KEY OF LUCK DOUBTFUL FOR MASSCAP

Sheikh Maktoum al Maktoum's **Key Of Luck** (Chief's Crown) is suffering from a bruised left front foot sustained Friday and his chances of making Saturday's Massachusetts H. are now doubtful. "He came down with it a couple of days ago," said trainer Kiaran McLaughlin. "We didn't really tell anyone over the weekend because it's usually a day-to-day thing and it will clear up quickly, but it hasn't. He's not 100 percent, and he'd need to have a lot of improvement in just one day now for us to think he'd be ready in time."

UNBRIDLED'S SONG ON THE SHELF?

Unbridled's Song (Unbridled), second at 1-5 in Sunday's Gil Peter Pan S. at Belmont, was scoped after the race and found to be suffering from a lung infection. "I don't know what bearing it had on his performance," admitted trainer Jim Ryerson. "He did not bleed, but to what degree the infection compromised his performance, I don't know. There was a good stream of mucous leading into his lungs. We had a culture taken and he will be placed on antibiotics to try and clear it up." Ryerson added that the colt came out of the race sound, unbothered by the quarter crack which compromised his chances in the Kentucky Derby. As for the future, the trainer said, "He's shown us in his last two races that he's probably been better. From his last two races, he's telling us the Belmont S. (June 8) is not the direction to go. It would be asking a lot based on his last two efforts, and I think Mr. Paragallo feels the same way."

IRISH PAIR FOR FRANCE **Matiya (Ire)** (Alzao) and **Dance Design (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells), the first two home in Saturday's Irish 1000 Guineas, look set to meet again the G1 Prix de Diane (French Oaks) at Chantilly June 9. Britain's bookmakers shortened Epsom Oaks odds on the two fillies following their Classic clash at the weekend. But both sets of connections seem to be favouring France rather than England next time out. Ben Hanbury, trainer of **Matiya**, said: "(Jockey) Willie Carson feels she won't stay a mile and a half and there is a lot of speed in her pedigree. I think they (owner Hamdan al Maktoum's team) are leaning towards the French Oaks." That race also looks the most probable target for **Dance Design**. Her handler Dermot Weld explained: "She needs more than a mile and will definitely step up in distance. I haven't firmly ruled out Epsom, but the French Oaks looks the more likely."

Honour and Glory could not stay the mile-and-a-quarter of the Kentucky Derby last time out, leading for just a half before folding to finish 18th. Getting a significant break in the weights facing older horses at a mile in his first start since, the three-year-old once again showed his speed from the start, racing head-and-head with favored **Afternoon Deelites** to deep stretch before edging clear late to set a new stakes record and miss the track record by just a tick. The victory, the third for a three-year-old in the last five runnings of this event, gave jockey John Velazquez, who rode Peter Pan winner **Jamies First Punch** Sunday, his second upset victory of the holiday weekend. "He went the first quarter (:22.33) easy and picked it up after that," said Velazquez. "Two-and-a-half furlongs out I said, 'Let's go' and my horse responded. I think the 110 pounds helped him." Added winning owner Michael Tabor, "It's a great kick to win this race. In my opinion, he won't go further than a mile, but you know Wayne (Lukas). When you have a trainer like Wayne, you go with him. He's done some unconventional things." **Afternoon Deelites** continued on gamely to dead-heat for second with second choice **Lite The Fuse**. Plans for the top three are undecided.

Sandpit (Brz) had started twice since running 8th in the Japan Cup last Nov., notching 2nd in the GIII Fort Harrod H. at Keeneland and 5th in the GI Early Times Turf Classic at Churchill May 4. Back home and at a distance he favors, the chestnut allowed PETIT POUCKET (GB) (Fairy King) to set the pace on a lengthy lead to the far turn before asserting himself once again as a leader of the division. "The last six months, things just haven't gone his way, but he really ran a big race today--probably the best of his entire career," said assistant trainer Gary Mandella. Northern Spur (Ire) rallied late but was second best. "He wasn't interested in the race the first part of it," said jockey Chris McCarron. "He made a little bit of a run, passed a couple of horses...he just didn't run his best race today." The winner heads to Atlantic City to try for his second straight Caesars International June 22; the runner-up will await the Caesars Palace Turf Championship July 21.
