UNBRIDLED'S SONG TO MET MILE The next race for **Unbridled's Song** (Unbridled) will be this Monday's GI Metropolitan Mile at Belmont, owner Ernie Paragallo confirmed yesterday. Paragallo had also been considering the GI Peter Pan, which is run the day before. Paragallo added that the June 8 Belmont S. is still a possibility. "I'd like to make the Belmont, but I won't abuse the horse," he said. "If he has an easy race in the Met, which is extremely unlikely against horses like **Afternoon Deelites** (Private Terms) and **Lite the Fuse** (Buckaroo), then we might come back in the Belmont. But that would be a difficult task." Unbridled's Song was assigned 112 pounds for the Met. According to the Jockey Club scale of weights, a three-year-old should get a 14-pound advantage over an older horse in a one-mile race in May, but NYRA Racing Secretary Mike Lakow said he gave the three-year-olds an 11-pound edge in the weights. "I was only concerned with the weights given the top two," Paragallo said. "I wanted eight or nine pounds. The scale isn't important." **Afternoon Deelites** was assigned 123 pounds and **Lite the Fuse** was next at 122. Considering the 11-pound weight advantage, Unbridled's Song was handicapped as the co-starting highweight.

NORTHERN SPUR SET FOR ARC RAID **Northern Spur** (Ire) (Sadler's Wells), winner of last year's Breeders' Cup Turf, will ship to Europe this summer to prepare for a start in the Oct. 6 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe at Longchamp, according to trainer Ron McAnally. McAnally has confirmed his intention to launch a challenge for France's best-known horserace and will probably send his charge to Europe in mid-summer and then give him a prep run as part of his buildup to the Group 1 event. **Northern Spur** was handled at two and three by Chantilly-based Andre Fabre and is expected to lodge with his original trainer from around July. "The Arc has been on the cards for about six weeks," McAnally said, "and horses have to be given a fair chance to acclimate." Fabre, meanwhile, will almost certainly be fielding a strong hand against his former trainee in October. His name appears alongside 26 in the total of 154 preliminary entries for this season's Arc. **Northern Spur** is scheduled to run next in Monday's GI Hollywood Turf H.

METROPOLITAN H.-GI, \$400,000, 3yo/up, 1m

Trainer Dick Dutrow caught **Lite the Fuse** (Buckaroo), winner of the GI Carter H. May 5 for the second straight year, working five furlongs Wednesday at Aqueduct in :59, galloping out seven-eighths in 1:26 under regular jockey Julie Krone. "Everything's fine," said Dutrow. "I couldn't be happier with him." Asked about the presence of **Unbridled's Song** (Unbridled) in the Met Mile, Dutrow said, "That'd be good. It would make it a real interesting race." **Honour and Glory** (Relaunch), 18th in the Kentucky Derby, drilled five furlongs in :59 2/5 at Churchill Downs Monday. "He looks terrific," said George Weaver, assistant to trainer D. Wayne Lukas, adding that John Velazquez will pick up the mount. **Afternoon Deelites** (Private Terms), who will ship to New York today, breezed a half-mile in :50 4/5 Tuesday at Hollywood. Also scheduled to run in the Met Mile are **Flying Chevron** (Carson City), **Criollito** (Arg) (Candy Stripes), **Placid Fund** (Dixieland Band), **Prenup** (Smarten) and **Spanos** (Strawberry Road {Aus}). Withers winner **Appealing Skier** (Baldski) will start in either the Met Mile or Sunday's Peter Pan S.; **Sea Emperor** (Naked Sky) and **Pacific Fleet** (Afleet) are listed as possible starters.

Monday, Hollywood Park:

HOLLYWOOD TURF H.-GI, \$500,000, 3yo/up, 1 1/4mT

Petit Poucet (GB) (Fairy King), a game second to Mecke in the GI Early Times Turf Classic at Churchill Downs May 4, will skip the GI Early Times Manhattan at Belmont June 8 to run in Monday's Hollywood Turf H. "Well, to be honest, if **Labeeb** (GB) (Lear Fan) doesn't go (in the Hollywood Turf H.), it's not as tough a race as it first looked," trainer Ben Cecil said. "We feel we have a decent chance to beat most of those horses." Last year's GI Hollywood Derby winner **Labeeb**, who returned from a 5½-month layoff to take a turf allowance at Hollywood May 12, is listed as possible for the race. The four-year-old has been wearing a protective patch that covers a quarter-crack, and trainer Neil Drysdale said **Labeeb** will work a half-mile today before a decision is made whether to run. **Northern Spur** (Ire) (Sadler's Wells), assigned highweight of 123 pounds, breezed six furlongs in 1:13 2/5 with Chris McCarron up at Hollywood yesterday. Defending Turf H. hero **Earl of Barking** (Ire) (Common Grounds {GB}) went six furlongs in 1:13 2/5 at Santa Anita, also yesterday. Other probables for the race are **Sandpit** (Braz) (Baynoun {Ire}), **Awad** (Caveat) and **The Key Rainbow** (Ire) (Rainbow Quest).

