PREAKNESS WRAP-UP Louis Quatorze (Sovereign Dancer), whose triumph in Saturday's 121st Preakness was the first wire-to-wire win in the race since Aloma's Ruler in 1982, vanned from Pimlico to trainer Nick Zito's Belmont Park base Sunday morning. Zito said the colt, who equalled the Preakness S. record of 1:53 2/5, is a definite starter for the June 8 Belmont S. Also leaving the Pimlico backside bright and early Sunday was Preakness runner-up **Skip Away** (Skip Trial), who left at about 3:30 a.m. and arrived at Monmouth Park by 8 a.m. Trainer Sonny Hine said late Saturday that Skip Away's odds of running in the Belmont S. are "50-50, maybe 40-60. If the horse is half as tired as me, he needs a rest. We'll give him a little break, make a last-minute decision." Trainer D. Wayne Lukas's three Preakness horses all shipped to Churchill Downs Sunday. **Editor's Note** (Forty Niner) and **Prince of Thieves** (Hansel), third and seventh respectively in the Preakness, will be pointed to the Belmont S., according to Lukas, but fifth-place finisher **Victory Speech** (Deputy Minister) will probably wait for the Gll Dwyer S. at Belmont July 6. Beaten Preakness favorite **Cavonnier** (Batonnier) shipped to Belmont Sunday, but with no guarantee he will run in the Belmont S. "He'll train for a while. If it looks like he likes the surface, we'll run in the Belmont. If he doesn't, we'll take him back home," said Bob Baffert, the colt's California-based trainer. Of Cavonnier's fourth-place effort Saturday, Baffert said, "He was trying; he was running at the end. He's the only horse that passed anybody down the stretch." Baffert added, jokingly, "That second in the Derby is looking pretty good now." Preakness eighth **Allied Forces** (Miswaki) was shipped back to Belmont Park late Saturday and will now return to grass races, with his immediate goal being the Glll Hill Prince S. at 1 1/16-miles over the Belmont turf June 16. **Secreto de Estado** (General Assembly) nearly fell at the start of the Preakness before going on to finish ninth of 12. "He grabbed a quarter," said Eduardo Escobar, exercise rider for trainer Alfredo Callejas. Angel Cordero Jr., conditioner of last-place finisher **Feather Box** (Cherokee Colony), reported Sunday that the colt, who was shipped home to Belmont within two hours of his race at Pimlico, will go next in the Belmont. "If he's okay, I'm gonna run him," Cordero said. "I think it'll be a small field, and it will be good for him."

 Jean-Luc Lagardere's filly Luna Wells scored another impressive victory here, giving her trainer, Andre Fabre, his fifth successive win in the event and setting herself up for a try in either the Epsom Oaks or the French equivalent at Chantilly June 9. Ridden by Thierry Jarnet, Luna Wells came to take the lead at the top of the straight, opened up a few lengths on her rivals and, although Miss Tahiti came with a good finish, was always in command. Lagardere's racing manager, Mr. de Longevialle, said, "She's a true champion. She's only been beaten once in her life, that as a two-year-old. She can do anything, come from behind or take the lead early. We have not yet decided where she will go next, but it will be either to Epsom or to Chantilly." Luna Wells, a daughter of Sadler's Wells, is jointly owned by Lagardere and Coolmore Stud, as she was the subject of a foal sharing agreement between the two parties.

UNBRIDLED'S SONG WORKS AT BELMONT

Unbridled's Song (Unbridled) worked five furlongs over Belmont Park's main track Sunday morning with jockey Mike Smith aboard and was timed in :58.22, breezing. His splits were :12.17, :23.47 and :34.69; the colt was out six furlongs in 1:10 4/5. The Wood Memorial winner, who arrived at Belmont Saturday from Monmouth Park, had been slated to run next in the GII Dwyer S. at Belmont July 6. But his connections are now saying that the three-year-old may resurface in either Sunday's GII Peter Pan S. or Monday's GI Met Mile. Trainer Jim Ryerson said that while those races are under consideration, no definite plans have been made and the condition of Unbridled's Song will dictate whether the colt will run this weekend. "We'll keep an eye on him and see how he comes out of the work," Ryerson said. "The work was fabulous, but he can do that sort of thing." Ryerson added that the bar shoes Unbridled's Song wore to a fifth-place finish in the Kentucky Derby have been removed. The colt, however, is wearing a patch to protect the quarter crack in his left hoof.

HORSES RETURN TO RIVER DOWNS The backstretch area of River Downs has been reopened to horses and horsemen who were evacuated last Thursday because of predicted flooding levels of the Ohio River. While some water covers the inside portion of the main track, no water ever reached the stable area. "It should be a quick clean up," stated track spokesman John Engelhardt. "Unlike the flooding we experienced this winter, the water that is on the track is run-off from the storm system. There won't be a lot of river debris left behind. The water never did make it to the turf course and the main track was well sealed prior to the flooding." Racing was cancelled for today and the track is closed each Tuesday and Wednesday. Officials believe the main track will be open for training Wednesday and that live racing will resume Thursday. River Downs plans to offer "double header" programs this Friday and Sunday.

Day, aboard first-time starter **American Dynasty** (Quiet American), was unseated and struck his head along the outside rail. He complained of a headache to track physician Dr. Ted Forrest, and was taken by ambulance to Caritas Medical Center and later released after a CAT Scan and X-rays revealed no serious injuries. The 42-year-old Hall of Fame rider was scheduled to ride in seven races on Sunday's card but decided to take off the day's mounts.

The previously undefeated DANJUR (Dayjur), sent off the 3-5 favorite, had travelled extensively in the past week, flying from Kentucky to California and then to New York. The four-year-old was rated up close early, then tired in the stretch to be sixth. "The track was very soft and that didn't help him," said Danjur's rider Jerry Bailey. "You can't judge him from today's race."
