ARLINGTON TO ANNOUNCE CITATION

CHALLENGE Arlington International Racecourse is scheduled to hold a press conference today, during which they are expected to announce they will hold an invitational stakes race July 13 in which **Cigar** (Palace Music) will attempt to equal the modern American record of 16 consecutive victories. Sources told the *Chicago Tribune* the race will be called the Citation Challenge, in honor of the horse who set the modern record for consecutive wins during a streak that began April 17, 1948 and ran through June 3, 1950. If Cigar runs, the purse will be \$750,000, the *Tribune* reported. In addition to the normal winner's share of \$450,000, there will be a winner's bonus of \$300,000. If Cigar does not run, the race will be worth \$300,000. Arlington is also expected to announce that CBS will televise the race nationally, devoting 30 minutes to its coverage.

CIGAR BREEZES TOWARD ARLINGTON In his first official workout since winning the June 1 Massachusetts H., reigning Horse of the Year **Cigar** (Palace Music) breezed a half-mile at Belmont Park Sunday morning. "You know how it is when you get a horse to do exactly what you wanted him to do? That's how he went," said trainer Bill Mott. "He went well, smooth. (Regular jockey Jerry) Bailey worked him. I told him to go between :49 and :50 and the clockers got him in :49.47. I thought that was pretty good." New York Racing Association Clockers labeled the work: "Cigar is ready; next stop Chicago." To prepare for the six-year-old's anticipated start at Arlington July 13, Mott said, "We will try to get four more works in him, each between five and six days apart, and go from there."

KEY OF LUCK OUT FOR THE YEAR Key of Luck (Chief's Crown), unraced since finishing second in the GI Pimlico Special May 11, has suffered a cracked cannon bone in his left front leg and will be out for the rest of the year. The five-year-old underwent surgery Thursday to have two screws inserted in the leg. Trainer Kieran McLaughlin said he is optimistic that Key of Luck can return to compete in the 1997 Dubai World Cup. "When he came out of that work (before the Massachusetts H.), he was off in his left front," McLaughlin said. "We X-rayed him and nothing showed, but he was sensitive in the area. There may have been a line in the area we missed or it didn't show up. Three weeks later, it did show up."

***FARASAN (IRE)** (Fairy King) finished 4th, but was disqualified and placed 6th. His rider, John Reid, received a 4-day suspension, starting July 2.

France's champion trainer Andre Fabre saddled Grape Tree Road to win today's Grand Prix de Paris in the final strides, denying the Paul Kelleway-trained Epsom Derby fourth Glory Of Dancer by a short head. LE TRITON (El Gran Senor) led from the start at a good pace, followed by FORT NOTTINGHAM (Alleged), MARTINIQUAIS (IRE) (Simply Great {Fr}), BLACKWATER (Irish River {Fr}) and Glory Of Dancer. Two furlongs out Le Triton still led, but was then challenged by Blackwater, with Glory Of Dancer making his move on the outside. A furlong and a half out, Glory Of Dancer hit the front and looked to be the winner. But France's champion jockey Thierry Jarnet conjured a miraculous run out of Grape Tree Road and he weaved his way through the field to catch Cash Asmussen's mount in the final strides. Winning owner Michael Tabor said, "I'm delighted. This is my biggest win in France. There are no definite plans for the horse; I am just going to savor this moment." Fabre added, "Grape Tree Road had a bad run in the French Derby and probably took the lead too soon there, but it is not easy to ride a tactical race at Chantilly. He probably found the mile and a half too far. A mile and a quarter is his best trip."

Twice the Vice won the GI Del Mar Oaks on the grass in 1994, then became a Grade I winner on the dirt as well when she scored a neck victory in the Santa Margarita Invitational H. this past March. Winner of the GI Apple Blossom H. at Oaklawn in her most recent effort April 12, the mare returned from a two-month layoff here to win her third straight against Grade I company. Sent off the 3-2 favorite, she raced fourth along the inside early, came off the rail on the backstretch, picked off rivals while wide on the turn for home, made the lead in midstretch then held off the late-closing Jewel Princess for the victory.

