**VALANOUR TAKES PRIX GANAY** Justifying favoritism, the Aga Khan's smart four-year-old colt Valanour (Ire) (Lomond) again produced his flying finish to grab the glory in Sunday's G1 Prix Ganay at Longchamp in France, catching the gallant English challenger Luso (GB) (Salse), trained by Clive Brittain and ridden by Irish champion jockey Michael Kinane, inside the final furlong to win by a half-length. Ridden by Gerald Mosse, Valanour raced in fourth early behind the leaders Marildo (Fr) (Romildo {GB}), Luso and Swain (Ire) (Nashwan). On the turn Kinane shot Luso into the lead, while Peter Chapple-Hyam's Spectrum (Ire) (Rainbow Quest) looked a danger on the wide outside. Valanour looked short of room on the inside at that stage, but once his rider found a gap between Luso and Swain, the favorite shot through and went on to win rather more easily than the half-length suggests. Winning trainer Alain de Royer-Dupre said, "Valanour is a top-class horse and he proved it again today. Horse and jockey know to wait and wait and his great turn of foot makes a big difference. He should run next in the Group One Prix d'Ispahan at the end of next month."

**KENTUCKY OAKS HOPEFULS WORK** My Flag (Easy Goer), three-length winner of the G1 Ashland S. at Keeneland nine days ago, worked six furlongs in 1:14 Sunday morning at Churchill Downs, earning the comment from the track's clockers that she went easily. The chestnut filly is scheduled to run next in Friday's G1 \$500,000 Kentucky Oaks over 1 1/8-miles. Also working for the Kentucky Oaks was Antespend (Spend a Buck), who won six straight races before finishing second in the G1 Fantasy S. at Oaklawn April 5. The Ron McAnally-trainee turned in a seven-furlong move in 1:28 at Churchill Downs Saturday. "She's been a pleasure to train," McAnally said. "When you get a good horse like that, they take everything in stride." Antespend's regular rider, Chris Antley, will be back in the saddle Friday.

**SERENA'S SONG IN SHARP BREEZE** Last year's Champion Three-Year-Old Filly **Serena's Song** (Rahy) charged through five furlongs Sunday morning at Churchill Downs in a sizzling :59 3/5, galloping out six panels in 1:12 3/5. The D. Wayne Lukas-trainee is slated to start in Friday's G1 \$200,000a Louisville Breeders' Cup, in which she will carry highweight of 123 pounds. "It was just a routine work, but she did well," Lukas said. "That should set her up. If she gets the track she likes, she should run well." Gary Stevens, her regular rider since the 1995 Kentucky Derby, has the return call.

The 4-5 choice, Debutant Trick, raced behind horses into the stretch where he came through tight quarters for a game late finish inside.

### UNBRIDLED'S SONG'S BAR SHOE TO BE REMOVED

**FOR DERBY** Trainer Jim Ryerson was asked how long the bar shoe would remain on the left front foot of Wood Memorial winner Unbridled's Song (Unbridled). "It won't be on for the race," Ryerson said. "It could come off anywhere from Thursday to Saturday; we are kicking that around. He might work in it (Tuesday or Wednesday). I don't expect to go that fast. We are just going to see what kind of track we get and how he is handling it. He has been handling it very well. For this little half-mile it may be on."

**SECRETO DE ESTADO STILL ON FENCE** The Kentucky Derby status of Secreto de Estado (General Assembly) remains up in the air, trainer Alfredo Callejas said yesterday from his home in New York. Should the Callejas-trainee run, there will be 21 horses pointing for the Derby, one over the limit. The odd horse out could be Alyrob (Alysheba), who does not have any graded stakes earnings. "We still haven't decided," Callejas said through an interpreter, his wife, Lillian. "We still have two days left (a plane is scheduled to take horses from New York to Louisville Tuesday). They want to see how he eats and everything else before we make a final decision. He's a very finicky horse."

### SUNDAY'S WORKOUTS AT CHURCHILL DOWNS:

**CITY BY NIGHT** (Slew City Slew): Last Sunday's GII Lexington S. winner breezed a half-mile in :48 3/5 yesterday, galloping out five furlongs in 1:02. "He was reaching right out over the track with a perfect stride," said trainer Patrick Byrne. "I don't get too crazy about times, just the way they handle the track. I know he is fit. He can work quick if you want him to. I watched HALO SUNSHINE breeze by and he looked good and my colt looked like he was doing more."

**HALO SUNSHINE** (Halo): With Kentucky Derby jockey Craig Perret in the saddle, Halo Sunshine breezed seven furlongs in 1:31 3/5 for trainer Richard Cross. The GII Arkansas Derby third-place finisher began slowly with an opening quarter-mile in :27 1/5, went the half in :54 4/5 and six furlongs in 1:19 2/5. He galloped out the mile in 1:45. "It was a little slower than we planned," said Cross, "but he finished well and worked fine. Craig said it was a little cuppy around the turn so he took a little hold there, but he got a hold of the track in the stretch and finished well. This horse has had six races this year so I know he's fit."

**DILIGENCE** (Miswaki)/**LOUIS QUATORZE** (Sovereign Dancer): Trainer Nick Zito's two Derby hopefuls had similar five furlong works Sunday in their final Kentucky Derby preps. George Steinbrenner's Diligence went in 1:04, galloping out six furlongs in 1:17 2/5. Louis Quatorze, owned by William Condren, Joseph Cornacchia and Georgia Hofmann, covered the distance in 1:02 1/5, galloping out in 1:16. "That's just what I wanted," Zito said. "I have a really good feeling. They are two wonderful horses, two wonderful chances. Both horses came on really fast at the end. They galloped out really strong, and that's what I was looking for. What they need to have now is a good week, a good final six days, and I'll be happy."

**EDITOR'S NOTE** (Forty Niner)/**VICTORY SPEECH** (Deputy Minister)/**HONOUR AND GLORY** (Relaunch): The D. Wayne Lukas-trained trio each worked five-eighths with Donna Barton aboard. Toyota Blue Grass third Editor's Note went in :59 4/5, galloping out three-quarters in 1:13; Victory Speech, working in company, went in 1:00 2/5; Honour and Glory was timed in 1:00 3/5. Lukas said of GII Jim Beam third Victory Speech, "His work tab here is impeccable. His work this morning--no horse is gonna work better this week. He came home in :23 with Donna's feet on the dashboard. I don't know if that means he's gonna win, run third or what, but I've got him fit. They're all fit." Regarding GI Santa Anita Derby runner-up Honour and Glory, Lukas said, "It was a good work. Again, there's a question with a horse that fast if he's going to be around at the end of the race, but I think he's got a chance. He's going to go farther than you guys think."

**SEMORAN** (Phone Trick): Although the official time clockers had was 1:13 for six furlongs, trainer Bob Baffert said the colt actually drilled seven furlongs in 1:26 2/5 and galloped out a mile in 1:44 2/5. "This was his best work since prior to (winning) the Remington Park Derby," Baffert said.

"She backed up so fast I didn't have time to cock my stick."
