HOLLYWOOD PARK OPENS TODAY The 55th Hollywood Park Spring/Summer Meeting, featuring the return of Friday-night racing, a special night program Monday, June 10, and a twilight card Friday, July 5, begins this evening. Post time at the Track of Lakes and Flowers, which customarily offers live racing Wednesdays through Sundays, will be 7:00 p.m. for the night cards, 1:00 p.m. for daytime programs and 4:00 p.m. for the one twilight card; a special 11:15 a.m. first post is set for Kentucky Derby Day, May 4. The meet will be highlighted by the second leg of the MGM Grand Classic Crown, the June 30 \$1-million Hollywood Gold Cup, which is expected to draw superstar **Cigar** (Palace Music); and the July 21 Super Sunday card, which includes the GII Caesars Palace Turf Championship, GII Swaps S., GI Vanity H. and GII Hollywood Juvenile Championship. The 67-day stand concludes Monday, July 22.

BOSRA SHAM IN INJURY SCARE **Bosra Sham** (Woodman), red hot favorite for the English 1000 Guineas at Newmarket next Sunday, has become the subject of an injury scare. The unbeaten filly, heroine of last year's G1 Fillies Mile at Ascot and impressive on her reappearance in the G3 Fred Darling S. at Newbury April 19, has a bruised foot. Henry Cecil, her 10-time British champion trainer, revealed, "Bosra Sham has suffered a minor setback. But, hopefully, she will be back in exercise in a couple of days. So we are hoping it will not affect her participation in the Guineas."

NAKAO SPONSORS CURRAGH EVENT Japanese businessman Terunobu Nakao, who is to set up a 200-strong team of horses in Britain and Ireland for next season, has agreed to sponsor the G3 Curragh S., to be run July 14 over the Irish course which gives it its name. The five-furlong contest--to be called the Omni Irish Club Curragh S.--will be backed with approximately \$38,000 of Nakao's money and is the first of several events he plans to support in Ireland. Nakao said, "Liam Browne, who is going to be my principal trainer, has won the race three times. So that was an added incentive to sponsor it." Brian Kavanagh, manager at The Curragh, is delighted at both the individual sponsorship and of Nakao's overall investment, which is thought likely to amount to about \$76 million. "There is much talk in Ireland concerning Mr. Nakao's investment in our industry--particularly as it will create many new jobs. He has accepted our offer of presenting the trophy for the Mooresbridge S. Saturday," he said.

Knockadoon, winless since taking a Churchill allowance last November but right there when on the board in graded stakes his last two starts, earns his first graded-stakes score. With new jockey Jerry Bailey in the irons, the bay Canadian-bred sat third in this four-horse field until the quarter-pole, then made his move from the far outside and outfinished favored Halo's Image for the victory. "It wasn't too complicated," said Bailey. "He didn't switch his leads through the stretch, but that's about the only thing he did wrong. He was running fast enough to maintain a winning margin, so I didn't see any sense in wrestling with him to make him do it."

KENTUCKY DERBY-GI, \$1,000,000, 3yo, 1 1/4m

Unbridled's Song (Unbridled), leading the way down the Triple Crown trail, is also travelling on another route --the information super highway. This year's Kentucky Derby favorite now has his own "homestretch" page on the Internet; billed as being 'for speed readers only,' it can be accessed at <http://napanet.net/unbridledssong>. The interactive web site includes videos and daily updated reports, as well as information from the colt's owner, trainer, jockey, jockey's agent, groom and hotwalker.

Blow Out (Marfa), fifth in the Arkansas Derby last out, has been given the green light by owners Bill Heiligbrodt, Ted Keefer and Buddy New to compete in the 122nd Kentucky Derby next Saturday. Jockey Patrick Johnson, aboard for the colt's last five starts, will be back in the saddle for the Derby.

As of yesterday, the probable 20-horse field for this year's "Run for the Roses," in alphabetical order, is: Alyrob (Alysheba), Blow Out, Built for Pleasure (Homebuilder), Cavonnier (Batonnier), City By Night (Slew City Slew), Corker (Festin {Arg}), Diligence (Miswaki), Editor's Note (Forty Niner), Grindstone (Unbridled), Halo Sunshine (Halo), Honour and Glory (Re-launch), In Contention (Devil's Bag), Louis Quatorze (Sovereign Dancer), Matty G (Capote), Prince Of Thieves (Hansel), Secreto de Estado (General Assembly), Skip Away (Skip Trial), Unbridled's Song (Unbridled), Victory Speech (Deputy Minister) and Zarb's Magic (Zarbyev). El Amante (Wild Again) and Semoran (Phone Trick) are the still undecided wild cards. Alyrob and Semoran are the only two candidates without graded-stakes earnings; if the final berth in the starting gate is between the two, Semoran would get in by virtue of his higher non-graded stakes earnings.
