NUMBERS UP AT CHURCHILL SPRING MEET

Churchill Downs concluded its 122nd Spring Meet Sunday with a 39 percent increase in wagering and a 10 percent increase in daily purse distribution. Overall wagering on Churchill races was \$333,939,493, boosted by a 97 percent growth in the out-of-state handle, which totaled \$210,280,161. Expanded distribution accounted for most of the gains; the Churchill signal was sent to a record 401 sites this year, as compared to 223 in 1995. On-track figures were off slightly, with the daily average attendance down 3 percent to 14,186, and the daily average handle down by the same percentage to \$1,836,835. The daily average purse distribution was a record \$368,868. "Our success has been built on a commitment to quality, the development of a strong purse program and this community's long-standing love of horse racing," said track president and CEO Thomas Meeker. He added that, with as many as five Indiana river boat casinos set to launch on the Ohio River, "It would be sheer folly to disregard the impact that will occur to all of Kentucky as a result of \$650 million of capital investment in Indiana river boat developments, especially for the race tracks located along the Ohio River. Recently, the Board of Directors authorized management to aggressively pursue...developing alternative forms of gaming at the racetrack." Jockey Pat Day collected his 22nd Churchill riding title with 63 victories. D. Wayne Lukas led all trainers with 20 winners for his ninth overall title at the Louisville track, while Raymond Cottrell topped the owners' standings for the second time with 15 wins.

CONDREN AND CORNACCHIA NAMED TOBA OWNERS OF THE MONTH The Thoroughbred Owners and Breeders Association has named William J. Condren and Joseph M. Cornacchia the Owners of the Month for May. The award, sponsored by Gainsborough Farm, highlights the partnership of Condren and Cornacchia, who enjoyed four wins from five starts in May. On May 2, **Sky Hero** (Conquistador Cielo) won a claiming race at Belmont, and on May 11, **Star Standard** (Risen Star) took the GI Pimlico Special. One week later, the twosome returned to Pimlico and captured a double as **Saratoga Dandy** (Saratoga Six) won the Sir Barton S. and **Louis Quatorze** (Sovereign Dancer), co-owned with breeder Georgia Hoffman, gave the gentlemen their first GI Preakness S. triumph. Condren and Cornacchia will be featured on ESPN's *Racehorse Digest*.

CORAL-ECLIPSE S.-G1, 3yo/up, 10fT

Bijou d'Inde (GB) (Cadeaux Genereux {GB}), winner of Royal Ascot's G1 St. James's Palace S. over a mile last month, is being prepared to step up in distance for this Group 1 test. The Mark Johnston trainee, earlier placed in both the Newmarket and Irish 2000 Guineas, will be racing at a mile and a quarter for the first time, but his handler is confident the colt is capable of doing equally well now with another two furlongs to travel. "He will give them all a run for their money," Johnston said. Nine others were declared for the Eclipse at the five-day stage. They were **Beauchamp King** (GB) (Nishapur {Fr}), fourth last time in the St James's Palace S.; **Charnwood Forest** (Ire) (Warning {GB}), hero of Royal Ascot's Queen Anne S.; **Definite Article** (GB) (Indian Ridge {Ire}), unbeaten in two outings this year; **Ela-Aristokrati** (Ire) (Danehill), a winner of his latest race; **Halling** (Diesis {GB}), last year's Eclipse hero; **Pentire** (GB) (Be My Guest), who collected on six of his seven starts during 1995; Epsom Derby winner **Shaamit** (Ire) (Mtoto {GB}); **Singspiel** (Ire) (In The Wings {GB}), narrowly defeated by Halling in last year's running of this Saturday's event; and **Valanour** (Ire) (Lomond), hero of France's G1 Prix Ganay April 28.

FIRST WINNER FOR CALLER I.D. Freshman sire **Caller I.D.** (Phone Trick) had his first winner at Calder Race Course Sunday as first-time starter **Chantilly Lace** posted a game neck decision, covering five-and-a-half furlongs in 1:07 flat. The seven-year-old stallion has already been represented by seven starters, with one winner and five placed horses. Caller I.D. won or placed in six of eight starts at two, including daylight victories in the GII Saratoga Special, GII Arlington-Washington Futurity and GIII Sanford S. Booked full in 1995 and 1996, he stands for a fee of \$6,000, live foal, at Pin Oak Stud near Versailles, Kentucky.

NEW FEATURE AT KEENELAND JULY SALE

Buyers at this year's Keeneland July Selected Yearling Sale will be able to view X-rays, endoscopic videotapes and veterinary statements regarding prospective purchases at a repository located in Keeneland's sales pavilion. Consignors will make the information available on a voluntary basis; the test results and statements must be taken on or after July 1, 1996 and must be delivered to Keeneland by 4:30 p.m. on July 12. "This is the result of several meetings over the past year with our consignors," said Rogers Beasley, director of sales. "We hope this will encourage our consignors to work together with the buyers to avoid multiple endoscopic examinations and X-rays." The information will be available beginning July 13 from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.; the booth will be open from 8:30 a.m. to the close of the sale during the two-day auction, July 15-16.

