbury. Michael Tabor's colt, unbeaten until finishing second behind European champion juvenile **Alhaarth (Ire)** (Unfuwain) in last year's G1 Dewhurst S. at Newmarket, was rated in the early stages as the pacesetter set a good gallop, but jockey Pat Eddery switched left to make his challenge and took Danehill Dancer to the front passing the furlong marker. Eddery was obviously pleased with the show. "This one is a real live wire," he said enthusiastically. "He has got plenty of speed, but is so relaxed the mile of the Guineas should present no problem." Winning trainer Neville Callaghan stated: "He is fully entitled to be third favourite for the Guineas, but wouldn't want the ground too firm on May 4." HOLLYWOOD AT ODDS WITH NEVADA

CASINOS Hollywood Park has reached an impasse in negotiations with the Nevada casinos and will not send them its simulcasting signal if an agreement is not reached prior to the track's April 26 opening-day card. Currently, Nevada outlets pay 3.5 percent of their handle to Santa Anita Park for rights to the signal. Hollywood is seeking an increase to 4 percent. "We've asked for a modest increase," said Hollywood Park Chairman R. D. Hubbard. "On a handle of \$500,000, the increase requested amounts to only \$2,500 a day." The average takeout at Nevada race books on Southern California racing is 19 percent. The race books currently retain 15.5 percent after paying 3.5 percent to the host track.

Looking to assert herself as the leader of her class, My Flag followed a win in the GII Bonnie Miss S. at Gulfstream with this even more impressive performance. Rated in fourth for the opening half after swerving at the start, the royally bred filly was asked for her best as they headed into the far turn and responded to catch Cara Rafaela and win in hand. "It takes her a little while to get her motor running," said winning jockey Jerry Bailey. "Her best running is in the straights. I think this was a pretty strong race considering it was a speed-favoring type of track with a short stretch. It's probably just what she needs with two weeks to the (Kentucky Oaks, May 3)." Cara Rafaela was easily second-best, but trainer D. Wayne Lukas said the filly is only 50-50 for the Kentucky Oaks. "We'll take a look at it," he said.

Auriette (Ire) had never missed a check in eight previous U.S. starts and came back from a five-month layoff March 28 to take a Santa Anita allowance by four lengths. A graded-stakes winner and second in the GI Queen Elizabeth II S. at Keeneland last year, the filly was the crowd's third choice in this talented field but proved much the best for soon-to-be retired trainer Gary Jones. The bay dueled with outsider TABLED WITH SAROS (Saros {GB}) for three-quarters, put that one away, then fought off the challenge of Angel In My Heart (Fr) at the top of the stretch and pulled away in the final furlong under jockey Kent Desormeaux. "Absolutely phenomenal," said Desormeaux. "She just galloped. Anybody out there could have ridden her." The 4-5 Wandesta (GB), back in with fillies after a pair of graded placings against colts, was bothered at the break and again on the far turn but finished gamely to be third.

Jockey Jorge Chavez picked up his 2,000th career victory at Aqueduct yesterday, rallying favored **Traffic Circle** (Cahill Road) to win the fifth race on the card. "Finally!" said Chavez, a 34-year-old native of Peru. "Someone told me a few days ago I was close to No. 2,000, and ever since then it seemed the horses kept going slower and slower for me--I kept finishing second." Chavez, currently the leading rider at the Big A, had his first mount in Peru in 1982 and came to the U.S. in 1988; he joined the New York jockey colony in 1990 and was leading rider in the state in '94 and '95.
