CAVONNIER RETIRED Cavonnier (Batonnier), who was pulled up after suffering a bowed right front tendon in Saturday's Belmont Stakes, has been retired, trainer Bob Baffert announced yesterday. "We could give him a year off and bring him back, but he's been such a good horse there's no way we would put him through that. (Owner Robert Walter) is a horse-man and he knows these things happen. He took it a little better than I did. Cavonnier will have his own little paddock (at Walter's farm) and he's going to have a great life. He's going to have a better life than you or me." The gutsy gelding, winner of the GI Santa Anita Derby and a nose behind Grindstone in this year's Kentucky Derby, retires with six wins from 16 career starts and earnings of \$1,139,397. He headed home to California yesterday.

BELMONT WRAP-UP Belmont Stakes winner **Editor's Note** (Forty Niner), none the worse for the wear after a hard-fought decision Saturday, shipped back to his base at Churchill Downs Sunday morning. Joining him on the trip was **Prince Of Thieves** (Hansel), fifth in the Belmont. "Everything is beautiful," said George Weaver, assistant to trainer D. Wayne Lukas. "They both pulled up good, ate well, and they got off o.k." **Skip Away** (Skip Trial), the Belmont bridesmaid, was back at his barn at Monmouth yesterday morning. He will take on Editor's Note once again in the GI Buick Haskell Invitational at Monmouth August 4. Trainer Shug McGaughey said Sunday that **My Flag** (Easy Goer), third in the Belmont, "came out of the spit box playing" after the race and would make her next start against fillies in the GI Coaching Club American Oaks July 20. Preakness winner **Louis Quatorze** (Sovereign Dancer), fourth in the third jewel in the Triple Crown, will get a short break before gearing up for the Jim Dandy August 4 and the Travers August 24.

Lambourn-based Sil Sila pulled off a 30-1 surprise in the French Oaks, defeating Miss Tahiti by a length with Irish 1000 Guineas heroine Matiya third. Ridden by Texan Cash Asmussen, the Bryan Smart-trained filly was well in rear for much of the race as SOLAR CRYSTAL (IRE) (Alzao), ridden by Willie Ryan, set the pace; Matiya took the lead with a furlong and a half to run, followed by Miss Tahiti, but Sil Sila closed strongly on the wide outside, took command inside the final furlong and ran on well to win comfortably. Smart, who has some 30 horses in his yard, almost half of them jumpers, was saddling his first Classic runner. He said: "I've always had confidence in Sil Sila's ability after she won both of her races as a two-year-old. We also had Cash Asmussen here and he's a great man on the French tracks, knowing them so well. My filly never goes well at home and in a big stable she'd probably be in the 'bottom yard.' But Cash said that today she settled so well and was always travelling so well; he thinks this is her best distance and I doubt that we will take on Lady Carla (winner of the Oaks at Epsom) over a mile and a half, but you never know. The sky's the limit now. We might come back to France for the Prix Vermeille in September, with the Arc in mind. We can go where we want now." Smart also paid tribute to Major Dick Hern for letting him use his private gallops at Lambourn on which to train the filly. Cash Asmussen said: "I'd like to thank Ray Cochrane, her usual rider, for suggesting how I should ride Sil Sila, after he was injured in Sweden last weekend. He phoned me...and his advice was absolutely perfect."

WINDSHARP OUT OF ESTRAPADE S. Top turf mare **Windsharp** (Lear Fan), twice a winner over colts this year and second in the GI San Juan Capistrano April 21 last out, has come down with a fever and will miss her scheduled return to the races in Saturday's \$100,000a Estrapade S. at Hollywood. "She'll be okay, but she had a 103-degree temperature and she's knocked out a little bit," said trainer Wally Dollase. "It's the same thing she had this winter (after winning the GI San Luis Obispo H. February 19)." Dollase added that, despite the setback, the five-year-old should have no trouble making her main objective, the GI Beverly D. at Arlington August 24.

EPSOM DERBY NOTES **Shaamit (Ire)** (Mtoto {GB}), hero of Saturday's Epsom Derby, looks set to make his next appearance in the Irish equivalent at The Curragh June 30. The colt was not among the original entries for Ireland's premier event, but could be supplemented to the race. Trainer William Haggas said yesterday: "If the owner is prepared to supplement him and the horse is okay, we shall probably send him to Ireland. He has taken his Derby win a lot better than all of us--eaten up all his food--and really looks fantastic. We have always thought he was a superstar and now he is!" Derby third **Shantou (Alleged)** also appears likely to go next to The Curragh, but runner-up **Dushyantor** (Sadler's Wells) will probably take on older horses in the King George VI & Queen Elizabeth Diamond S. at Ascot July 27. But his trainer, 10-time British champion handler Henry Cecil, believes the Derby second would have an excellent chance of beating Shaamit if the duo do meet again. Overhead pictures revealed Dushyantor was clearly hampered after five furlongs at Epsom and Cecil said: "He was flattened, wasn't he? He went down on his knees and was pushed right back." **Glory Of Dancer (GB)** (Shareef Dancer), fourth in Saturday's Epsom Derby, now steps back in distance for the 10-furlong G1 Grand Prix de Paris at Longchamp June 23. The Paul Kelleway trainee faded in the final furlong of Epsom's mile and a half, so the switch to shorter distances is no surprise. Kelleway said: "He's come back in terrific form and now we know where we stand. If he'd finished second at Epsom, I might have thought he was a mile-and-a-half horse. But I've won the Grand Prix before (with Risk Me {Fr} in 1987), so let's hope we can do it again." Plans are less certain, though, for **Even Top (Ire)** (Topanoora {Ire}), runner-up in the 2000 Guineas but a disappointing 13th after being struck into during the Derby. Jockey Philip Robinson revealed: "He has a gash on a hind leg. He got it in some scrimmaging about five furlongs out. But I'm still certain he's a very good horse and that his day will come."

