“FIRST PUNCH” KO’S UNBRIDLED’S

SONG It was supposed to be a first-round knockout for 1-5 **Unbridled’s Song** (Unbridled), but when 7-1 challenger **Jamies First Punch** (Fit to Fight) took it to him at the top of the stretch, the champ never even got his gloves up, taking a standing eight-count as the lightly raced and lightly regarded gelding dashed home to a two-and-a-half length victory in yesterday’s GII Peter Pan S. at Belmont Park. “Believe me, I’m at a loss for words,” said Mike Smith, who piloted the favorite to a second-place finish. “It’s mind-boggling and frustrating. He was going great down the backside, he was good on the turn, but when he switched leads, that was it. What it means, I don’t know. He pulled up fine and came back fine.” It was the second straight disappointment from the grey, who became the 18th straight losing favorite in the Kentucky Derby when he came home fifth wearing bar shoes at Churchill on the first Saturday in May. The bar shoes were off yesterday, but the colt could not overcome a constantly changing schedule which saw him pointed for the Preakness, then the Met Mile, then the Dwyer, then back to the Met Mile, before his connections finally decided on a run in the Peter Pan. The Belmont S. June 8 was supposed to be the next possible spot, but owner Ernie Paragallo said after the race, “Right now, I don’t know what is a possibility.” (Peter Pan chart, p2)

CIGAR ON TARGET FOR MASSCAP Allen Paulson’s **Cigar** (Palace Music) had his final major prep for Saturday’s \$250,000 Massachusetts H. yesterday morning, going six furlongs in 1:14 at Belmont Park with jockey Jerry Bailey in the irons. The six-year-old breezed through fractions of :24 1/5, :36 1/5 and :48 3/5. The Bill Mott trainee, pointing for his first start since his gutsy win in the Dubai World Cup March 27, will ship to Suffolk Downs Friday. **Key Of Luck** (Chief’s Crown) is expected to arrive Wednesday.

Spinning World became the first French-trained horse to win the Irish 2000 Guineas when he convincingly won yesterday’s running at The Curragh. Perfectly ridden by Cash Asmussen, the Jonathon Pease trained colt sat just behind early pacemakers RUSSIAN REVIVAL (Nureyev) and Rainbow Blues before ensuring a clear run by making his late challenge well wide of the rails, taking the lead at the two-furlong pole and drawing clear in a canter. The win is significant compensation for his last run, where he finished a luckless second behind Ashkalani in the Prix d’Essai de Poulains. Pease has already removed Spinning World from the Epsom Derby list as he feels the colt will be better suited to distances less than that mile and a half. The St James’s Palace S. at Royal Ascot may be considered as his next target, if there is give in the ground.

Coral Reef set a strong early pace, with FLYFISHER (IRE) (Batshoof {Ire}) in second. These two dominated the early stages of the race, with Bahamian Knight mid-division until coming into the straight when the 'men were sorted from the boys.' Playing a patient waiting game, the winner came with a strong run three furlongs from home; Backdrop finished very strongly to be second. This Italian Derby victory was the 10th in the last 11 years for foreign-trained horses.

Looking to bounce back from his fifth-place showing in the Kentucky Derby, odds-on Unbridled's Song cruised right to the lead when the gates opened; he was in the clear through sharp early fractions of :22.92, :45.23 and 1:09.33 and looked to have the race in hand as the short field of five headed around the far turn. Second-choice Diligence had made a move at the leader down the backstretch but could never get on even terms, but when Jamies First Punch ranged up alongside as they straightened for home, Unbridled's Song did not battle back, offering no response as the gelding swept past and drew away to victory. The winner, four-for-six going into the Peter Pan and first in the Gill Bay Shore two back, was making his first start beyond a mile; he finished second in the Gill Withers Mile last out. "I'm just real happy, that's all," said trainer Bobby Barbara. "He ran a great race." Added jockey John Velazquez, "It worked out perfect for me. There was a lot of speed in the race, and my horse came with a good run. That's the way the track has been playing today. Speed has been coming back. He won it pretty easy." Plans for the first three finishers are up in the air, but trainer Nick Zito said third-placed Diligence would definitely not try the Belmont S. June 8.

SIMULCASTING CHANGES PROPOSED FOR NEW YORK

A proposed bill, backed by the offices of the governor and the leaders of the state senate and assembly, would allow for unlimited simulcasting in New York. As a trade-off for allowing OTB to take in additional out-of-state races, the New York tracks would receive a larger cut of all bets made off track. According to New York Racing Association Director of Communications and Development Steve Crist, the tracks would receive 8 percent of any bet made off track on any race, with 4 percent going to purses and 4 percent going to the track. For all simulcast races run from 10:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., the money would go to Thoroughbred tracks; bets made from 7:00 p.m. to 10:00 a.m. would go to harness tracks. All money wagered on daytime simulcasts at New York City, Suffolk or Nassau OTB would go to NYRA tracks; Finger Lakes would get the revenue from wagers made at Capital, Catskill and Western OTB. "In principle, we're in favor of it," said Crist. "We've been lobbying very strongly for the idea of increased simulcasting, letting the public and the market decide what to bet on. But we want to be paid as if it was our own races."

Sandpit (Brz) (Baynoun {Ire}) has been first or second in all six starts at this distance, but looks for his first win since taking last year's GI Caesars Palace Turf H. over this course in July. He finished second to **Earl Of Barking (Ire)** (Common Grounds {GB}) in this event last year. **Petit Poucet (GB)** (Fairy King) set the pace and just missed in the GI Early Times Turf Classic at Churchill last out, finishing second by a head with Sandpit back in fifth and Earl Of Barking in eighth; the four-year-old, on the board in eight-of-11 lifetime, was G1SP in France before launching his American campaign with a rallying third-place finish, beaten just a half-length, in the '95 GI Secretariat S. at this distance.

THORO-GRAPH ANALYSIS by Jerry Brown

The Met Mile is truly one of America's great races. Contested over a one-turn mile featuring a long straight-away, the Met gives sprinters and routers a chance to compete on a level playing field, and is always a fascinating handicapping exercise.

This year's field contains several horses who will be overbet, making it a good wagering event. **Criolitto (Arg)** (Candy Stripes) has never run fast enough to threaten here, and neither has **Flying Chevron** (Carson City), whose recent 4 was the best Thoro-Graph figure of his life. **Afternoon Deelites** (Private Terms) (2 1/2) and **Prenup** (Smarten) (1) just ran huge lifetime best efforts, and both are extreme bounce candidates.

Lite The Fuse (Buckaroo) is solid at the 2 level, and showed last year in this race that he could handle the distance. **Placid Fund** (Dixieland Band) and **Our Emblem** (Mr. Prospector) are a little slower, but get breaks in the weights worth a couple of lengths.

The Thoro-Graph play is a box of Lite The Fuse, Placid Fund and Our Emblem. *The Thoro-Graph handicapper's line offers analyses and suggested plays for six major tracks daily. Lahint, fourth in the GI Early Times Turf Classic in his last start, stalked the leaders before rallying in the stretch and held off the late-charging Desert Waves and Kiridashi. "I had a clean race, a perfect stalking trip really," said winning jockey Todd Kabel. "He actually hung a little bit on me nearing the wire, but when the other horse came alongside, he was going to go on with him and win anyway."
