### “QUATORZE” QUASHES COMPETITION IN PREAKNESS

Trainer Nick Zito, the last man to saddle a Triple Crown race winner before D. Wayne Lukas went on a tear that gave him six in a row, yesterday put a stop to the streak, sending out 8-1 **Louis Quatorze** (Sovereign Dancer) to take a handy 3 1/4-length victory going wire-to-wire in the 121st Preakness at Pimlico. Jockey Pat Day picked up the mount and his fifth victory in the event; it was a measure of revenge for the rider, who had won the last two runnings of this race aboard Lukas trainees and piloted Lukas' **Prince Of Thieves** (Hansel) to a third-place finish in the Kentucky Derby before losing the mount to Jerry Bailey. "I was disappointed when I got taken off Prince Of Thieves, but, inevitably, things work out. I come over and do the best that I can and leave the results in the hands of the master," said Day. It was the first Preakness win for Zito, who has already collected two Kentucky Derby trophies this decade; the New York native earned his second Grade I win at the Baltimore track in as many Saturdays after his **Star Standard**, also ridden by Day, produced a similar front-running finish in last week's Pimlico Special. Team Lukas had a trio of starters in the second leg of this year's Triple but could do no better than third with **Editor's Note** (Forty Niner); his **Victory Speech** (Deputy Minister) was fifth and Prince Of Thieves, the most fancied of the three and a three-quarter brother to last year's winner, **Timber Country**, was seventh. "This gives us an opportunity to start a new streak and to show our character," said Lukas. The three-year-olds go at it again in the third leg of the Visa Triple Crown Challenge, the Belmont S. June 8.

Louis Quatorze suffered what was by far the worst defeat of his career when 16th in the Kentucky Derby two weeks ago, but the dark bay with the strip of white lightning down his face bounced back to give his owners and trainer their very first success in the Preakness. The colt showed no speed after finding himself in close quarters at the start of the Derby and never got into the race, but this time bounded out of the gate on top and was never headed, turning back a challenge from Skip Away on the far turn and cruising to a decisive victory, the third straight in the race for new jockey Pat Day. "He turned up the backside pricking his ears and went to waiting on horses; I thought then he'd be tough to beat," said Day. "He came home running." Skip Away, second throughout, easily held the place spot. "The post killed us," said his trainer, Sonny Hine. "He got parked out there on the first turn; we got up to (the winner), but it was too much to overcome." Editor's Note, last early, rallied to get third for the best finish of the Team Lukas entry. "I thought he made a monster run," said trainer D. Wayne Lukas. "Gary (Stevens) thought it was his best race to date." **CAVONNIER** (Batonnier), nosed out in the Derby, was sent off the 7-5 favorite but did not handle the Pimlico surface as well and finished an even fourth. "Quite frankly, he didn't feel the same on it," said jockey Chris McCarron. "It was like he was struggling. I really had to encourage him around the home turn--I've never had to do that before. It wasn't his race today. Hopefully he'll rebound and you'll see the real Cavonnier." The first four are expected to meet again at Belmont Park in three weeks.

Star de Lady Ann was coming off back-to-back stakes wins, having scored in the North Miami Beach S. at Hialeah in Apr. and the Nassau County H. at Belmont May 1. The filly quickly gained the lead, set fractions of :21.80 and :44.45, then dug in gamely to hold off the traffic-plagued Yanks Music. "When I saw the first two fractions, I turned to the owner and said, 'We're in serious trouble'," said winning trainer Bill Perry. "I wanted to be on the lead--her speed is her strength--but I thought they were going too fast. At the end, I kept looking at her, and the wire, her and the wire." Perry said the Mother Goose (June 22) was a possible next start. John Velazquez, rider of previously undefeated 4-5 favorite Yanks Music said, "It was a bad post and there were a lot of horses in here. We had no luck. I tried to get out, but every time I'd get pushed back in. Once clear, she was running really strong at the end." The runner-up also points for the Mother Goose.

**Juddmonte Lockinge S. cont.**

Soviet Line (Ire) put up a courageous display to win the Juddmonte Lockinge S. for the second successive season. The six-year-old gelding broke smartly from the stalls and was always at the front of the field under jockey Richard Quinn. Gabr (GB) (Green Desert) kept him company for four furlongs but, on grass softened by prolonged rain, he soon faded out of contention to leave Charnwood Forest (Ire) as the main danger. Soviet Line, as he often does when put under pressure, drifted steadily left inside the final quarter, but Charnwood Forest could not quite peg him back. Spectrum (Ire), sent off favourite following his good fourth last time out in the G1 Prix Ganay at Longchamp, threatened briefly to make late progress but found little when asked to quicken by jockey John Reid and there may be some physical reason for this distinctly disappointing performance. No explanation was needed from the successful connections, who nominated the G2 Queen Anne S. at Royal Ascot among Soviet Line's next possible targets. The runner-up could also head for that mile contest June 18.

**MARIA'S MON ON THE WORK TAB** Last year's champion two-year-old colt **Maria's Mon** (Wavering Monarch) had his first breeze of the year over the Belmont training track yesterday, going three furlongs in :37, according to trainer Rick Schosberg. "He was perfect," said Schosberg. "It's a good feeling seeing him out doing what he wants to do. He came back bouncing and biting the pony--he was very happy." As for a return date, the trainer said he would breeze every six or seven days and then "worry about his path to the Travers. We had originally planned on a comeback in the Riva Ridge (June 8) because seven furlongs would be an ideal spot, but it's too close. It's hard to say now where he'll come back. What's important is he's on track, going forward and we're looking forward to the rest of the season."

**RANDY SOTH RETURNS TO FLORIDA** Randy Soth has resigned as general manager of Retama Park, effective June 15, and will return to Florida, where he owns a home, to accept that same post at Calder Race Course in Miami. Larry Craft, currently the director of racing at Retama, has been named as vice president and general manager of the Texas track. "I told myself there were only two things that could happen that would make me want to leave Retama Park," said Soth. "They were to pick the correct six numbers in the lottery, or to have an opportunity to work in Florida in the industry I love. I feel like Jimmy Johnson getting to return to Miami."
