TRIPLE CROWN RECORD CARVED IN

"STONE" It began with the infamous Tabasco Cat's victory in the 1994 Preakness and made the record books when Thunder Gulch earned his trainer an historic fifth consecutive Triple Crown race triumph in last year's Belmont S., but until the very last stride it looked like D. Wayne Lukas' streak would end with yesterday's 122nd running of the Kentucky Derby. It was the Bob Baffert-trained **Cavonnier** (Batonnier) who led the 19-horse field as they raced past Churchill Downs' celebrated twin spires and, with 100 yards to go, the Santa Anita Derby winner seemed poised to add the garland of roses to his collection. But jockey Jerry Bailey, riding Team Lukas' **Grindstone** (Unbridled) and moving like a New York cabbie through crosstown traffic, wove his way from the back of the pack and flew through the final sixteenth to take the tightest Derby finish since 1959. "There were 14 horses in front of us, but it looked like 114," said Bailey, who guided his colt from 15th to first. "The idea is to hit the holes without getting stopped, and Grindstone was game enough to go through every one of them. It was a wonderful effort." It had been 23 years since the last trainer saddled back-to-back Derby winners--Lucien Laurin sent out Riva Ridge and Secretariat in 1972-73--and Wayne Lukas was picking up his third "Run for the Roses" (Winning Colors-'88, Thunder Gulch-'95) but his first for 78-year-old owner William T. Young. "This is absolutely the happiest I have ever been," said Lukas, who was represented by a record five Derby runners yesterday. "I've been blessed a lot of days in racing, but I've never, never been prouder than I am standing here today next to Bill Young. It is the highlight of my career to win this race for him." A lukewarm 7-2 favorite, **Unbridled's Song** (Unbridled) had grabbed the lead after pressing fast fractions of :46.09 and 1:10.15, but hampered by a pair of bar shoes and the toll a torrid pace will take, the gallant grey succumbed to the jinx that has claimed 17 straight Derby favorites and faded to fifth. "I thought he looked pretty good about the five-eighths pole, but as the pace began to pick up he was really struggling with those bar shoes on," said his jockey, Mike Smith, who now holds the dubious distinction of riding the losing favorite in three of the last four Derbies (Prairie Bayou-'93; Holy Bull-'94). "He couldn't get the traction everybody else did. It just didn't work out today, but we're going to go on and redeem ourselves." The three-year-olds do battle next in the Preakness S. May 18.

When did Jerry Bailey know he had it won? "When (Churchill announcer) Mike Battaglia said I did," said last year's Eclipse Award-winning jockey, who picked up his second Kentucky Derby victory with an eye-catching ride and a heart-stopping finish aboard Grindstone. Coming off a second-place finish in the Arkansas Derby April 13, the lightly raced colt was rated well off a very rapid pace (the fourth-quickest six-furlong and one-mile splits in 122 runnings), but found seam after seam to run through and finished fastest of all to run down the game gelding Cavonnier as they hit the wire. "There is no other thrill in the world like winning the Kentucky Derby," said Bailey, who also took the '93 edition with Sea Hero. Jockey Chris McCarron had rallied the runner-up from just off the pace to take the lead as they neared the eighth-pole, but his mount came up a nostril short of becoming the first gelding since Clyde van Dusen in 1929 to wear the blanket of roses. "I thought I was going to win it," said McCarron. "I was screaming 'Come on, wire' and then, when I raised up (after the finish) I saw Jerry's horse about a head in front and I thought he might have caught me. But this is a real hard-trying horse and he ran great." Prince Of Thieves overcame a bump at the start to get up for third. "The start was a little detrimental to us, but he got up and got into the race and was right where I wanted him to be at the head of the stretch," said his jockey, Pat Day. "But he was getting awfully tired late." Blue Grass winner SKIP AWAY (Skip Trial) raced just off the leaders to the top of the stretch and weakened to be 12th.

GODOLPHIN MAKES IT'S MARK IN

GUINEAS Mark of Esteem (Ire) (Darshaan {GB}) gave the Godolphin string it's fourth consecutive English Classic success when inching out **Even Top (Ire)** (Topanoora {Ire}) in a thrilling finish to yesterday's 2000 Guineas over a mile at Newmarket. Sheikh Mohammed's Dubai-based team captured the 1995 Derby, Oaks and St. Leger, but had been deliberately playing down their prospects of adding to those victories since flying in from the Middle East earlier in the week. Mark of Esteem, however, looked magnificent beforehand and, responding to Frankie Dettori's urgings from the saddle, showed that he has a big heart despite his relatively small stature. The runner-up gave his all, too, but was a short head behind when the photo-finish print was published. Sheikh Mohammed was obviously delighted by his string's continued success, saying: "This a wonderful moment for us. But all the credit really goes to the horses themselves. You can't take a donkey to Dubai and come back with a Classic winner. This colt has had his problems (he suffered a knee injury last year), but he has come through the winter really well. He's in the Derby and, if he is all right from now on, I think he will run. I expect he will go straight to Epsom without another race." Even Top's connections have similar plans. Trainer Mark Tompkins said: "There were no excuses, but I think he would have won in another stride or two. He will go straight to Epsom now. I think he'll stay the mile and a half." Favourite **Alhaarth (Ire)** (Unfuwain), last year's European champion juvenile, finished fourth and is also likely to be aimed for the Derby. Jockey Willie Carson insisted: "He's got to go to Epsom. He wasn't quite good enough today, but it looks as though he'll stay." The only dissenting voice was that of Mark Johnston, trainer of third-placed **Bijou d'Inde (GB)** (Cadeaux Genereux {GB}). His charge will almost certainly have his next outing in the Irish 2000 Guineas. DERBY FAVORITE'S DAM FOALS ON DERBY

EVE Trolley Song (Caro {Ire}), the dam of yesterday's Kentucky Derby favorite and fifth-place finisher **Unbridled's Song** (Unbridled), delivered a foal by Caerleon at 11:00 p.m. Friday night. Boarded at Coolmore Stud in County Tipperary, Ireland, the 13-year-old mare foaled a filly that was described as a "very good, correct individual" at 3:00 a.m. local time; owned by Kevin Doyle, she will now go to the court of Sadler's Wells.

KEY OF LUCK TOPS PIMLICO SPECIAL Pimlico Racing Secretary Tommy Baker has assigned top weight of 120 pounds to Dubai invader **Key Of Luck** (Chief's Crown) for the \$600,000 GI Pimlico Special, to be run May 11. In his most recent effort, the five-year-old took the Dubai Duty Free Race by 20 lengths on the Dubai World Cup undercard March 27, running the mile and a quarter in a time that was .07 seconds faster than Cigar's hard-fought triumph. In at 118 pounds are the Bill Mott trainees **Geri** (Theatrical {Ire}) and **Wekiva Springs** (Runaway Groom), who finished 1-2 in the GI Oaklawn Park H. in their last outings. California shipper **Dare And Go** (Alydar) gets 116 pounds, followed by **Star Standard** (Risen Star) at 111 and **Western Echo** (Eastern Echo) at 108; only six of the original 20 nominees are still eligible for the 1 3/16-mile event after a sustaining payment last week.