EPSOM LOOKING AT DERBY SWITCH Executives at Epsom will take "two to three weeks" before making any decision over whether the Derby should revert to its traditional position on the first Wednesday in June. Britain's premier Classic has been run on a Saturday for the past two years, but there is now strong pressure from many interested parties to return it to a mid-week spot. Racegoers voted with their feet by shunning Epsom's top draw again this year--only 56,000 paid to get in--and bookmakers described betting turnover as "not much better than a normal Saturday." Even the Queen has expressed the opinion that Wednesday is preferable and Home Secretary Michael Howard stated that he also had "a slight soft spot" for a return to the pre-1995 timing. However, Edward Gillespie, Epsom's director of racing, insisted that there is to be no rush to change and that much consultation will take place before any date is set for next season. He added: "We will want to speak to a lot of people before reaching our decision."

CAREER OVER FOR BINT SALSABIL? **Bint Salsabil** (Nashwan), considered a leading Epsom Oaks contender but last to finish in the Classic last Friday, has almost certainly run her final race. The John Dunlop trainee, owned by Hamdan al Maktoum, underwent searching tests from veterinarians following her Epsom eclipse and was found to have a problem with her heart. Dunlop is pessimistic about her prospects of running again. He said: "It seems 90 percent likely we will have to retire her." **Bint Salsabil** won three of her four juvenile starts last year but disappointed when finishing eighth in Doncaster's May Hill S. She ran well when second in the Nell Gwyn S. at Newmarket on her 1996 reappearance, then ran seventh in last month's 1000 Guineas on the same course. At Epsom, though, she was never going well and, after starting at 10-1, seemed ill-at-ease for the last six furlongs before trailing in well behind the other 10 starters.

MARYLAND HANDLE SHOWS DECLINE Pimlico Race Course wrapped up its 48-day spring meet Sunday with a total handle of approximately \$100 million, on par with last year's spring season, but overall, for the year to date, the Maryland Jockey Club is experiencing a 4.7 percent decline in business at the mutuel machines. The Maryland Jockey Club operates both Pimlico and Laurel Park. Racing switches to Laurel this Friday, June 14, for a 29-day meeting. The track will offer live cards Tuesdays, Wednesdays, Fridays, Saturdays and Sundays, and simulcasting only on Thursdays, with the exception of a live program Thursday, July 4. The Laurel summer meet ends Sunday, July 21, and racing will resume at Pimlico Tuesday, July 23.

WOODBINE CLERKS RATIFY CONTRACT As expected, the union which represents Woodbine's pari-mutuel clerks, Service Employees International Union, Local 528, ratified an agreement yesterday with the Ontario Jockey Club. Eight-five percent of the 450 members in attendance voted to accept yesterday's version of the contract. Last Thursday, 80 percent of the membership voted against a similar contract. Changes in yesterday's version included certain work guarantees after the arrival of video lottery terminals, expected to be implemented at racetracks in Ontario beginning July 1. Breeders' Cup officials still await a written guarantee from Ontario Premier Mike Harris and Ontario Federation of Labour President Gord Wilson that there will be no disruptions during the Breeders' Cup.

Bidding for her third victory in three starts this year, **Auriette (Ire)**, impressive winner of the GII Santa Barbara H. at a mile and a quarter last out, shortened up an eighth looking for her first Grade I win. The bay showed her speed right out of the gate, set a moderate pace on an uncontested lead and had plenty left in the drive to post a handy tally under jockey **Kent Desormeaux**. "What's gotten into her?" **Desormeaux** marvelled. "She has gotten phenomenal. The biggest scare I had in the whole race was when she turned into the backside and acted like she was sprinting for home. But she went about 80 yards and pulled herself up--like maybe she was saying she shouldn't be going so fast. That's where she mentally won the race." Retired trainer **Gary Jones** saddled the filly for his son, **Marty**, 24, who was at Belmont Park with **Ski Dancer** (fifth in the Just A Game Breeders' Cup H.). "I'm so proud of **Marty**," he said. "He's done this all by himself. I felt terrible because he had to go (to New York)...and I got to go where the glory was. I want to thank the owners for leaving this horse with **Marty**, because it's a big break for him, and I'm so thankful they did so."

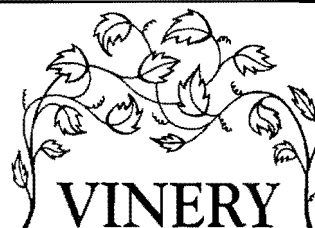
