CIGAR WEIGHTLESS IN MASSCAP Reigning Horse of the Year Cigar (Palace Music) moved one step closer to immortality yesterday with an effortless win under a career-high impost of 130 pounds in the 57th running of the MassCap at Suffolk Downs. The last horse to win the MassCap under 130 pounds was Whirlaway in 1942. With his victory, Cigar came one step closer to equaling Citation's modern North American record of 16 straight victories, achieved between 1948 and 1950. Cigar has now become the fifth horse this century to reel off 15 in a row. "What can I say, he was superb," said winning jockey Jerry Bailey. "I spent more time pulling him back than I did asking him to run. One more and he's broken the record. I'm aware of the record and I think everybody in the world has to be aware of the streak by now. Heck, Cigar is so smart he's probably aware of it." Trainer Bill Mott, who brought Cigar to Suffolk last year to win the MassCap in 1:48 3/5, a full second faster than yesterday's running, enjoyed his time in Boston once again. "They really made him feel very welcome and they gave him star treatment," Mott said. "You could see it on the walk up here; they were screaming for him passing the eighth pole. They gave him a real down home welcome and it's great. Most of it is for Cigar, but some of that is for everyone here on this team." Mott summed up Cigar's performance, saying, "I don't know if he has any weaknesses, and his strength is clearly his mental attitude. He looked like a real champ today. He showed us that he's back and ready for more."

MY FLAG DEFINITE FOR BELMONT

STAKES The June 8 Belmont S. will be the next stop for My Flag (Easy Goer), trainer Shug McGaughey said Saturday morning after the Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies winner breezed five furlongs at Belmont in 1:00.19, going the last three-eighths in a quick :35.21. "As things stand now, if she comes out of the work all right and has a good week, she'll run," said McGaughey. "I thought her work was excellent and she couldn't be doing any better than she is right now." My Flag, winner of the GI Ashland S. at Keeneland April 20 before finishing fifth as the favorite in the GI Kentucky Oaks May 3, galloped out six furlongs in 1:12.39 yesterday, pulling up in 1:24.80. She will become just the 20th filly to run in the Belmont, won by her sire in 1989.

In 127 runnings of the Belmont S., only two fillies have won--Ruthless in 1867 and Tanya in 1905. The last filly to enter the classic was Winning Colors, who finished sixth in 1988. "It's going to be exciting for us to run," said McGaughey. "(Owner) Mr. Phipps asked me if I thought we'd have a chance, and I told him 'Yes.' He said, 'Then that's what I want to do.'" McGaughey added that Mike Smith will ride in the Belmont, taking over for Jerry Bailey, who has ridden the chestnut filly in all 10 of her previous outings.

UNBRIDLED'S SONG DEVELOPS ULCER

The latest chapter in the soap opera life of Breeders' Cup Juvenile/Florida Derby/Wood Memorial winner **Unbridled's Song** (Unbridled) is that the top three-year-old colt is suffering from an ulcer. Trainer Jim Ryerson confirmed yesterday, "We took him to Dr. (William) Reed, he scoped him, and there was evidence of an ulcer. We've put him on some medication and will keep him in light training. I don't think any race is definite for him right now." Ryerson added, "He's really not in any discomfort. Hopefully this is not something serious and it's something we can get under control." The gray colt, second in last Sunday's Gil Peter Pan S., is scheduled to be reevaluated by the veterinarian in three weeks time.

CHURCHILL DOWNS INCREASES PURSES

Churchill Downs officials announced Saturday an increase of 16 percent for all overnight purses, effective immediately and for the remainder of the 122nd Spring Meet, which ends June 30. "The increase is an obvious reflection of the success of our racing program," said Churchill Downs Vice President of Racing Don Richardson. "This is undoubtedly the largest one-time purse increase in the 13-year tenure of Track President Tom Meeker. With this increase in place, Churchill Downs daily average purses may climb to nearly \$400,000." For the meet, Churchill Downs has shown increases in both interstate activity on Churchill races and whole-card wagering in Kentucky on out-of-state sources. Interstate wagering has climbed 46 percent, while whole-card handle, within Kentucky, has increased 67 percent.

BREEDERS' CUP RELEASES STATEMENT

REGARDING WOODBINE James E. Bassett III, president of Breeders' Cup Limited, yesterday released a statement regarding the precarious position of Woodbine as host of this year's Oct. 26 Breeders' Cup Championship Day. The statement read as follows: "In view of today's press coverage and the response of the Ontario Federation of Labour, Breeders' Cup Limited wishes to make its position in regard to the Championship event

absolutely clear. Breeders' Cup Limited fully recognizes and appreciates the need for the Ontario Jockey Club to manage its own business and has always held the view that the mutual clerk labour dispute would be resolved early enough so that it would not affect the operation of the Championship event. Now, however, the concerns of Breeders' Cup Limited go much further as a result of the Ontario Federation of Labour's call for labour action October 25 and 26. This action could result in disruption of regular services and commerce throughout Toronto, not just Woodbine Racetrack. Toronto may be an unpredictable environment which Breeders' Cup Limited would not want its event nor visitors exposed to. Therefore, regardless of the outcome of the Ontario Jockey Club's labour dispute, Breeders' Cup Limited will require assurance from the Ontario Federation of Labour that all locations, venues and services related to the Breeders' Cup city wide will be free from inconvenience and disruption for its patrons."

EPSOM OAKS FIELD TAKES SHAPE

This Friday's \$302,206-added Epsom Oaks, run over a mile and a half and sponsored by Vodafone, will have a maximum of 13 runners. Bidding to push his career earnings over the \$8 million mark, Cigar settled behind the early leaders, allowing longshots Prolanzier and WILL TO REIGN (Cox's Ridge) to battle through quick fractions of :22 2/5 and :45 4/5. Jockey Jerry Bailey finally allowed the eager champion to pass the leaders on the outside, entering the far turn. Cigar drew clear on the final turn while in hand, then galloped down the stretch to win with authority. Even with no place or show wagering on the event, there was a minus pool of \$33,933.34 at Suffolk Downs. Handle on the race itself was \$1,053,704. A crowd of 22,169 was on hand to cheer Cigar home, the largest at Suffolk Downs since July 4, 1966. Trainer Bill Mott confirmed after the race that the champion's next stop will be the \$1 million Hollywood Gold Cup June 30.
