**OBS TWO-YEAR-OLD SALE MONDAY** Nearly 300 juveniles will be offered at the Ocala Breeders' Sales Co.'s Two-Year-Olds in Training and Horses of Racing Age Sale Monday. The catalogue includes 291 two-year-olds and 27 horses of racing age. "This is the final opportunity of the year for buyers to select from a large group of two-year-olds in training," said Tom Ventura, OBS Director of Sales. "While this group may lack the pedigrees of juveniles at our select sales, many top runners have come out of the June sale." **Thundering Storm** (Storm Brewing), a product of the '95 sale, won this year's \$150,000 Tampa Bay Derby by five lengths. Farnsworth Farms, selected the leading Florida breeder of 1995, leads the consignors with 30 two-year-olds, including a half-sister by Mercedes Won to GSW Richie The Coach (Maudlin). This year's sales horses will gallop or breeze over the OBS training track Sunday, June 9, beginning at 9:00 a.m.; videos of the works will be shown at the OBS sales pavilion on sale day. The sale begins at 11:30 a.m. Monday, June 10.

**'SUN KINGS' NAMED COBRA GOLF/TDN SUBSCRIBERS OF MONTH** William Condren and Joseph Cornacchia, who picked up two of Thoroughbred racing's most prestigious prizes in an eight-day span last month, have been named the Cobra Golf/Thoroughbred Daily News Subscribers of the Month for May. In recognition of the award, they will receive a set of Senior King Cobra clubs, the country's leading oversize irons and woods. Condren and Cornacchia picked up their second Pimlico Special win when Star Standard won this year's renewal, following in the footsteps of their Strike the Gold in 1992. One week later, the golfing buddies were back in the Pimlico winner's circle, accepting the Woodlawn Vase after Louis Quatorze's Preakness win. They picked up another stakes for good measure when Saratoga Dandy won the Sir Barton S. on the Preakness undercard. Said Condren, "It's hard to measure, but it was probably the best week we ever had--two Grade 1s as bookends with the Sir Barton in between. Joe DeFrancis told me, 'I've got one piece of advice for you: buy a lottery ticket before you leave town.'" But perhaps Cornacchia summed it up best: "It was a great year we had last month."

Punters had made Pricket a hot favourite to give the Godolphin team its third successive Oaks but the Dubai operation's latest hope was no match for the brilliant Henry Cecil-trained Lady Carla (GB).

**MOODY'S CAT (IRE)** (Alzao) led the field early on and was still in front with three furlongs to run when, despite not appearing entirely content coming down the famous Tattenham Hill, Lady Carla started to motor. She took the lead just over a quarter of a mile out and, accelerating easily, she put nine lengths between herself and the second before reaching the line. Mezzogiorno (GB) and **CAMPORESE (IRE)** (Sadler's Wells) came out of the pack late to grab third and fourth. But Bint Salsabil (Nashwan), who had been expected to appreciate stepping up to a mile and a half, showed no sign of doing so and trailed in last. Lady Carla's trainer, Henry Cecil, had seen Pricket removed from his stable in a well-publicized bust-up with Sheikh Mohammed last autumn, so it was hardly a surprise when he grinned: "That was very exciting. I was hoping for a good run because Lady Carla has improved a lot for her first run of the season. I think she must be pretty good to win like this." Successful jockey Pat Eddery was equally enthusiastic, saying: "She's quite lazy, but when you pick her up she really goes. I gave her a slap three out and she took off. When I looked around, I could hardly believe how far ahead we were."

### THORO-GRAPH ANALYSIS OF THE BELMONT STAKES

The Belmont Stakes usually features only two or three contenders after the rigors of the first two legs of the Triple Crown have taken their toll, but this year's field is strong and makes for a difficult handicapping exercise.

On balance, the best horse in the race is **Skip Away** (Skip Trial), but he's tough to figure. After developing to win big in the Blue Grass for a figure of 1 3/4, he bounced to the moon in the Derby, then came back with a good one (3 1/4) in the Preakness. But what now? Will he go back to his top or bounce? Tough call.

Two members of the field come in ready to pay off on the spring three-year-old pattern--a pair of lifetime bests followed by an off race followed by the race of his (or her) life. **Prince Of Thieves** (Hansel) looks an awful lot like **Louis Quatorze** (Sovereign Dancer) did before the Preakness; he had run a couple of 6s preceding a sub-par performance in the Preakness. He should run better, but like Louis would need to jump out of his skin to win.

**My Flag** (Easy Goer) is also on track for a lifetime best effort. She had less than two weeks rest before her bad race in the Kentucky Oaks but has had five weeks off now. Her dam, the great Personal Ensign, got markedly better with age, as have her previous runners, so there's probably improvement left. And Shug McGaughey wouldn't be running against colts if he wasn't sure she was ready to run her best.

The only question is whether her best will be good enough. But with the five-pound weight allowance, we'll bet it is--the Thoro-Graph play is My Flag to win. *The Thoro-Graph handicapper's line offers analyses and suggested plays for six major tracks daily. (Sadler's Wells), favourite for the Epsom Derby before having to be withdrawn when he was found to be lame in a foreleg Wednesday, is now to be prepared for the Irish equivalent at The Curragh June 30. The Michael Tabor-owned colt, unbeaten winner of York's Michael Seely Memorial Glasgow S., had been 4-1 market leader for Britain's premier Classic. But, when Dr Massini became subject to his second hold-up in two weeks, connections had little option other than to defect from Epsom and give him a break. However, Demi O'Byrne, racing manager to Tabor, stated: "The problem is not of great significance, but it's enough to stop him running in the Derby. I'm sure he will be back in action soon and the Irish Derby is now his main target."
