**KENTUCKY DERBY WRAP-UP** Trainer D. Wayne Lukas will head to Pimlico with three of his five Kentucky Derby runners; winner **Grindstone** (Unbridled), third-placed **Prince Of Thieves** (Hansel) and sixth-placed **Editor's Note** (Forty Niner) will continue down the Triple Crown trail in the GI Preakness S. May 18. Lukas may also start the lightly raced **Dr. Caton** (Seattle Slew), recovered from last month's throat surgery, in his quest for a seventh straight Triple Crown race victory. "**Victory Speech** (Deputy Minister) (10th) we may save for the Belmont. I think he has a better style for it," said Lukas. "**Honour and Glory** (Relaunch) (18th after setting the pace) we may want to keep to under a mile." Dr. Caton will work seven furlongs sometime this week before a final decision is made on his next start. As for his second consecutive Derby hero, Lukas said, "I was never worried about him not having the seasoning to do what (jockey Jerry) Bailey was able to do with him. He has always been a solid performer. I call him John Stockton—he just goes out and plays." The game gelding **Cavonnier** (Batonnier), who missed by only a nose Saturday, will also point for the second leg in the series, but stablemate **Semorán** (Phone Trick) (14th) will head back to California. "I think he is more effective running a mile," said trainer Bob Baffert, who added, "I feel like I took a good belly punch" after losing the closest Derby photo in 27 years. "It is so hard to get here. I train for some nice people, but we don't get many chances. The feeling of winning the Kentucky Derby—I thought I had it. I had it for a couple minutes and then I found out I didn't. I feel like I was DQ'ed. I had (Cavonnier) ready, I had him fine-tuned and he ran a great race...that Jerry Bailey, I ought to kill him," he jested. **Halo Sunshine** (Halo), who moved into second at the quarter-pole before weakening to finish a credible fourth as the 28-1 longest shot on the board, will head home to California and will skip the Preakness. "I'd love to run, but for a horse that has had so many races in a short period of time, to come back in two weeks after (the Derby) is not what I would prescribe," said trainer Richard Cross, who indicated that the GII Swaps at Hollywood July 21 could be on the colt's agenda. No word yet on where **Unbridled's Song** (Unbridled) will go next. "There is a flight to Baltimore and a van to Jersey on Wednesday," said trainer Jim Ryerson, who did not regret his decision to run the favorite in bar shoes. "The track might have stung his foot and we might be in worse shape. I'm really happy with his foot this morning and with how he came out of the race." *Wrap-up cont. p2*

Henry Cecil, 10-times British champion trainer, accomplished what he described as his "toughest ever" assignment when nursing Bosra Sham to victory in yesterday's 1000 Guineas. Cecil's star filly has been plagued by a foot problem for the past fortnight and her participation was in question up to 30 minutes before the Classic. But she silenced the doubters by making a late appearance on the course which, when transmitted on the big screen alongside the Rowley Mile, brought cheers from the crowd. There was a contrasting silence for much of the event itself as Papering (Ire) led the field at a good gallop. Bosra Sham eased across to a midfield position from her outside post and, at one stage, she seemed a little short of room. But two furlongs from home she began to make up ground and, despite hanging left on to her problem foot, she soon hit the front going well. Matiya (Ire) finished with a flourish and Bint Shadayid stayed on stoutly, but their efforts were never going to be enough. An inquiry into possible interference as Bosra Sham made her race-winning move was disallowed and once again there was an ecstatic roar of spectator approval. Cecil, clearly moved by the emotional response of the crowd, said: "It almost brings tears to your eyes. The whole build-up to this has been a nightmare and she was always looking after herself during the race. But in the end she has done it well and, assuming she is okay, we'll have to think about either the Irish 1000 Guineas or the Coronation S. at Ascot. She will definitely stick to miling for the moment."

**DERBY WRAP-UP** Of the 19 three-year-olds who started in Saturday's 122nd Kentucky Derby, only the three Team Lukas colts and Cavonnier are definite for the 1 3/16-mile Preakness. **Blow Out** (Marfa), seventh, came out of the race in good order but will stay at Churchill Downs for his next start. **Alyrob** (Alysheba), eighth, will head west and look for a spot to try the grass at Hollywood. Trainer Nick Zito said that **Diligence** (Miswaki) (9th) will not make the trip to Baltimore, but **Louis Quatorze** (Sovereign Dancer) (14th) is a possibility for the Preakness. "Diligence tried, but he tried at the end of the race, which is unusual for him," said Zito. "Louis Quatorze never tried at all. If he is okay and training the same way he was here, he'd be the one to run back (at Pimlico). Why he didn't run at all is a complete mystery." **Corker** (Festin {Arg}), 11th, is out of consideration for the Preakness but could be back for the final jewel in the Triple Crown, the Belmont Stakes June 8. **Skip Away** (Skip Trial), a disappointing 12th Saturday, will ship to Monmouth Park today while trainer Sonny Hine ponders his next move with the colt. "You have got to think about these things because he was so badly beaten," said Hine. "He came back fine and had two buckets of water, which showed he tried. He is a much better horse than he showed." **Zarb's Magic** (Zarbyev), 13th, will ship to Louisiana Tuesday; long-range plans include the GI Super Derby at Louisiana Downs in September. **In Contention** (Devil's Bag) returns to his home base at Philadelphia Park today or tomorrow and could try turf for the first time in his next outing. "We might consider the Jersey Derby (May 27)," said trainer Cynthia Reese. **Matty G** (Capote) (17th) leaves the Triple Crown trail to return to California. **Built for Pleasure** (Homebuilder) (18th) will head south to Florida where he will get some time off. The 122nd Kentucky Derby was witnessed by the third-largest crowd in history with 142,668 on hand at Churchill Downs; the time of the race, 2:01, was the sixth-fastest and the fastest since 1985. Golden Gate Fields set a Northern California handle record with their special Derby Day program; a total of \$7,148,011 was wagered on the nine live races, five stakes simulcast from Churchill and 11 races simulcast from Hollywood Park. The old mark of \$7,093,420 was set on last year's Derby program.

He has a good turn of foot, which he showed here. He goes next for the Prix du Jockey Club (French Derby). This ends a great weekend for the Young family, as Arbatax's owner, Lucy Boutin, is the daughter of Mr. Bill Young, who owns the winner of the Kentucky Derby."

I thought she looked a very special filly." Britain's bookmakers obviously agree and promoted her to 6-4 favourite for the Epsom Classic. Pricket looks to add to the Oaks success of Godolphin's Balanchine and Moonshell.

Sheikh Mohammed's Godolphin string, given the best possible start in Europe's 1996 Classic events when **Mark of Esteem (Ire)** (Darshaan {GB}) took Saturday's 2000 Guineas at Newmarket, has its attention switched to France next weekend.
