LABOR WOES THREATEN WOODBINE BREEDERS' CUP

There is a possibility that the Breeders' Cup might not be held at Woodbine this October. The Breeders' Cup Ltd. is concerned about the ongoing labor dispute between the Ontario Jockey Club and its mutual employees; the clerks have been locked out since March 23, the opening day of the Thoroughbred season. The mutual workers' union rejected the OJC's most recent offer early last month after track management fired three of the locked-out employees for malicious behavior on the picket lines. In addition, the Ontario Federation of Labor has announced a general strike of protest in Toronto October 25 and 26 against the anti-union policies of the ruling Progressive Conservative party of Ontario, which is rumored to be meeting that weekend. This year's Breeders' Cup is scheduled for October 26. The Breeders' Cup Ltd. is expected to reach a decision concerning a possible change of venue as early as Tuesday. "Our primary and major responsibility is to ensure that the Breeders' Cup Championship is put on under the most advantageous conditions," said Breeders' Cup President James E. Bassett III. "We would be acting irresponsibly if we exposed it to any unnecessary risk of disruption."

VETTORI ON THE MOVE Last year's Poule d'Essai des Poulains winner **Vettori (Ire)** (Machiavellian), retired to stud at France's Haras le Fresnay-le-Buffard for this season, has now been sold to stand in Australia. The one-time Henry Cecil and Godolphin trainee has been purchased by Baramul Stud in Hunter Valley, New South Wales for an undisclosed sum. But the terms of the deal allow for a return to his original Normandy base in the future. Vettori, successful on the second of his two juvenile starts, won the French G1 event on his first appearance after spending a winter in Dubai. He subsequently finished sixth in the Epsom Derby and then third on what proved to be his final start in Royal Ascot's St. James's Palace S.

Tuesdail Laboratories will continue to serve as the primary testing facility for the California Horse Racing Board after the Board approved an \$878,800 contract with the Tustin lab for the 1996-97 fiscal year Friday. The new agreement marks a \$200,000 increase over the current contract, primarily because, as of July, the laboratory will double its use of the highly sensitive Elisa tests. The Board also extended its complementary drug testing program with Iowa State University for another year.

Sheikh Mohammed's Godolphin team, successful in last year's Epsom Derby with Lammtarra, is likely to be without a contender in next Saturday's renewal of Britain's premier Classic event. Both **Mark Of Esteem (Ire)** (Darshaan {GB}), hero of the 2000 Guineas at Newmarket, and the unbeaten colt **Mick's Love (Ire)** (Law Society) have suffered setbacks which will prevent them lining-up next weekend. Mark Of Esteem was found to have a high temperature earlier this week; Mick's Love, who was all set to stand in for the Guineas winner, has injured an ankle. Also counted out of the Derby line-up is one-time favourite **Nash House (Ire)** (Nashwan), who flopped in last month's G2 Dante S. at York. Peter Chapple-Hyam, his trainer, said: "Although he is okay, he simply hasn't come back to himself in time for the Derby." That leaves **Dushyantor** (Sadler's Wells) and **Glory of Dancer (GB)** (Shareef Dancer) as co-favourites in the current betting at 9-2.
