LONGSHOT ZAGREB WINS IRISH

DERBY Zagreb (Theatrical {Ire}), carrying the colors of breeder Allen Paulson, was sent off at odds of 20-1 but posted what must surely have been the best performance by a European-based three-year-old in 1996 when simply running away with yesterday's G1 Budweiser Irish Derby at The Curragh. Trainer Dermot Weld had made the decision to run this lightly raced colt at only the last minute and stable jockey Michael Kinane turned down the chance to ride him in favour of **Dr Massini (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells), who came home a disappointing seventh. With jockey Pat Shanahan in the saddle, Zagreb sat behind a wall of horses to the final quarter, then found a seam to run through and strode majestically clear to score by six lengths. French Derby runner-up **Polaris Flight** (Northern Flagship) was easily second best, while 50-1 **His Excellence** (El Gran Senor) completed the Kentucky-bred triple in third. It was the first Irish Derby victory for Weld, who was delighted by the performance. "This is the one event I have always wanted to win," he said. "I've won virtually every other race in Ireland, plus the Melbourne Cup, but collecting this is something really special." He added: "I've always thought Zagreb was a good horse, but he was disappointing last time out. However, he was very sick in the spring and is still improving." No word on where the colt will make his next appearance. (*Irish Derby chart p2*)

Bidding for his fourth straight victory, Siphon (Brz) was nevertheless overlooked at the windows in his quest for his first U. S. Grade I score. The speedy South American wired the field in the restricted Bates Motel H. and Gil Mervyn Leroy H. at a mile and a sixteenth in his last two but was attempting a mile and a quarter for the first time. Rated on the front end through moderate fractions by jockey David Flores, the bay dug in when challenged by 8-5 favorite Geri in the drive. "He was just kind of looking around, because he was going too easy," said Flores, who also guided longshot Marquetry to a front-running victory in the 1991 Gold Cup. "By the time we got to the three-eighths, I picked him up a little. I felt somebody was close to me, but I didn't want to look back. He gave me all he had when he changed leads in the stretch." Trainer Richard Mandella admitted, "I had questions about going a mile and a quarter--we've been stretching him out a little at a time. Last year, he was a real good sprinter for us. In his training and his last couple of races, he's done nothing but look like a top horse and he came through with it today." The winner will be back for the third leg of the MGM Grand Classic Crown, the Pacific Classic at Del Mar August 10. Plans for Geri could include a try on the turf, while Helmsman, third, will go next in the Pacific Classic or the Arlington Million. MR PURPLE (Deputy Minister) showed little and was eased; trainer Ron McAnally said an entrapped epiglottis caused the problem but that the colt was okay after the race. LUTHIER FEVER (Mt. Livermore), 47-1, was also eased. "The horse just didn't have running on his mid. He felt completely sound," said jockey Kent Desormeaux.

Unraced at two, Zagreb broke his maiden in April and was second in allowance company in June before breaking into the stakes ranks in eye-catching fashion. PRIVATE SONG (Private Account), the pacemaker for the favourite, Epsom Derby runner-up DUSHYANTOR (Sadler's Wells), carried out the task to perfection. But well before the home turn it was clear that Pat Eddery, aboard the bettors' 5-4 choice, was working hard. Pat Shanahan, riding his pick-up mount, Zagreb, was only sitting still, however, and he squeezed through a gap on the inside rails with just over a quarter-mile left. From there it was easy money for the colt despite the late flourish by Prix du Jockey-Club second Polaris Flight. Allen Paulson, listed as the winner's owner/breeder, sold 50 percent of the colt and 10 other homebred two-year-olds to partners Michael Smurfit, Michael Watt, Joe King and Dermot Weld in a deal arranged by Lexington's Newmarket International last year.

Grand Prix de Saint-Cloud cont.

Helissio (Fr), the disappointing favourite for the French Derby at the beginning of the month when finishing only fifth after a less than enterprising ride from Dominic Boeuf, bounced back in fine style to confirm that he is the best three-year-old colt in France. With France's leading rider Olivier Peslier replacing Boeuf, Helissio was always travelling well in behind the pace-setting Poliglote and took the lead fully three furlongs out. Thierry Jarnet on G1 Coronation Cup winner Swain came to throw down a challenge inside the final quarter mile, but he was never a serious threat. French Derby winner RAGMAR (FR) (Tropular {GB}) ran poorly to finish only seventh of the nine runners, while Italian Derby winner Bahamian Knight beat only one home, that being the 1995 French Oaks winner Carling, who finds a mile and a half too far in top-flight company. Winning trainer Elie Lellouche said: "Helissio did what he had to do and he proved that he is the best three-year-old in France. He just did not run his race in the French Derby. He will be rested now until the Prix Niel in September and then go for the Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe." Gerald Mosse partnered Ragmar (Fr) to win the French Derby, but this time had to settle for a disappointing effort. "The horse just did not seem comfortable on the surface," he said. "He was never striding out well."

Arlington International Racecourse has invited 15 horses to run against **Cigar** (Palace Music) in the Arlington Citation Challenge July 13. Likely to accept invitations for the 1 1/8th-mile race are **Dramatic Gold** (Slew o'Gold), **Eltish** (Cox's Ridge), **Polar Expedition** (Kodiack) and **Tenants Harbor** (Badger Land). Others receiving invitations were **Itron** (Quick Style), **Come on Flip** (Commemorate), **Classic Fit** (Bucksplasher), **Auggie My Dad** (Broad Brush), **Unusual Heat** (Nureyev), **Coup d'Argent** (Silver Buck), **Tooslew to be True** (Seattle Slew), **Dr. Banting** (Foligno), **Exclusive Garth** (Ecliptical), **Wild Syn** (Wild Again) and **Jambalaya Jazz** (Dixieland Band). Arlington officials said that if owners of other prominent horses express an interest in running, they also will be considered for the list. After winning the Hollywood Gold Cup with **Siphon (Brz)** (Itajara {Brz}), trainer Richard Mandella said he might be interested in sending the horse to Arlington in an attempt to thwart Cigar's bid to tie Citation's modern record of 16 straight victories.

QUEEN'S PLATE NOTES Victor Cooley (Cool Victor), early favorite for the July 7 Queen's Plate at Woodbine, worked six furlongs in a bullet 1:12 4/5 over a muddy main track at the Toronto oval yesterday morning. "He was very, very impressive," said jockey Emile Ramsammy, aboard for the move. "He did it so effortlessly. It felt like he was floating out there. He couldn't be any more ready than he is right now." The gelding has won three-of-five starts this year, including a pair of stakes at Woodbine in his last two. Also prepping for the Queen's Plate Sunday, **Kristy Krunch** (Varick), who will be ridden by Robin Platts next Sunday, went a mile in 1:42 1/5, while **Northernprospector** (Gold Crest) breezed six furlongs in 1:15 2/5, and **Intended Passage** (Regal Intention), son of the 1988 Queen's Plate hero, worked seven furlongs in 1:28 4/5. **Bartholomew Bandy** (Silver Deputy), sixth in the Plate Trial last out, will skip the main event. "He's not a Plate contender," said trainer Glenn Magnusson.

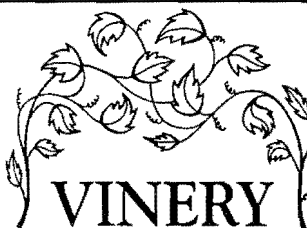

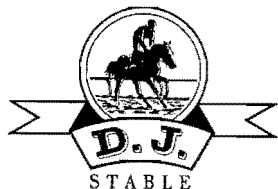
