**OBS APRIL SALE SHOWS GAINS** The Ocala Breeders' Sales Company completed the first session of the four-day OBS April Spring Two-Year-Old In Training Sale Monday, with a total of 172 horses sold for \$2,589,700. The gross showed an increase of \$738,100 over the opening session a year ago; the average rose more than 12 percent, at \$15,056 in '96 as compared to \$13,417 for the '95 opener. There were 76 buy-backs, 30.6 percent of the total offered. The session-topper was a filly by Summer Squall out of GSW Weekend Delight (Clever Trick), who brought a bid of \$122,000 from Bea and Robert Roberts; consigned by AbraCadabra Farms, agent, the bay had breezed three furlongs in :35 2/5. The sale continues through Thursday.

**FASIG-TIPTON TWO-YEAR-OLD SALE SET FOR MONDAY** Fasig-Tipton Kentucky will conduct its annual Two-Year-Olds In Training and Horses of Racing Age Sale Monday, April 29 at Newton Paddocks in Lexington. The auction, scheduled to begin at 3:00 p.m., will offer a total of 159 two-year-olds and horses of racing age. This year's under-tack show will take place Sunday, April 28 at 10:00 a.m. and will be videotaped. The videos can be reviewed prior to and during the sale.

**EDDERY TURNS DOWN DANEHILL DANCER** Pat Eddery, 10 times Britain's champion jockey, has turned down the chance to take the mount on **Danehill Dancer (Ire)** (Danehill) in the British 2000 Guineas. The 44-year-old Irish-born rider partnered Michael Tabor's colt to wins in two Group One races last season and was in the saddle when Danehill Dancer made an impressive first appearance for 1996 in Saturday's G3 Greenham S. over seven furlongs at Newbury. Eddery has, however, chosen to partner Henry Cecil-trainee **Storm Trooper** (Diesis {GB}) in the Newmarket Classic May 4. Mick Kinane will now substitute on Danehill Dancer. Tabor said, "Henry has a far bigger outfit than me and, obviously, Pat is keen to maintain their successful relationship. But he has done all the ground work on Danehill Dancer and will be back on board as soon as possible." Eddery's 1000 Guineas partner--the Cecil-trained **Bosra Sham** (Woodman)--now rates the 2-5 favorite after confirmation that **Blue Duster** (Danzig) will definitely miss the May 5 event.

She was the final starter of what has been a stellar career, and Ski Dancer did not let trainer Gary Jones down. Coming off back-to-back wins over this course and distance, the hard-knocking filly this time took on the boys and proved up to the task; she rated off the pace to the top of the lane, then came running to outfinish longshot Daggett Peak under a determined jockey Gary Stevens. It was the second graded stakes win of Jones' final weekend with a stopwatch after he saddled Auriette (Ire) to victory in the GII Santa Barbara H. Saturday. "First of all, I'd like to thank (owners) Jeff and Sandy Kallenberg. I'm pretty emotional," said Jones after the race. "I never thought I would get this way, but I did. You always want to go out a winner." Jones also credited Stevens with a great ride. "When Gary (Stevens) came into the paddock, I knew I was going to get the ride of a lifetime. He was saying 'We've got to win this race, we've got to win this race'," Jones recounted. "He rode her like it was the Kentucky Derby--you would have thought it was the last ride of his career."

**Saturday, May 4, Churchill Downs**

**KENTUCKY DERBY-GI, \$1,000,000, 3yo, 1 1/4m**

A total of nine Derby prospects worked at Churchill Downs Monday morning. Trainer D. Wayne Lukas sent out four prospects yesterday: **Victory Speech** (Deputy Minister)--six furlongs in 1:13, **Honour and Glory** (Relaunch)--six furlongs in 1:12 2/5, **Grindstone** (Unbridled)--a half in :50, and **Editor's Note** (Forty Niner)--seven furlongs in 1:27 3/5. Jockey Donna Barton was aboard all four. "I was pleased," said Lukas. "I didn't expect anything less. They're all right on tagret." Lukas is also planning to run Lexington runner-up **Prince Of Thieves** (Hansel) in the Derby; if all five go, it would be the largest contingent from a single trainer in the race's history. James Rowe Sr. holds the current record, saddling a quartet in 1923 (his best finish in that edition was a sixth); Lukas has had three runners four times previously--1983, '87, '90 and '95.

