**DUSHYANTOR FOR IRISH DERBY** Dushyantor (Sadler's Wells), considered by connections to have been unlucky when runner-up behind **Shaamit (Ire)** (Mtoto {GB}) in the Epsom Derby 10 days ago, appears increasingly likely to renew his rivalry with his Classic conqueror in the Irish Derby at The Curragh June 30. Trainer Henry Cecil had originally suggested that Dushyantor would be given a rest until the King George VI & Queen Elizabeth Diamond S. at Ascot in late July. But, having watched the colt's progress since Epsom, he hopes to be able to take the Irish option of a re-match. Cecil said: "Epsom took a bit out of him, but he has recovered well. His owner (Khalid Abdullah) would love to have a runner if I'm happy with the horse nearer the race." Dushyantor's second clash with Shaamit should add excitement to the Budweiser-sponsored contest. However, it almost certainly rules out Cecil's Epsom Oaks winner **Lady Carla (GB)** (Caerleon). The trainer added: "It's more than likely she will go for the Irish Oaks (July 14)."
