CIGAR ON TRACK FOR ARLINGTON Cigar (Palace Music) worked six furlongs in 1:13.37 at Belmont yesterday morning and is right on target for his next start in the Arlington Citation Challenge July 13. "It was a very good move, especially considering he was going by himself," said trainer Bill Mott. With jockey Jerry Bailey in the irons, the six-year-old cruised through fractions of :23.71, :35.48 and :47.53. "He felt fine and his time was probably better than usual for him," said Bailey. Mott said the reigning Horse of the Year would leave for Chicago the day before the race.

UNBRIDLED'S SONG SHARP IN PUBLIC WORK

With jockey Mike Smith handling the reins, three-year-old **Unbridled's Song** (Unbridled) smoked six furlongs in 1:10.69 between the fourth and fifth races at Belmont Park Saturday afternoon. The colt, second in the GII Peter Pan S. May 26 in his most recent appearance, completed the first quarter in :23.22 and the half in :46.42. "He did everything with extreme ease," said Smith. "I was trying to slow him down from the eighth pole to the wire. Then, at the wire, I gave him his head again and boom, he was gone again. I liked that." Possible for Saturday's GII Dwyer S. at Belmont, Unbridled's Song has been treated with antibiotics for a lung infection and with Zantac for ulcers since his last start. "I like what I see since we've been treating the ulcers," said trainer Jim Ryerson. "He'll always be a 'hot' horse, but I like how he is with the pony, and he's been more relaxed in other areas as well. We're stressing him here to see where he is." The grey is also nominated to the seven-furlong GII Tom Fool July 7 and the GIII Poker S. at a mile on the grass July 4; definite word on his next start is expected later this week. "The decision as to when he comes back, and where, has yet to be made," said Ryerson.

MISWAKI INJURED

Top stallion **Miswaki** (Mr. Prospector), sire of champions Black Tie Affair (Ire), Urban Sea, Miswaki Tern, Misil and Mister Slippers, injured his right front tendon in a paddock mishap and will out of action for what is left of the 1996 breeding season. Dr. J. D. Howard and Dr. Larry Bramlage, who examined the stallion, said the injury was not serious and that the prognosis was for a complete recovery. The 18-year-old sire stands for a fee of \$35,000, live foal, at Walmac International in Lexington.

THORO-GRAPH ANALYSIS

Does this year's Gold Cup feature the best older horses in training? Close, but no Cigar.

Sorry about that. Actually, what's left is a highly competitive, evenly matched field. One of the favorites, **Helmsman** (El Gran Senor), has never run fast enough to win (his best Thoro-Graph figure is 4 1/2), making this an attractive betting race. The other favorite, **Tinners Way** (Secretariat), has only run fast enough once (his 1/2 to win last year's Pacific Classic), so is certainly no value at a short price.

Clearly the most likely winner is **Geri** (Theatrical {Ire}), who put in four straight efforts around the 3 level before throwing in a stinker in the mud for the GI Pimlico Special. Mott's other entrant that day, **Wekiva Springs**, also ran poorly but came right back to his good races when he returned to a fast track.

If Geri does run his race, **Mr Purple** (Deputy Minister) is the primary danger. That colt exploded to a 1 in winning the Big 'Cap, then, as you would expect, bounced. In his last start, he made a nice forward move and now could be ready for his best. The catch, of course, is that he has only run that fast once in his life.

The Thoro-Graph play is Geri to win, protecting with an exacta under Mr Purple. **The Hollywood Gold Cup will be televised live on ESPN from 4:30-5:30 p.m. EDT.** Weekend Preview cont. p2

Adding spice to the event are **Dr Massini (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells), favourite for Epsom before he fell victim to a training setback, plus last year's European champion juvenile **Alhaarth (Ire)** (Unfuwain), who will be sporting blinkers for the first time as he tries to register his first success since last October's G1 Dewhurst S. at Newmarket. **The Budweiser Irish Derby will be televised on ESPN from 3:30-4:30 p.m. EDT.**

Wayne Lukas. "It was a very professional race. The weight and the new rider (Jerry Bailey was subbing for regular jockey Gary Stevens) were my only concerns. I felt we were running the best horse." The 11-1 outsider Shoop closed late to finish second to Serena's Song for the second time in her career after placing in the Pimlico Distaff H. as well.
