MATIYA'S IRISH GUINEAS VICTORY

Matiya (GB) (Alzao) underlined the strength of the Newmarket 1000 Guineas form when running away with the Irish equivalent at The Curragh yesterday. The Hamdan al Maktoum-owned filly was second to **Bosra Sham** (Woodman) on her previous Classic assignment but always seemed in complete control in this less exalted company. She shadowed her pacemaker **Abir (GB)** (Soviet Star) until halfway, was then asked to stretch by jockey Willie Carson and soon put plenty of daylight between herself and her rivals. **Dance Design (GB)** (Sadler's Wells) stayed on steadily for second and the Newmarket fourth **My Branch (GB)** (Distant Relative) collected third. But **Bint Shadayid** (Nashwan), third to Bosra Sham in the English version three weeks ago, figured only briefly and finished back in the pack. She may not have been suited by the easier ground she found here. Winning trainer Ben Hanbury was clearly delighted with Matiya's win. "She's a fantastic filly and has come on mentally since Newmarket," he said. "Whether she would ever beat Bosra Sham is open to question. But it all went to plan in this race and, even though Willie (Carson) said she was getting tired near the end, that was probably because she was in the lead so far out. I'd like her to run in the Epsom Oaks (book-makers quote her at 5-1), but the final decision is, of course, entirely Sheikh Hamdan's."

MOTT ACCEPTS MASSCAP IMPOST Trainer Bill Mott was not surprised that his superstar **Cigar** (Palace Music) was weighted at 130 for the Massachusetts H., and will send the six-year-old to Suffolk Downs for the nine-furlong test June 1. "The weight is in the neighborhood of what we expected," said Mott. "The spread is fair. I think if he can carry 130 and win it would be another historically significant event for him." Cigar was weighted from 12 to 25 pounds higher than the other 20 nominees; second highweight **Key Of Luck** (Chief's Crown), 118, is also pointing for the race. **Personal Merit** (Turkoman), 111, fourth in the race last year, will fly in from his home base at Calder Wednesday.

Clear Mandate captured Philadelphia Park's GII Cotillion H. last Sept. at odds of 28-1, but most recently finished fifth in the GII Louisville Breeders' Cup H. May 3 in her second start since the Cotillion. The filly stalked the favorites turning for home before sweeping past them in the stretch to win as the longest shot in the field. "I knew she wasn't going to be favored, but I didn't think she'd be 25-1," winning trainer Rusty Arnold said after the race. "She's run one bad race in her life." Favored **TWIST AFLEET** (Afleet) came into the Shuvee with 12 wins from 14 starts but suffered the worst defeat of her career as she tired to sixth. Her trainer John Kimmel said, "The filly didn't look like she gave any effort. She's been so consistent and it makes me nervous because she didn't try hard today. Something may show on her tomorrow or the next day."
