**BLOW OUT EUTHANIZED** Kentucky Derby seventh **Blow Out** (Marfa) was euthanized at Churchill Downs yesterday after breaking down during the running of the seventh race, a 1 1/16-mile allowance for three-year-olds. The bay colt, ridden by Pat Day, was sent off the 1-2 favorite. He appeared to take a bad step leaving the five-sixteenths pole and broke down; Day was able to bail off over the colt's left side, escaping injury. Blow Out was twice stakes-placed, finishing second in the GIII Rebel S. at Oaklawn in March and the Turfway Park Prevue S. at age two. He had two wins in 10 career outings for earnings of \$106,064.

**MOTT FINED FOR TURNDOWNS** Trainer Bill Mott was fined \$1,000 yesterday by New York Racing Association stewards for sending his horse, **Sir Cat** (Storm Cat), to the Belmont paddock with turndowns, shoes prohibited at NYRA tracks. NYRA Steward Bill Boland explained that Sir Cat was wearing a version of turndown shoes in which he had been training. The shoes had been straightened, but not enough to meet NYRA guidelines. Boland said Mott had previously brought a horse into the paddock wearing similar shoes and had been warned not to do it again. "It was a very slight turndown," said Boland. "Still, he broke the rules."

**CALDER OPENS TODAY** The 1996 Calder racing season opens today with a nine-race live card, full-card simulcasting from Belmont Park and free grandstand admission to kick off the Memorial Day weekend. Post time for the first race is 1 p.m. with racing five days each week, Thursdays through Mondays. The \$35,000a Needles H. Saturday is the first of 42 stakes worth \$3.7 million to be run during the 122-day meet, which opens with record daily purse distribution. The 1996 Calder Race Course meet runs through Nov. 5 with the Tropical at Calder meet commencing Nov. 7 and concluding Jan. 2, 1997.

**Sunday, Belmont Park:**

**PETER PAN S.-GII, \$150,000, 3yo, 9f**

Fresh off Wednesday's decision to run in this Monday's Metropolitan H., the **Unbridled's Song** (Unbridled) team has again reversed direction, announcing yesterday that there was now "serious consideration" to enter the colt in Sunday's Peter Pan. "If we're looking at the Belmont S., the 1 1/8th-mile Peter Pan might be a better spot for him," said trainer Jim Ryerson. Trainer Nick Zito said **Diligence** (Miswaki) will definitely be starting in the race. "We're hoping Diligence will have the same kind of success **Louis Quatorze** (Sovereign Dancer) had. Louie didn't run his race in the Kentucky Derby and came back a winner (in the Preakness), and we're hoping the same thing will happen with Diligence." **Instant Friendship** (Cormorant) worked a half-mile on the turf yesterday morning in :48.23. Said trainer Leo O'Brien, "I'd rather have a little more time for him, but we'll probably go in the Peter Pan."

**IRISH 1000 GUINEAS-G1, \$233,936, 3yo, f, 1mT**

John Oxx, who saddled subsequent Breeders' Cup Mile heroine Ridgewood Pearl to win last year's Irish 1000 Guineas, launches a three-pronged attack in his bid to follow up in tomorrow's renewal of the Irish Classic. Oxx will be represented by **Asmara** (Lear Fan), the mount of Christy Roche; **Sheraka (Ire)** (Doyoun), partner of Gerald Mosse; and **Zafzala (Ire)** (Kahyasi), selected from the three by Irish champion jockey Johnny Murtagh. Other possible starters are: **Abir (GB)** (Soviet Star); **Bint Shadayid** (Nashwan), ridden by British champion Frankie Dettori; **Ceirseach (Ire)** (Don't Forget Me); **Dance Design (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells); **Distant Oasis** (Green Desert); the English 1000 Guineas runner-up **Matiya (Ire)** (Alzao); **My Branch (GB)** (Distant Relative); **Princess Tycoon (Ire)** (Last Tycoon); **Priory Belle (Ire)** (Priolo); and **Tossup** (Gone West).

## HONEYMOON H.-GIII, \$125,000a, 3yo, f, 1 1/8mT

**Clamorosa** (Seattle Dancer) took her first spin over Hollywood's turf course Thursday, breezing a half-mile in :52 (dogs up). The Maryland-bred filly was claimed for \$25,000 at Gulfstream three months ago and has won two of three starts for new owner Jeffrey S. Sullivan, including stakes at Turfway Park and Keeneland. Most recently, she set a Keeneland track record for 1 1/8-miles on the turf in 1:46 4/5 while winning the Palisades S. Also working for the Honeymoon H., 122-pound highweight **Antespend** (Spend a Buck) drilled five furlongs in 1:00 yesterday for trainer Ron McAnally. Antespend raced exclusively on the grass at age two, winning the GIII Miesque S. at Hollywood and the Green River S. at Keeneland. She has raced on the dirt in all five of her starts at three, winning the GI Santa Anita Oaks, GI Las Virgenes S. and Santa Ysabel S., and most recently finishing fourth in the GI Kentucky Oaks. Also pointing to the Honeymoon H. are **Gastronomical** (Sunshine Forever), **Ribot's Secret (Ire)** (Danehill), **Hear the Music (Ire)** (Common Grounds {GB}), **Staffin (GB)** (Salse), **Rumpipumpy (GB)** (Shirley Heights {GB}) and **Taxable Deduction** (Prized).

## SHUVEE H.-GI, \$150,000, 3yo/up, f/m, 1m

The field, from the rail out, will be: **Supah Jess** (On to Glory), **Halo America** (Waquoit), **Clear Mandate** (Deputy Minister), **Smooth Charmer** (Easy Goer), **Restored Hope** (He's Bad), **In Conference** (Dayjur) and **Twist Afleet** (Afleet). Highweighted at 124 pounds, Twist Afleet concedes six to 13 pounds to her seven rivals in looking to keep her 1996 record perfect after a win in the Vagrancy H. last out.

## CANADIAN HORSEMEN OPPOSE RACING

**CHANNEL** A proposed 24-hour national horse racing television network in Canada has run into some opposition from horsemen. Representatives of the Ontario Thoroughbred and Harness Divisions both expressed their disapproval yesterday in Ottawa, where the network's application is being heard by the Canadian Radio/Television and Telecommunications Commission. The application is expected to be either approved or disapproved later this summer. If approved, the channel will begin broadcasting early next year. The proposal is designed to include 12 hours of horse racing as well as other items related to horses. The Ontario Jockey Club is a major backer of the channel, and is expected to be featured largely if the application is successful. The horsemen are against the channel because they feel it will cut into their share of the profits derived from wagering.
