HOLLYWOOD CUTS STAKES PURSES After cutting overnight purses by eight percent earlier this month, Hollywood officials have now lowered the purses on five upcoming stakes races by \$25,000 each. The GI Milady Breeders' Cup H., set for June 23, will be run for \$175,000a instead of \$200,000a; the GIII Affirmed H., June 30, has been dropped to \$100,000a; the GII American H., July 4, will be run for \$125,000a; the GI Hollywood Oaks, July 13, has had its purse lowered to \$175,000a; and the GII Bel Air H., July 14, is now worth \$100,000a.

OHIO DERBY TAKES SHAPE The connections of five three-year-olds have confirmed their colts as runners in next Sunday's GI \$300,000 Ohio Derby at Thistledown. Expected to be the first to arrive at the Cleveland oval is Buckram Oak Farm's **Irish Conquest** (Conquistador Cielo), who ships in Tuesday. Trained by Mohammed Moubarak, the colt finished third in the GII Illinois Derby last out May 11; there is a 70-percent chance he could be accompanied on the trip by Illinois Derby winner **Natural Selection** (Slew City Slew), who was seventh in the GI Belmont S. June 8. MGSP **Bunker Hill Road** (Cahill Road) and GSW **Storm Creek** (Storm Cat) are scheduled to arrive Friday; also listed as definite for the nine-furlong fixture are GSP **Connecting Terms** (Private Terms) and Team Lukas' **Victory Speech** (Deputy Minister), who was fifth in the GI Preakness in his latest. SW **Instant Friendship** (Cormorant), entered for today's GIII Hill Prince S. at Belmont, is possible for the race.

CHURCHILL'S SIMULCAST HANDLE DOUBLES Wagering on the signal from Churchill Downs to simulcast outlets around the country has more than doubled since last year. A total of \$162,913,905 has been bet on Churchill's product this year through Wednesday, as compared to \$81,009,625 to this date in '95. "The OTB system in New York has come on...we've also picked up Illinois, after they changed their laws," said Churchill's Director of Product Development, Hubert Hazelip. "Michigan and Oklahoma have also come on board, so that's helped." The number of national hub sites accepting the Churchill signal averages around 400 a day. Hazelip said the track is currently looking to develop the market in Ohio and Florida, and added, "Hopefully, California is also just down the road. We just can't sit back on our laurels...we need to keep moving forward."

Wekiva Springs, winner of the GI Gulfstream Park H. March 2, had started twice since, finishing second to Geri in the GI Oaklawn H. and fourth behind Star Standard in the GI Pimlico Special. Stepping down from Grade I company for the first time since January, the heavily-favored gray rated in mid-pack down the backside, closed ground rapidly on the turn, then drew clear in the stretch under a hand ride from regular jockey Mike Smith. "He's run hard enough," said winning trainer Bill Mott. "He's been beaten by Cigar (in the GI Donn H. Feb. 10) and Geri, but he's also won a Grade I. He's a good horse for anyone's barn. It makes sense to come back in the Suburban (July 4). It's a little tight (time-wise), but we'll take a shot at it."

Jockey Ray Cochrane, who missed out on the mount aboard Sila Sila, winner of last weekend's French Oaks, may receive ample compensation when he partners the Godolphin-owned five-year-old **King's Theatre (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) in today's Group 1 mile-and-a-half event in Italy. Cochrane takes over from the unfortunate Frankie Dettori on the Saeed bin Suroor-trained runner. King's Theatre, runner-up in the 1994 Epsom and Irish Derbies and winner of that year's King George VI & Queen Elizabeth Diamond S., raced without success in North America last year and was then sent to winter in Dubai. He returned to Britain this year as part of the Godolphin team and on his one run this year was runner-up to Murajja in a minor conditions race at Newbury at the end of last month. He faces stiff opposition from two English-trained runners, Clive Brittain's **Luso (GB)** (Salse), who won last year's Italian Derby in Rome and who recently won the G3 Premio Ellington at the same track, and Paul Cole's **Strategic Choice (Alleged)**, winner of last year's Irish St. Leger, in the field of only four, the smallest since the 1940s. The only Italian-trained runner, **Pay Me Back (Ire)** (Master Willie {GB}), a past winner of the Italian St. Leger, rounds out the field.
