**NO REST FOR SKIP AWAY** Skip Away (Skip Trial), second in the the Preakness and Belmont S. in his last two starts, may not wait around in his stall for the Aug. 4 GI \$750,000 Buick Haskell Invitational at Monmouth Park, according to trainer Sonny Hine. "Skip Away is doing excellent and everything is going well," said Hine. "I don't know if I can wait eight more weeks for the Haskell." The Blue Grass winner may make his next start in next Sunday's \$300,000 Ohio Derby, according to Hine. Hine completed the Ohio Derby/Haskell double in 1985 with Skip Away's sire, Skip Trial.

**GOLD CUP FIELD TAKES SHAPE** In the absence of Cigar (Palace Music), who is on the mend from a foot bruise, a field of six to 10 runners is shaping up for the June 30 \$1 million Hollywood Gold Cup. Mr Purple (Deputy Minister), Helmsman (El Gran Senor), Siphon (Brz) (Itajara {Brz}), Soul Of The Matter (Private Terms), Tinnors Way (Secretariat) and Geri (Theatrical {Ire}) are all probable starters, while Luthier Fever (Mt. Livermore), Dare And Go (Alydar), Key Of Luck (Chief's Crown) and Tejano Run (Tejano) are all considered possible. Mr Purple remains eligible for the \$2 million MGM Grand Classic Crown bonus, awarded to any horse who sweeps the Santa Anita H., Hollywood Gold Cup and Pacific Classic. Since his March 2 Big 'Cap win, Mr Purple has finished fifth in the April 6 Oaklawn H. and third in the June 2 Californian. Trainer Ron McAnally said yesterday that he is still looking for a Gold Cup rider. Eddie Delahoussaye, who rode Mr Purple in the Big 'Cap, will be aboard Tinnors Way in the Gold Cup, while his Californian jockey, Corey Nakatani, will pilot Soul Of The Matter. While McAnally admitted that last year, he didn't think jockeys would be lining up to ride the horse, the GI winner has come a long way. "We were trying to get him to rate and he wasn't learning," he said. "We kept teaching him and he finally caught on." If Mr Purple does not win the Gold Cup, he remains eligible for \$500,000 in participation bonuses.

Fastness came in at the start, settled into next-to-last position early, swung four wide into the stretch and finished under a strong hand ride to win his third straight going away. "All I said to Corey (Nakatani) was, 'Just be in a good position at the top of the stretch and be ready to fly home,'" said winning trainer Jenine Sahadi. "That's exactly what he did." Said Nakatani, "I was forced a little bit wide, and Romarin kicked on and really ran a nice race today. But when I asked (Fastness) to run at (Romarin) he really kicked it in. This horse is amazing and he really wants to do it." Chris McCarron, aboard Romarin, said he didn't expect to be caught once his horse turned for home in front. "At the quarter-pole, he threw me in the backseat he cut so hard," said McCarron. "I thought, 'Oh, man, you're going to have to sprout wings to catch me.' I think I saw Pegasus go by at the sixteenth pole." Sahadi said the \$300,000 GI Eddie Read H. August 4 at Del Mar would be next for Fastness, and that she and owners Carol and C.N. Ray had discussed running the horse at seven next year. "We're excited about the prospects of doing that," said Sahadi, "especially because the Breeders' Cup will be at Hollywood Park. He loves it here and I don't have a problem giving him the first six months off the year off and then running him the last half of the year just like this."

Winner last year of the Irish St Leger, Strategic Choice pursued the pacesetter Luso for much of the race and in the straight slipped through on the inside to take the lead and take the winner's purse comfortably. Clive Brittain's 1995 Italian Derby winner Luso ran a fine race considering he had developed a nasty skin rash overnight after being bitten by a mosquito in his stables. He was allowed to take part even though Brittain said that "he was not at his best." Godolphin's King's Theatre, partnered by John Reid in the absence of Ray Cochrane who aggravated an injury at the Leicester evening meeting Saturday, was never a serious factor in the race and only beat the moderate Italian runner Pay Me Back.

Two-for-two in North America, the five-year-old was coming off allowance wins at Keeneland and Churchill and was sent off the third choice to win his third straight. Rank in the early stages, he was hard held in second place off the early pace, made a move at the three-eighths pole and was hard ridden to wear down Sand Reef. The win was trainer Neil Drysdale's second consecutive Golden Gate H. victory.

"There were three factors in our favor today," said winning trainer Ron McAnally. "Weight, this is not a closing-type track, and a slow pace. Those are all big factors." The 2-5 favorite, Pike Place Dancer, was coming off three straight wins--the last in the Kentucky Oaks, but, after settling in last early, could manage no better than third. Jockey Corey Nakatani took the blame. "I rode bad," he said. "It was as simple as that. They were walking on the lead." Listening will make her next start in the Hollywood Oaks.

Optic Nerve, on the board in all four prior turf starts and runner-up in the GIII Jersey Derby on the grass last out, showed good speed right out of the gate and led this field all the way to the wire to pick up his first-ever stakes win. "When we got the overnights, I called the owner and told him we had to put the horse on the lead...there was no speed in the race, and his sister (Meadow Star) could run on the front end," said trainer Howie Teshler. "I kinda like this horse. In Florida, I said once we got him on the grass, he wouldn't lose--he's lost twice, but he had excuses." As for what's next, Teshler mentioned the GIII Lamplighter at Monmouth June 29, GII Arlington Classic June 30, or the GIII Lexington at Belmont July 14. Favored Allied Forces pressed the pace but weakened late to be third; he will be pointed to the Lexington next.

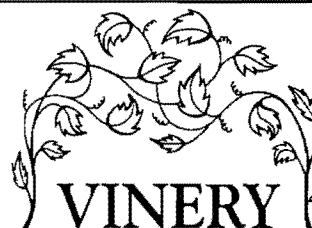
