**STAR STANDARD OUT OF MASSCAP** Trainer Nick Zito announced yesterday that GI Pimlico Special winner **Star Standard** (Risen Star) will not run in the Massachusetts H. June 1 as originally planned. "He worked (Friday) morning in 1:01 and change and he's just a little tired," said Zito. "The horse next to him at Pimlico was sick, and his blood count came back a little low. He's just starting to come around (after the Special) and it wouldn't be right to try and make the race unless he was 100 percent. It breaks our hearts not to run. He just needs a little more time." Weights for the MassCap will not be officially released until Saturday, but Suffolk Downs Racing Secretary John Morrissey confirmed yesterday that **Cigar** (Palace Music) has been assigned highweight of 130 pounds for the race. **Key Of Luck** (Chief's Crown) is in with 118.

**MONMOUTH PARK OPENS TODAY** Offering a record daily purse distribution of \$230,000 to start the meet, Monmouth Park opens its gates today for the 51st season of Thoroughbred racing. The Oceanport, New Jersey, oval is hoping to add to two straight years of increased attendance and handle. "We've had two good years thanks to hard work and the right mix of live racing and full-card simulcasting," said Hal Handel, executive vice president and chief operating officer of the New Jersey Sports and Exposition Authority. "We think with the same solid mix and a few additions we can continue our growth." One addition is the new Clubhouse Pavilion, a covered dining area located on the clubhouse turn which will cater to groups of 45 to 125 people. A recap of the day's races will be broadcast in the New York metropolitan area for the first time; the replay show will be aired on SportsChannel between 6-6:30 p.m. Highlighting the 15-race stakes schedule, worth more than \$2.6 million, is the GI \$750,000 Buick Haskell Invitational August 4, and GI \$300,000 Philip H. Iselin H. August 25. Monmouth will also take entries for 43 overnight stakes with \$40,000 purses. The 73-day meet runs through September 2.

And while she has a lot of questions to answer, this could be the start of a championship campaign." The five-year-old is 12-for-14 lifetime, including a pair of Grade I wins. **Restored Hope** (He's Bad) was a well-beaten third to champions Inside Information and Sky Beauty in this event last year; the five-year-old, seven-for-10 lifetime, came back from a three-month break to finish a close third in Aqueduct allowance company April 28 in her latest effort.
