CIGAR GAINS A CHALLENGER Trainer Bobby Frankel told the *Daily Racing Form* earlier this week that **Eltish** (Cox's Ridge) will race against reigning Horse of the Year **Cigar** (Palace Music) in the Arlington Citation Challenge at Arlington International Racecourse July 13. The four-year-old colt, owned and bred by Juddmonte Farms, finished fourth in his only start this year, the GII Mervyn LeRoy H. at Hollywood Park May 4. A MGSW in England, **Eltish** finished second in the Breeders' Cup Juvenile in 1994 and has won three of 12 career starts for earnings of \$422,830.

SHAAMIT TO ECLIPSE STAKES Epsom Derby winner **Shaamit (Ire)** (Mtoto {GB}), forced to miss this Sunday's Irish Derby after a training setback, will start next in Sandown's G1 Coral Eclipse S. a week from Saturday. The William Haggas-trainee was found to be slightly lame following a stiff workout last weekend and connections decided not to supplement for the Irish Classic. But **Shaamit** is now back in exercise and expected to be able to run in Sandown's 1 1/4-mile event. Haggas said yesterday, "He cantered this morning. He's fine and we are happy. He'll be okay to run in the Eclipse provided we don't have another niggle."

RMBs filed after August 1 must be accompanied by a notarized letter explaining why the report has been submitted later than the published deadline. Kiri's Clown missed in his attempt to win a third straight GIII New Hampshire Sweepstakes last time out, finishing fifth in this year's edition of the event June 16 --just eight days after running third in the GI Early Times Manhattan. Sent off the third choice in this six-horse field, the veteran sat just behind Pennine Ridge and Turk Passer to the stretch, then moved to challenge under jockey Jean-Luc Samyn and prevailed in a heated duel to the wire to take the three-way photo. Even-money favorite CLAUDIUS (Majestic Light), a GSW last year, was making his second start since last August; third off the eight-and-a-half month layoff May 26, the chestnut showed little this time and finished fifth.

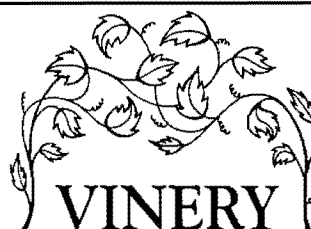
