ASHLAND WRAP-UP Assessing the three-length victory of **My Flag** (Easy Goer) in Saturday's GI \$540,750 Ashland S. at Keeneland, trainer Shug McGaughey said, "I thought it was a great race for her. I thought it was the best race she's probably ever run." The trainer added that My Flag, also winner of last year's GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies and the GI Bonnie Miss S. at Gulfstream March 13, will ship to Churchill Downs this Wednesday to prepare for the May 3 Kentucky Oaks. Elliott Walden, who conditions Ashland S. third-place finisher **Mackie** (Summer Squall), said yesterday that his charge will skip the Kentucky Oaks. "We're just going to regroup and figure out what to do with her," Walden said. GSW Mackie, a half-sister to 1993 Kentucky Derby winner Sea Hero, was beaten 13 lengths in the Ashland. Walden plans to have a runner in the Kentucky Oaks, however, in **Birr** (Farma Way), who finished second in the GI Beaumont S. at Keeneland in her three-year-old debut April 6.

BLUE DUSTER DOUBTFUL FOR BRITISH 1000 GUINEAS Blue Duster (Danzig), last year's champion European juvenile filly, now seems set to miss the Newmarket 1000 Guineas May 5. David Loder, who handles Blue Duster for Sheikh Mohammed, has seen a series of his string disappoint over the past week and, after discussing her recent work with big-race jockey Michael Kinane, is not convinced his stable star is ready to take on Guineas favorite Bosra Sham and company in less than two weeks. Loder has also been in talks with Anthony Stroud, the Sheikh's racing manager, who revealed, "Blue Duster is a doubtful starter. David's stable is not really firing and we're slightly worried that the filly is not 100 percent. The final decision will rest with Sheikh Mohammed, but we will tell him exactly what the form is. The Irish 1000 Guineas (May 25) could be an alternative." Blue Duster, a perfect four-for-four in her juvenile season, has not raced since taking last year's G1 Shadwell Stud Cheveley Park S. at Newmarket September 26.

Raintrap, the 9-2 fourth choice in this seven-horse field, won the GI Rothmans Int'l at Woodbine in Oct. '94, then was winless in six starts until returning from a four-month hiatus to take the restricted Cedar Key S. over the Santa Anita turf March 8. Making his second start back off that layoff, the chestnut horse, reluctant to load into the gate, quickly sprinted to the lead, was rated on the front end by rider Alex Solis through soft fractions of :24 3/5, :49 2/5, 1:13 3/5 and 1:39 1/5, and held off a mild challenge from Windsharp late to win under a strong hand ride. "Don't forget (Raintrap) is a horse that always came from behind," said winning trainer Bobby Frankel. "This was the first time he's ever been committed to go to the lead. I had to take a chance. I knew he'd get the distance and that's the main thing." Frankel said the long-term goal for Raintrap is the Oct. 26 Breeders' Cup Turf. "The key thing about him is that he won over the course (at Woodbine, site of the '96 Breeders' Cup)," Frankel said. The 9-5 favorite Windsharp, the only filly or mare in the race, chased the winner from start to finish but was not able to catch him. "They were going so slow," said Windsharp's jockey Eddie Delahoussaye. "When I asked my mare, she ran. But that other horse just kept running too. He quickened. I wish he would have had a pacesetter with him, but there was nothing you could do." MALMO (Jade Hunter), never in contention, was pulled up in distress by jockey Chris Antley nearing the clubhouse turn then was vanned off.

City By Night, sixth after pressing the pace in the Gill Louisiana Derby last time he ran, had run well in two of three graded starts at two; he returned to the form that saw him second to Honour and Glory and third to Ide last year. The bay was rated just off the leaders to the far turn, then found room between horses to take the lead and outfinish a troubled Prince of Thieves for the narrow victory. "I had a great trip," said winning rider Shane Sellers. "I was always in the garden spot...I was in a position to dictate the race. I know Pat (Day, aboard Prince Of Thieves) didn't have the best trip in the world --it helped get us there." The colt's connections have not yet decided if the Kentucky Derby will be next. The runner-up, a definite for the Derby, was in tight quarters at the eighth pole but finished well when swung to the outside late to just miss. Day remarked that his mount "was the best horse in the race. We lost some momentum, but he came back running. He ran a very courageous race." The 4-5 favorite Roar set the pace but tired to be third. Trainer Shug McGaughey said the colt was still possible for the Derby. "I'll have to see how he comes out of this race, and talk it over with (owner Seth Hancock," he said.
