**SKIP AWAY EARNS BELMONT START** Preakness runner-up **Skip Away** (Skip Trial) stamped himself a starter in the June 8 Belmont S. with a strong move at Monmouth Sunday. "The clockers said it was by far the best work of the morning," said trainer Sonny Hine. "I got him going in 1:12 and change for the six furlongs. He went seven-eighths in 1:25 and galloped out the mile in 1:39. He worked dynamite and I'm happy with the work. We'll go in the Belmont. He'll gallop into the race and probably ship in on race day." Belmont hopeful **Traffic Circle** (Cahill Road) worked yesterday at Belmont, drilling five furlongs in :59.92. According to trainer John Kimmel, the colt, winner of a pair of allowances in his last two starts, got his first three-eighths in :35 4/5 and the final quarter in :24. "The horse is pretty fit," Kimmel said. "It was just to maintain his conditioning level. I had him covering a mile and an eighth in about 1:57." Following an easy five-furlong breeze in 1:04.17 yesterday at Belmont, Preakness ninth **Secreto de Estado** (General Assembly) was declared a definite starter for the third jewel of the Triple Crown. "He's 100 percent," said Bernardo Callejas, son of trainer Alfredo Callejas. "He'll run Saturday." Also on Belmont's worktab yesterday was **Saratoga Dandy** (Saratoga Six), winner of the Sir Barton S. for three-year-olds on the Preakness undercard May 18. The Nick Zito-trainee breezed five furlongs in 1:01.14. Virginia Kraft Payson's **South Salem** (Salem Drive), who has raced exclusively in England, arrived at the Aqueduct quarantine facility at 3 a.m. Sunday. The Kentucky-bred, who will make his U.S. debut in the Belmont S., was third in last year's G3 Coventry S. at Royal Ascot.

### SHANE SELLERS SUFFERS BROKEN WRIST

Jockey Shane Sellers suffered a broken right wrist Sunday when his mount, **Commander Teddy** (Phone Trick), broke down in the third race at Churchill Downs. Sellers, 29, was thrown head first to the track and sustained a concussion. He regained consciousness and was transported to Caritas Medical Center for X-rays and a CAT scan. According to Caritas attending physician Dr. Ted Forrest, Sellers' CAT scan was negative. He will be transported to Louisville's Jewish Hospital, where he will undergo surgery to repair the fracture with the placement of surgical screws or plates to stabilize the wrist. The injury will take an estimated six to eight weeks to heal. **Commander Teddy**, a three-year-old maiden who was making his second career start, was euthanized. He was sixth in a field of 11 in the stretch turn of the 6½-furlong race when the incident occurred.

HOIST TO HEAVEN (Alleged) set a fast pace as pace-maker to the Criquette-Head trained L'AFRICAIN BLEU (FR) (Saint Cyrien {Fr}), and these two led the field early. On the home turn, L'Africain Bleu took the lead, but he was soon challenged by Michael Tabor's GRAPE TREE ROAD (GB) (Caerleon), with Tabor's HIGH BAROQUE (IRE) (High Estate {GB}) also coming to challenge, along with Lucy Boutin's ARBATAX (IRE) (Mtoto {GB}), with Ragmar making fast progress. A furlong out, Ragmar took the lead, but in doing so appeared to swerve across the English challenger Polaris Flight. Ragmar went two lengths clear entering the final 100 yards, but then began to idle and Polaris Flight began to close stride by stride and only just failed to catch the winner, with Les Destin also closing fast on the wide outside. Ragmar and his rider Gerald Mosse then had to survive an objection. Mosse said, "When I hit the front my horse moved to the left, but I think we were clear enough of Mick Kinane on Polaris Flight not to have caused him any trouble." With the victory, Ragmar upped his '96 record to a perfect two-for-two; he took the G2 Prix Greffulhe April 21 in his only other start this year.

Winning owner Jean-Louis Bouchard, who bought Ragmar as a two-year-old after the horse finished second in his career debut, said, "I've only had two runners in the French Derby, Celtic Arms and Ragmar, and they've both won! It's likely (Ragmar) will be put away until September and be trained for the Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe." This result was a reversal of last October's G1 Criterium de Saint-Cloud, when Polaris Flight edged Ragmar by a short head. G1 winner HELISSIO (FR) (Fairy King), rank early, dead-heated for fifth as the favorite.

Tinners Way was making his first appearance since running seventh in last year's GI Breeders' Cup Classic at Belmont. Third in this event last year after nine months on the sidelines, the veteran was sharp off the seven-month layoff this time, sitting third behind front-runner DEL MAR DENNIS (Dixieland Band), then making his move three-wide on the far turn and outgaming favored Helmsman in the race to the wire. "I thought maybe he would get a little tired," said jockey Eddie Delahoussaye. "I don't think he's 100 percent fit just yet, so he ran great." The top two will be back to take on Cigar in the GI Hollywood Gold Cup June 30.

It was a brilliant frontrunning effort from Le Triton, who quickened well at the top of the straight and was never seriously challenged, although both Martiniquais and Blackwater finished well on the outside. Winning trainer Criquette Head commented, "I'm thrilled. He was short of condition after a minor setback in training when he ran fourth to Helissio in the Prix Lupin, so he came into this race fresh. He always runs well when fresh. His next target will be the Prix Jacques le Marois (Group 1) at Deauville in August."

Making her first start for her new owner and trainer, Chelsey Flower was also making her first start since finishing third in the GIII Black Helen H. at Hialeah April 13. Boasting a solid record over this course after finishing on the board in eight of nine Belmont turf tries, the bay settled just off the pace through the opening fractions, swung out for running room at the head of the lane and wore down Look Daggers to win going away. "She is so sharp out of the gate, and she kind of wanted to make the lead from the start," said jockey Robbie Davis, riding the mare for the first time. "I just waited for her to get covered up, so I could have something left for the finish. I got lucky and had a really nice trip." The 9-5 favorite ELECTRIC SOCIETY (IRE) (Law Society), second in the Black Helen in her most recent effort, set all the pace but tired in the final furlong and finished fifth.

**FINAL WORKOUTS REVISE EPSOM DERBY**

**BETTING** Dr Massini (Ire) (Sadler's Wells) and Shaamit (Ire) (Mtoto) were the two colts best backed for Saturday's Epsom Derby after Britain's racing fans digested an extravaganza of final workouts for the big race over the past weekend. Dr Massini, unraced at two but unbeaten in two starts this year, is now quoted the clear favorite for the 1 1/2-mile Classic following encouraging news from trainer Michael Stoute about a colt whose participation had been in doubt last week when he was found to be stiff. Shaamit's odds shortened markedly after he finished two lengths up on **Glory Of Dancer (GB)** (Shareef Dancer) in a gallop on Newmarket's July Course. The Mtoto colt's trainer William Haggas, son-in-law of the nine-times Epsom Derby winner Lester Piggott, said, "Shaamit worked all right. He's genuine and always does. But it's no different from how he has been going for the past six weeks." Shaamit, winner of a Doncaster maiden last season but forced to miss his trial at York with a painful cut following an over-reach at home, will not have seen a racecourse since November when he lines up Saturday. But Haggas added: "I think he'll be fit enough. Now it's just a question of whether he can run fast enough. There's a slight doubt about his stamina, but I think he'll stay."
