CECIL PLEASED WITH SHAM'S PROGRESS

Henry Cecil, trainer of the English 1000 Guineas favourite **Bosra Sham** (Woodman), is now cautiously optimistic that his star filly will recover from a foot injury in time to run in the Newmarket Classic a week from today. Cecil discovered heat in the near-fore hoof of Bosra Sham on Wednesday. But the unbeaten Group One winner was fit enough to canter yesterday and is now expected to do two pieces of faster work over the next few days. "She is fine after cantering and the foot is healing," said the Newmarket-based 10-time champion handler in Britain. "Obviously, you cannot wave a magic wand and make everything all right. The foot is bruised but improving." Bookmakers have every confidence in Cecil nursing Bosra Sham back to health before next weekend. They still make her 2-5 to lift the one-mile event.

TRIAL WINNER WON'T HEAD TO EPSOM

Santillana (El Gran Senor) gave trainer John Gosden his fourth victory in the Thresher Classic Trial in the past five years with a half-length win yesterday's event at Sandown, but will not bid for Derby glory, according to trainer John Gosden. Gosden did not enter Santillana in the Epsom Derby, explaining: "He is out of an Irish River mare, who only stayed a mile, so we think this will always be his best trip. This was our first major target. I like the race and it is a valuable prize to win. The Grand Prix de Paris is a possibility now." However, Paul Kelleway, trainer of runner-up **Glory Of Dancer** (GB) (Shareef Dancer), definitely does have the Derby in mind. He nominated the Dante Stakes at York as his colt's next stop and told jockey Olivier Peslier: "Make sure you are available for Epsom." The runner-up, who was giving away six pounds, must be given a chance, said Kelleway, explaining the colt had been operated on in January and was slightly behind in his preparation.

The bar shoe has come off when the colt works, and will again for Tuesday's scheduled breeze. Ryerson said he has missed no time from the track. "We couldn't be any happier with the way he has trained," said Ryerson.

GRINDSTONE WORKS SIX FURLONGS Arkansas Derby runner-up **Grindstone** (Unbridled) worked six furlongs in 1:14 yesterday morning to the satisfaction of trainer D. Wayne Lukas and rider Donna Barton. He clocked quarter-mile fractions of :25 2/5 and :49 2/5 and galloped out in 1:28. "He worked fabulous," said Barton. "Wayne wanted me to go in :13 or :14 and we went in :14 flat. He did it the right way. He started off nice and picked it up as he went along."

IN CONTENTION, MATTY G. HOOK UP IN WORK Wood Memorial runner-up **In Contention** (Devil's Bag) worked six furlongs in 1:17 under jockey Craig Perret yesterday, encountering **Matty G** (Capote), who passed him down the backstretch en route to his seven-furlong move in 1:27 1/5. "I tried to stay with Perret on the turn, but then I told him 'Gotta go' and he put In Contention Away easily," said jockey Willie Martinez, who was aboard for the work. Countered trainer Cynthia Reese: "I'm sure when they saw Matty G blow on by they probably thought this horse can't keep up. When that other horse went by it would have been easy to say, 'let's test him here,' but that's not the time to test them."

ZARB'S MAGIC BREEZES THREE-QUARTERS Arkansas Derby winner **Zarb's Magic** (Zarbyev) worked six furlongs in 1:16 yesterday morning at Churchill. "It was just an average work," said trainer Bret Thomas. "We were not looking for anything fast."