Skip Away returned just two weeks after his game second in the Belmont S. to prove a dominant winner here. The 3-5 favorite broke from the outside post and settled behind the early leaders, took the lead on the final turn and drew off through the stretch under a hand ride. "Quite simply, the best horse in the race won," said winning jockey Jose Santos. "It's as easy as that. He looked great in the paddock and he ran that way. He dragged me to the lead at the three-eighths pole and it was pretty much all over after that." Skip Away's 1:47 4/5 for the 1 1/8m race was 2/5 seconds off the This-tledown track record.

Capote Belle ran second to Danseuse (Mr. Prospector) in her debut May 11 and then broke her maiden by six lengths in allowance company in her last start June 1. Leaping up to graded stakes company, the lightly-raced filly set the pace and drew off confidently in the stretch to finish in hand as the 2-1 favorite. Her winning time of 1:08 4/5 equaled the stakes record set by Classy Mirage in 1993. Winning trainer Danny Peitz said Saratoga's Test S. July 27 would be next for his precocious filly. "We will probably run there next without any other start. We are looking forward to a rematch with Danseuse," the trainer said.

STARS CLASH IN IRISH DERBY Three of the first five colts home in the Epsom Derby will clash again in the Irish equivalent at The Curragh next Sunday. Connections of Epsom Classic hero **Shaamit** (Ire) (Mtoto {GB}) confirmed yesterday that they are to pay £60,000 to supplement to the Irish Derby. Trainer **William Haggas** stated, "We were very pleased with the horse when he worked Saturday, but I left it up to up to the owner whether to put up the money because he's the one who pays. Now, though, I can confirm we plan to run in Ireland." Epsom second **Dushyantor** (Sadler's Wells) and fifth-placed **Alhaarth** (Ire) (Unfuwain) have both been declared intended starters in the Group 1 event. Also set to line up at The Curragh are **Dr Massini** (Ire) (Sadler's Wells), hot favorite for Epsom before suffering a last-minute injury, and **Polaris Flight** (Northern Flagship), a close second in France's G1 Prix du Jockey-Club.

HICKEY HIT WITH NEW SUSPENSION Trainer **Noel Hickey** is appealing a 15-day suspension and a \$1,000 fine he received from the Arlington stewards after one of his horses tested positive for an overdose of phenylbutazone. **Golden Gear** (Gulch), owned by **Barry Golden**, was sent off the 1-2 favorite in a \$25,000 Arlington allowance race June 8 and won by 7 1/4 lengths. A blood sample was found to contain 16.7 microgram/milliliters of phenylbutazone. The legal limit in Illinois is 2 mcg/ml. "A person would have to be a complete idiot to give a horse that much Bute, especially this horse in this race," said Hickey. "This is a horse who ran in the Breeders' Cup Sprint and here he is, running as the obvious overwhelming favorite in a race with a \$25,000 purse. All I can think of is that either someone tampered with the horse and gave him an overdose out of spite for either Barry or myself or my veterinarian accidentally made a mistake." Hickey had previously been suspended for six months after six of his horses tested positive for traces of albuterol. When he appealed to the Illinois Racing Board, the regulatory commission doubled the suspension. Hickey responded by taking the Board to Cook County Circuit Court; the case has still not been resolved.

TRAINER TOM JONES TO RETIRE Tom Jones, trainer of dual St. Leger winner **Touching Wood** (Roberto), is to retire at the end of the current flat-racing season. The 71-year-old handler announced his intention to hand in his licence over the weekend and his retirement will represent the end of an era. He was among the first British trainers to have horses for the now world-famous Maktoum family and one of them, 1985 Irish 1000 Guineas heroine **Al Bahathri** (Blushing Groom {Fr}), is recalled in the name of a renowned exercise gallop at Newmarket. Born Harry Thomson Jones, but always referred to simply as "Tom", the trainer began his career at age 26, mainly in the National Hunt racing sphere. But he soon switched to the flat and landed his first Classic via **Athens Wood (GB)** (*Celtic Ash) in the 1971 Doncaster St. Leger. Touching Wood added a second in 1982 and then went on to take that same year's Irish equivalent. John Hills, a former assistant at Jones's Green Lodge Stables and now a successful trainer in his own right, paid him a glowing tribute yesterday. He said, "Tom is 'old school' and he knows so much about horses. He's a stickler for doing things right. But even when he gave us a real telling-off during my time in his yard, it was always done with a sense of humor. He's a wonderful man and taught me the importance of traditional values in racing. For him, it always has to be fun. We shouldn't lose sight of that."
