CLASSIC GLORY FOR ROOKIE

TRAINER In only his second season as a trainer, Newmarket-based Ed Dunlop enjoyed Classic glory with his very first runner at this level when he saddled Sheikh Hamdan al Maktoum's filly **Ta Rib** (Mr. Prospector) to win yesterday's French 1000 Guineas (Poule d'Essai des Pouliches) over a mile at Longchamp. Ridden by Willie Carson, Dunlop's filly took over a furlong and a half out and galloped on resolutely to withstand the late finish of the troubled French-trained favourite **Shake The Yoke (GB)** (Caerleon), who switched to the outside for running room a furlong out but could not get to the winner, falling three-quarters of a length short. Young Dunlop, son of trainer John (who has himself enjoyed much Classic success with horses owned by Sheikh Hamdan) said: "It was the Sheikh's decision to run the filly here in France after she missed the Craven meeting at Newmarket because of a minor injury. She will be kept to miling for the time being and the Irish 1000 Guineas is a possibility, although I will have to discuss it with the Sheikh." Sheikh Hamdan donated all his prize money (his family sponsored the race) to medical research and children's charities. (*French 1000 Guineas chart p2*)

UNBRIDLED UPDATE Unbridled's Song (Unbridled) had a new patch applied to the quarter crack on his left front foot Saturday and galloped without bar shoes for the first time since the injury Sunday morning, but his status for Saturday's Preakness is still up in the air. "He went fine," said trainer Jim Ryerson, but added, "He's going to have to tell us if he can run in the Preakness. It will be a day-to-day thing. (Owner) Ernie (Paragallo) told me to wait until mid-week to make a final decision."

CIGAR TOPS GOLD CUP ELIGIBLES Last year's Hollywood Gold Cup winner **Cigar** (Palace Music) heads a list of 17 horses who remain eligible for the \$1,000,000 event after sustaining nominations closed Friday. As expected, the Aga Khan's French-trained favourite Ashkalani won the French 2000 Guineas, beating the unlucky Spinning World, trained for the Niarchos family by Jonathan Pease. The winner, twice a G3 winner going into this event, remains undefeated in four starts. Ridden by Gerald Mosse, Ashkalani came with his customary strong finish to overhaul the English-trained Tagula in the closing stages, but whether he would have beaten Cash Asmussen on Spinning World if the latter had been able to get a clear run a furlong out is open to doubt. The Aga Khan said of the winner: "He's a very good colt, with lots of speed. I think he was the only one sustaining his speed at the end of the race. We don't know where he will run next, but he may go for the St. James's Palace S. over a mile at Royal Ascot. But he had a harder race than we expected and we will have to wait and see." Alan Cooper, racing manager to the Niarchos family, said of Spinning World: "He ran a great race and he may possibly run in the Epsom Derby, for which he was a late entry. But I will have to discuss the matter with the Niarchos family, the trainer and the jockey."

French-trained Helissio justified favoritism in the Prix Lupin and will now head for the French Derby (Prix du Jockey Club) June 2. Unraced at two, the colt is now three-for-three, including a victory in the G2 Prix Noailles last time he ran. He was always travelling well behind pacesetter LE TRITON (El Gran Senor), took the lead a furlong and a half out and ran on well to beat the Andre Fabre-trained Loup Solitaire. It was a workman-like rather than brilliant performance by the winner and winning trainer Elie Lellouche said: "That was satisfactory. He is still a bit green and has a lot to learn."
