**CIGAR TO BREEZE TODAY** Trainer Bill Mott reported Saturday that Cigar (Palace Music) will breeze a half-mile at Belmont this morning, his first work since an injury to his right fore hoof was discovered following the June 1 Massachusetts H. "It will be his first time back, so if he went in about :50 it would be good," Mott said. "Actually, if he went in :49 or :51 that would be okay, too. Just as long as he goes around and comes back okay." Cigar, looking for his 16th straight win in a special event at Arlington International July 13, galloped 1 1/2-miles on the training track Saturday and is doing "very well," according to Mott. The trainer added that Cigar will likely ship straight to Saratoga following his engagement in Chicago and train there for his next scheduled start in the Pacific Classic at Del Mar Aug. 10.

**UNBRIDLED'S SONG BACK ON TRACK** Unbridled's Song (Unbridled), who went five furlongs in a slow "1:10 or 1:11" Saturday morning at Belmont in his first move since developing a lung infection in the Peter Pan S. May 26, will breeze more seriously in three days. "Barry (Downes) was so conscious of not going fast he didn't go at all," said trainer Jim Ryerson of Unbridled's Song, who did not make the work tab. "He never let him run. It was similar to the first time back in Florida, prior to the Hutcheson." Downes agreed, saying, "We wanted a nice, slow work, but that's a bit slower than we wanted. He did it nice and easy, but maybe a bit too easy." Unbridled's Song, who has been treated with antibiotics since the lung infection was discovered, underwent an endoscopic examination by Dr. William Reed earlier this week and his connections were pleased with the results. "He's going in the right direction," said Downes. "It will be another few weeks before he's back to himself." Unbridled's Song is being pointed toward the Aug. 24 Travers and will likely make one start prior to that race. "There are a few options, like the Haskell, but I don't believe anything has been decided yet," Downes added.

Sandpit, most recently victorious in the GI Hollywood Turf Cup H. May 27, was rated in along the hedge while champion Northern Spur and Early Times Manhattan winner Diplomatic Jet set leisurely fractions of :25 3/5, :50 1/5 and 1:14 2/5 on the front end. As the front-runners began to tire through the stretch, jockey Corey Nakatani sent Sandpit through a hole on the hedge and the Brazilian champion charged convincingly to the front, drawing off through the final sixteenth to win the Caesars for the second straight year. "He really quickened through the stretch," said Nakatani. "Now that he's beaten Northern Spur twice in a row, I feel like he's the one they have to beat for National Turf Horse of the Year." Winning trainer Richard Mandella added, "The fractions scared me a little, but I had all the confidence in the world that Corey would find a spot and get him home." When asked what's next for Sandpit, Mandella responded, "We're going to the Caesars race (GI Caesars Palace Turf Championship) at Hollywood Park (July 21). There's a million dollar bonus between the two." The race took on some added flavor when inclement weather prevented a flight of Belmont Park jockeys from leaving for Atlantic City, providing a group of local jockeys with mounts in the Grade I event. Among the horses receiving last-minute rider changes was runner-up Diplomatic Jet, who received the services of Dale Lynch instead of Jorge Chavez. Fred Hooper, the 98-year-old owner/breeder of Diplomatic Jet, said, "Dale Lynch did a great job on this horse today. We are proud of him. You know that Dale learned to ride on our farm in Florida, so it was special to have him ride our horse today. We have trained a lot of riders, but this boy always stuck out as a special one."

Yanks Music won her first three career starts by a combined 19 lengths before finishing second as the 4-5 favorite in her stakes debut, the GI Acorn at Belmont May 18. Sent off the 2-1 second choice here, the talented filly made amends. After being bumped at the start, she was rated in fifth through six furlongs, made a seven-wide move on the turn, then prevailed by a neck after a long stretch duel. "The longer she goes, the better she gets," said winning trainer Leo O'Brien. "I want to give her racing education and run her around two turns. Maybe the Cotillion (at Philadelphia Park July 7)." The 6-5 favorite Escena, who was also on the short end of a neck margin when second in the GI Kentucky Oaks May 3, may go next in the GI Coaching Club American Oaks at Belmont July 20, according to trainer Bill Mott. The time of the race equalled the third fastest running time for the Mother Goose at the distance. Ruffian in 1975 also ran the 1 1/8-miles in 1:47 4/5.
