ARLINGTON INTERNATIONAL OPENS TODAY

The 1996 Arlington International meet gets underway this afternoon, showcasing "fan-friendly" improvements, a new race caller and a stakes schedule worth more than \$6 million. Arlington's '96 season will introduce the Arlington Passport, a visitor's guide to the track; a racing program just for newcomers; an industry information center to promote handicapping, horse ownership, breeding and group events at the track; BCTV, an in-house TV channel with features on racing personalities, terminology, equipment, handicapping and betting, and promotions; and the Gold Club, an invitation-only club for Arlington's best customers. Australian Michael Wrona, who began his announcing career just outside his native Brisbane 11 years ago and made his U.S. debut in 1990, takes over the microphone; he will have 36 stakes races to call, highlighted by the International Festival of Racing August 24 and 25--six stakes worth \$2.35 million, including the GI Beverly D., GI Secretariat S. and GI Arlington Million. Arlington also unveils SummerFest this year with three graded stakes on the card July 21--the Laurance Armour, Equipoise Mile and American Derby. The 134-day Arlington meet runs through October 13 with live racing Wednesdays through Mondays; post time is set for 1 p.m. every day except Friday, when the first race goes off at 3 p.m.

BELMONT PARK PURSES RAISED Beginning this Wednesday, May 15, purses at Belmont Park will increase between four to five percent. New York Racing Association Chairman and President Kenny Noe, Jr. stated, "The efforts of Governor George Pataki, Senate Majority Leader Joe Bruno and Assembly Speaker Sheldon Silver have allowed (Belmont Racing Secretary) Mike Lakow to raise purses. The legislation passed last year with their backing provided help that the racing industry needed. Racing owes them and their staffs a debt of gratitude." According to Lakow, the increases will effect all overnight purses, with money allowance races going up \$2,000, and other allowances, maiden special weight races and claiming events for tags of more than \$50,000 going up \$1,500; claiming races for \$25,000 to \$50,000 will be raised \$1,000, and those for less than \$25,000 will increase \$500.

Sent off the longest shot on the board despite a sharp second-place finish in the GI Gulfstream Park H. two starts back and the fact that he was getting seven-to-nine pounds from his three rivals, Star Standard used his speed to good advantage and led the short field from gate to wire under jockey Pat Day. Pressed by Dubai shipper Key Of Luck throughout, the four-year-old edged away on the far turn and had enough left in the tank down the lane to hold the runner-up safe. Key Of Luck, who impressed with a 20-length win on the Dubai World Cup undercard March 27, continued on gamely for the place. The Bill Mott-trained duo of Geri and WEKIVA SPRINGS (Runaway Groom) raced as a team down the backstretch and looked to make a bid at the leaders as they headed into the final bend, but the front-runners were able to open up on the crowd's first and third choices, respectively, once again, and the pair finished well back, settling for the minor awards. Winning trainer Nick Zito told ABC's Jim McKay that the Massachusetts H. at Suffolk Downs June 1 could be next for his colt. "We'll have to sit down with the owners and try and figure it out," said Zito. "Maybe we'll go up to the MassCap and run second to Cigar again." Star Standard was runner-up to last year's Horse of the Year in the '95 GI Woodward.

EPSOM DERBY ENTRY UP FOR DISCUSSION

Representatives of the British Horseracing Board and the National Trainers' Federation are to meet Wednesday to discuss possible changes to entry regulations for the Vodafone Epsom Derby. The current rules have come under fire recently after a series of the Classic Trials --including the European Free H., the Chester Vase and the Dee S.--were won by colts not eligible for Epsom's June 8 Classic. The last-named contest was especially significant, because it was collected in 1995 by subsequent multiple Group event hero **Pentire (GB)** (Be My Guest), whose Newmarket trainer Geoff Wragg has suggested a very late supplementary stage should be made available at around £50,000 (\$76,000). Pentire was never given an Epsom entry and this season's Dee S. winner, Wragg's **Prize Giving (GB)** (Most Welcome {GB}), was withdrawn at an early forfeit stage. Both colts would certainly have added spice to any Derby. Paul Greeves, BHB director of racing, stated: "If the NTF believes there is need for change then, hopefully, we can find a new entry system." Officials from Epsom are also expected to attend the talks, but they believe any late supplementary entry fee would need to be set at £100,000 (\$152,000) and are adamant that no changes can be made before the 1998 renewal.

ANTILASSA NAMED NEW YORK'S

BROODMARE OF THE YEAR A panel of members of New York Thoroughbred Breeders, Inc. have voted **Antilassa** (Anticipating) New York's 1995 Broodmare of the Year. The 19-year-old mare was represented last season by multiple-stakes winner Lottsa Talc, who was honored as the 1995 New York-bred champion sprinter and champion older mare; KCV Stable's Antilassa also produced the 1990 New York-bred champion sprinter Appealing Guy. The NYTB panel consisted of Vivien Malloy, Sunny Westerman, Anne McMahon, Kate O'Connell and William Gibson.

ROBERT LEWIS JOINS TOC BOARD Thoroughbred Owners of California has announced the addition of Robert Lewis to its Board of Directors. Lewis was nominated by Chairman Ed Friendly and his appointment was approved during the TOC's monthly Board meeting May 9. Lewis and his wife, Beverly, first ventured into Thoroughbred ownership with partner Arthur Straub before purchasing horses on their own in 1990; they have since campaigned two champions--Serena's Song, who they own outright, and Timber Country, owned in partnership. "I am thrilled to have a man of Bob's integrity and stature join TOC's Board," said Friendly. "I consider him a great asset to racing and am very pleased that he accepted our invitation to join TOC as a Director."