HAWTHORNE H.-GII, \$100,000a, 3yo/up, f/m, 1 1/16m

Borodislew (Seattle Slew), winner of the Santa Lucia H. at Santa Anita in her last outing April 7, drilled a half-mile in :47 1/5 at Hollywood Tuesday. Also breezing at Hollywood Tuesday were **Jewel Princess** (Key to the Mint), who went five furlongs in 1:00 4/5, and **Cat's Cradle** (Flying Paster), who covered the same distance in 1:00 2/5. Borodislew's trainer John Shirreffs has pegged Jewel Princess as the horse to beat in the Hawthorne. "I've seen her run some absolutely unbelievable races," Shirreffs said. "Her win over Radu Cool in the Linda Vista (at Santa Anita) was phenomenal. And then she just beat Serena's Song (in the GII Louisville Breeders' Cup H. May 3). She's definitely the horse to beat." Also pointing to the GII event are **Urbane** (Citidancer), **Sleep Easy** (Seattle Slew), **Klassy Kim** (Silent Screen) and **Above the Table** (Never Tabled).

FRENCH DERBY FIELD TAKES SHAPE France will defend its Derby (Prix du Jockey Club) in strength at Chantilly June 2, with all the best middle-distance three-year-old colts in the country looking almost certain to run in the mile and a half classic. Heading the French team is G1 Prix Lupin winner **Helissio (Fr)** (Fairy King); the runner-up in that event, trainer Andre Fabre's two-year-old champion **Loup Solitaire** (Lear Fan); G2 Prix Greffulhe winner **Ragmar (Fr)** (Tropular {GB}); and G2 Prix Hocquart winner **Arbatax (Ire)** (Mtoto {GB}). Other probables for the French classic include Criquelette Head's pair **L'Africain Bleu (Fr)** (Saint Cyrien {Fr}) and **Dark Nile** (Riverman); and the Michael Tabor-owned and Fabre-trained **Grape Tree Road (GB)** (Caerleon). Fabre, champion trainer in France on several occasions, has yet to train a French Derby winner. Also looking for his first French Derby victory is Loup Solitaire's owner-breeder Daniel Wildenstein.

HIALEAH MEET ENDS Hialeah Park's live race meeting ended Wednesday. Sandi Kleeman led all owners with 13 wins; Dan Hurtak topped the trainers standings with 28 victories; and jockey Abdiel Toribio was the leading rider with 46 winners from 217 mounts. **Class Kris** (Kris S.) was named "Horse of the Meet." The four-year-old turf filly won the \$100,000 Hialeah Breeders' Cup S. March 30 and the GII \$200,000 Black Helen H. April 13. South Florida racing resumes at Calder Race Course Friday.

According to an article in today's *Daily Racing Form*, the management of Philadelphia Park and the Pennsylvania Thoroughbred Horsemen's Association reached an agreement Monday night on the issue of arbitration and signed a contract good through Dec. 31, 1997. Simulcasting resumed Tuesday at the track and its off-track betting facilities, which had been closed since Sunday, and entries were taken for the return of live racing Saturday.

Whitewater Affair may have earned herself a supplementary entry for the Epsom Oaks after a brave victory here. Driving rain made conditions difficult for Britain's final trial for the Oaks, but **SCARLET PLUME (GB)** (Warning) led the field at a good gallop in her bid to give trainer John Dunlop his fifth successive win in the race. Shemozzle and Whitewater Affair, however, were always keeping tabs on her and, a quarter of a mile out, appeared to be going best. Papering also put in a late challenge but lacked racing room between the eventual winner and second and was left to switch right before ensuring herself of third spot. Successful owner-breeder John Greetham said, "The final decision about whether Whitewater Affair is supplemented for the Oaks will be left to (trainer) Michael Stoute, but the alternative would be the Ribblesdale S. at Ascot."

The Elie Lellouche-trained filly **Shake The Yoke** (Caerleon), runner-up to **Ta Rib** (Mr. Prospector) in the Poule d'Essai des Pouliches (French 1000 Guineas), will miss the Prix de Diane (French Oaks) at Chantilly June 9 and will be kept instead for the one-mile G1 Coronation S. at Royal Ascot June 19.

Connections of **Dr Massini (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) appear confident that the colt will be able to run in the Epsom Derby June 8 after a veterinary examination on his off foreleg revealed no serious problems. The Michael Stoute-trainee was discovered to be lame Monday morning, but his owner Michael Tabor now describes himself as "guardedly optimistic" for a run in Britain's premier Classic. Dr Massini was one of 34 three-year-olds, including six U.S. breds, to appear on the list of acceptors released by Epsom Wednesday afternoon.

The Aga Khan's impressive G1 Prix Ganay winner **Valanour (Ire)** (Lomond) appears to have scared off several high-class opponents for next Monday's G1 Prix d'Ispahan at Longchamp. The four-year-old son of Lomond is one of only seven horses still engaged in the extended mile and an eighth event after the first forfeit stage, but the race is open to supplementary entries today.