Trainer Nick Zito sent out **Diligence** (Miswaki) to go five-eighths in 1:03 2/5, and stablemate **Louis Quatorze** (Sovereign Dancer) went the same distance in 1:02 2/5 Monday. "I'm trying to get (Diligence) over that race (a fifth-place finish in the Blue Grass). Sometimes a bad experience can be traumatic," said trainer Nick Zito, adding, "Louie went fabulous. He's starting to come around."

**Halo Sunshine** (Halo) went a half-mile in :49 3/5 with jockey Joe Deegan in the irons, and **Semorán** (Phone Trick) went five furlongs in 1:01 4/5.

**Blow Out** (Marfa), a Derby possible, went five furlongs in 1:01 Monday; trainer James Keefer and co-owner Walter "Buddy" New have voted to take a run at the roses, but Bill Heiligbrodt and R.E. "Teddy" Keefer, the other two-thirds of the owner partnership, have not yet made a commitment to the race.

After a slight delay in his original plans, Arkansas Derby winner **Zarb's Magic** (Zarbyev) is scheduled to arrive at Churchill this morning. Wood Memorial runner-up **In Contention** (Devil's Bag) vans down from New York Wednesday, while California invaders **E C's Dream** (Incinderator) and **Alyrob** (Alysheba) will fly in Friday.

**Local News: Middleburg, Virginia**

Spoiling **Irish Approach's** (Irish River {Fr}) attempt to take the first Steeplechase Triple Crown, Vesta Balestiere's **Rowdy Irishman** (Erin's Isle {Ire}) took Saturday's \$75,000 GII Temple Gwathmey S. at the Middleburg Spring Races in Virginia. The seven-year-old, with jockey Jonathan Smart in the irons, took the lead after the final fence and held off Irish Approach's late charge to win the second leg of the Steeplechase Triple by a length and a half, with **To Ridley** (Steady Growth) third. The winner, hero of last year's GI Breeders' Cup Grand National, was purchased by trainer Bruce Haynes for \$1,500 in 1993 and turned to steeplechasing in 1994 after going 0-for-17 on the flat; he has now earned over \$250,000. He will make his next start in the May 11 GI Iroquois S. at Nashville, Tennessee, where he will face three-time Eclipse winner **Lonesome Glory** (Transworld). "The three miles at the Iroquois will help my horse," said jockey Smart. "Lonesome Glory won't, but we'll be ready."

**Local News: Fort Erie Race Track**

The Ontario Jockey Club has announced the appointment of Mike Robitaille to the position of general manager of Fort Erie Race Track. Robitaille, 47, succeeds David Gorman, who will continue as an executive vice president with the OJC; Robitaille has served as the track's director of marketing/public relations since 1993.

Champion Melbourne trainer Lee Freedman landed his sixth Group One victory at this year's Sydney Autumn Carnival when his New Zealand-bred gelding Doriemus took this event. Ridden by Shane Dye, the five-year-old beat the Gai Waterhouse-trained gelding Juggler to land his first victory since his famous "double" last Spring in the G1 Caulfield and G1 Melbourne Cups. This was Doriemus' first victory in a weight-for-age race and Freedman said, "It was a great win and it's great to see him running like a racehorse again."

Britain's first major Epsom Derby rehearsal of 1996, this Saturday's G3 Thresher Classic Trial over 1 1/4-miles at Sandown, has drawn 13 entries. Definite for the race is **Mons (GB)** (Deploy {GB}), winner of last year's G2 Royal Lodge S. at Ascot and third on his final juvenile start in Doncaster's G1 Racing Post Trophy October 21. Trainer Luca Cumani said, "He was a shade disappointing at Doncaster, but had been on the go since June so may not have been at his best. This will hopefully tell us if he is an Epsom or a foreign Derby horse." Trainer Henry Cecil could be doubly represented, sending out **Brighstone (GB)** (Cadeaux Genereux {GB}), unbeaten in two outings, and **Silver Dome** (Silver Hawk), a winner of his only two-year-old race.