CALDER SIGNAL TO HIALEAH About 300 people ventured to Hialeah yesterday to bet on Calder, Philadelphia Park and Arlington. They wagered \$44,512 on all three tracks, about \$148 per person. What makes this so significant is that, until yesterday, there was a specific law that prohibited one Florida Thoroughbred track from taking or sending a signal to another Thoroughbred track in the state. A recently passed law which mandates Calder give Hialeah their signal was one of the crucial bargaining chips in Hialeah allowing the Breeders' Cup bill and full-card simulcasting to pass the recently concluded Florida legislative session. In 1993, Calder sent their signal to Hialeah for 11 days before pulling the plug, claiming the track was taking away a significant portion of their audience and handle. The sending of the 1993 signal was not mandatory.

A # will distinguish first-time stakes-winners, a @ will indicate first-time graded stakes-winners, a + will denote winners who are first-time starters, an (S) will be used for state-bred races and an (R) will be used for other restricted races.

Sunday, Woodbine

QUEEN'S PLATE S.-GIC, \$400,000, (S), 3yo, 10f

Plate Trial and Marine S. runner-up **Firm Dancer** (Affirmed) concluded his preparations for the Queen's Plate with a five-furlong breeze over Woodbine's main track Monday. With jockey David Penna in the saddle, the colt zipped through three furlongs in :34 3/5 before completing the five-eighths in :59 4/5; he galloped out six furlongs in 1:16. "He went much faster than I thought," said Penna. "He worked quite easily. I'm very impressed with the way he trained." Added trainer Mike Keogh, "It was just a maintenance breeze--he's tight enough. He came back great as well; he wouldn't even blow out a candle." Trainer Barbara Minshall sent both her Plate candidates out to breeze yesterday. **Rebmec** (Miswaki) blazing through three-eighths in :33 4/5 en route to his five furlongs in a bullet :58 3/5; he galloped out the three-quarters in a sprightly 1:11 2/5. Stablemate **Stephanotis** (Regal Classic) went the same distance in :59 4/5, going out the six furlongs in 1:12 3/5.

Alexandra Madigan fulfilled a lifelong dream at River Downs Monday. The 33-year-old apprentice jockey won a five-furlong maiden special weight aboard **City of Angels** (Texas City)--a horse she bred, foaled, raised, owns and trains. The two-year-old gelding was born and raised on Madigan's farm in Paris, Kentucky. "It's what I've waited for my whole life," she beamed. "This horse is really the reason I got my jockey's license. I pulled him from his mother, broke him and have been on him since day one. We plan to run City of Angels in a stakes race and will try for a spot in the \$200,000 Miller Genuine Draft Cradle S. After that, I'll try for my biggest dream--to win the Kentucky Derby on him."

Mt. SassafRAS, third in last year's Queen's Plate and Molson Million, started this season with two straight wins at Woodbine, including his first stakes score in the Gill Eclipse H., before shipping to Churchill to run a sharp third in the GII Stephen Foster H. June 15. Returning to Canada, the chestnut returned to the winner's circle as well, shadowing the longest shot on the board, Heaven's Wish, to the far turn before asserting himself as the leader of this pack for a handy victory. "My horse broke a little slow, but that worked out good because I was able to sit behind (Heaven's Wish), then make my move," said winning rider Mickey Walls. "He was really on the bit, and when I asked him, he powered on by." Last year's Queen's Plate winner REGAL DISCOVERY (Regal Classic), the 9-5 second choice, showed little and came home fifth. "We had no pace to run at whatsoever," said his jockey, Rob Landry. "He likes to kick late, but the other horses weren't coming back today."

HONEST (f, 3, Regal Search--Devine Truth, by Northern Jove) started her career in the claiming ranks and was haltered twice as a two-year-old, for \$25,000 after a 6 1/2-length victory last July and for \$32,000 by her present connections following a 7 1/2-length score last August. On the sidelines after that effort until January, the chestnut miss had picked up a pair of allowance tallies and a stakes-placing in six starts this season and earned her third win of the campaign in this off-the-turf affair, dueling on the lead to the top of the stretch before cruising away from the field to break the track record, winning by 4 1/4 lengths as the 1-5 favorite. Andre Fabre unveiled another potential star Monday at Maisons-Laffitte when **Zamindar** (Gone West), full-brother to the 1993 2000 Guineas winner Zafonic, won on his racecourse debut by five lengths. Partnered by Thierry Jarnet, the two-year-old bay colt, who had to miss his debut earlier in the season after hitting his head on the starting gate, was slowly into his stride in the five-and-a-half furlong Prix de la Saone, but soon made up the lost ground and went on to win very easily in 1:06.30.
